Introduction

This report has been written to introduce you to the concepts of astrology and how to get started in relationship astrology. Astrology is a complex and meaningful science which takes years to study and apply successfully; however, we would like to whet your appetite with this report, and encourage you to deepen your understanding through other means.

Astrology is a study of the connection between planets and life on Earth. It is based on a concept that energy patterns form between other planets and Earth and that these energies affect our lives as individuals and communities.

An astrological chart, also known as a horoscope, natal chart, or birth chart, records the relationship between the planets and the signs of the Zodiac. Charts can be calculated for the birth of a person, a community, an event or anything that seems momentous. The horoscope is as individual and unique as a fingerprint.

When using these interpretations, please bear in mind that, inevitably, every chart will contain some contradictory influences, and as a result certain interpretations of different items in the same chart may seem difficult to reconcile. However, this may still be an accurate reflection your chart, as it is likely that you do experience conflicting desires, events and circumstances in your life. Usually it is the responsibility of an astrologer to synthesise these apparent contradictions in order to present a cohesive and realistic interpretation of the dilemmas of the chart.

Please also be aware of the fact that each person has positive and negative influences in the chart, and therefore in their lives. The challenge is to accept and overcome the negative influences, so that we can successfully focus on the positive traits. This report outlines the influence of both people's charts on each other. This is called relationship synastry meaning the comparison of two horoscopes and the correlations discovered. It is likely that the report will show both the strengths and weaknesses of the relationship synastry. Any advice given is meant to be an aid to a person taking responsibility for their own lives and their own choices within a relationship. The ultimate decision rests with each individual. Individual Relating Traits

This section looks at each person's individual relationship concerns in their own personal birth chart. Every individual brings certain needs and expectations into a union, which affect his or her ability to feel loved and supported. This in turn affects the nature and course of the relationship.

Traits of Ted

Venus is in the 12th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the twelfth house of your birth chart you're likely to enjoy your own company, perhaps even craving the peace and quiet offered by seclusion rather than the hustle and bustle of a hectic social life. Your friends and your life partner need to respect your need to be alone at times. On occasion you don't mind spending your time with one or two friends, particularly women friends, but "the more the merrier" is definitely not your motto. You're more likely to be an introvert than an extrovert, reveling in a fantasy world or in your secret pastimes. You love mystery and romance, and have more than your share of secrets, perhaps even investigating secret arts. The worlds of magic, alchemy and astrology hold a certain appeal, as do many of the occult arts. Your success in the world may be as a result of your investigation into the secret arts. Success may also come as a result of your work behind the scenes in your profession, or in an institution or charitable organisation. You have a tendency to delight in secrets. You need to be wary of secret enemies, in particular women.

Chiron is in the 7th House

With Chiron in the 7th House of your birth chart you are likely to learn many lessons through your personal relationships. These lessons can be quite painful when you are young. As a child your parent's marriage might have adversely affected you. As you grow older your own partnerships may be hurtful, particularly if you feel rejected by someone you love. The benefit is that, as you grow older you also grow wiser. With this wisdom comes the ability to attract a positive spouse, someone who helps heal your past wounds. It is at this time that you find true joy and understanding through your own marriage.

Venus is in Scorpio

With Venus in the sign of Scorpio you're ardent and passionate in your primary relationship, and insist that your partner returns the intensity of your emotions. You're likely to enjoy the heights of passion if your love is matched in its intensity, finding yourself thrust into a world of almost painful pleasure. Sensual pleasure is important to you, although you also like to discover your partner's innermost thoughts and feelings. Problems can occur when your love isn't returned, or if your partner can't keep the intense fires of passion burning. Then you're likely to suffer the depths of despair, perhaps even resorting to manipulation in order to keep your partner's attention. Secret liaisons could play a part in your relationships, either your own or your partner's, particularly if the intensity becomes too claustrophobic. Jealousy and thoughts of vengeance can be a problem, although you would be wise not to give in to follow these avenues. Your challenge is to use your resources to find a middle path between the highs and lows of intense emotions within relationships. Your relationships can then flourish as important resources in your life. At some stage in your life you may benefit financially or through a legacy from an important relationship.

Venus is Trine Pluto

The combination of the planets Venus and Pluto in your chart indicate that you enjoy commitment and challenge in your personal relationships. Unlike many other people, you're not afraid to make the necessary changes demanded within close relationships. In fact you prefer change, especially if the alternative is a staid and steady relationship. You like to be consumed with love and passion, and are happiest when with a partner who feels the same way. You can be disappointed when others fail to soar to great emotional heights and plummet the emotional depths by your side. You want intensity, perhaps even a little drama, in your primary relationship. You're fiercely loyal and committed, and expect as much from your partner. Problems can arise when you don't feel a strong bond with your partner, or if a third partner threatens your relationship. You're a jealous person, and quite capable of seeking revenge when wronged. You need to be careful to choose the right person as your primary partner - someone who reciprocates your love and passion. Otherwise you can waste a lot of time and energy trying to make a doomed relationship work. You may also benefit from directing some of your energy into an all-consuming project, such as fighting for human rights or an intensely creative pursuit.

Venus is Square Jupiter

The planets Venus and Jupiter are combining unfavourably in your chart suggesting that you are somewhat fickle in relationships. It's not that you don't love your partner, but rather that the grass appears greener in other fields. Of course your ability to form a long-lasting relationship depends on other influences in your chart, but this combination suggests that you can be somewhat self-centred. You're optimistic and talented, full of joie de vivre and optimistic plans for the future, which are likely to be successful. Traits of Jane

Venus is in the 11th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the eleventh house of your birth chart friendships are an important component of your life - a great source of satisfaction and pleasure. Your marriage partner may have initially been a friend, who later became a lover. A popular person, you enjoy a wide variety of friends from all walks of life, who seem to take up a considerable amount of your time. Your friendships with women may be more prominent than those with men. At times you feel that you owe your success to your friends or your life partner, and this is probably true. Your relationships are beneficial, contributing to your happiness and helping you achieve your hopes and wishes. This may even involve financial gifts or favours. It's also possible that groups and clubs feature in your life. You enjoy belonging to a group of like-minded people, feeling supported by the relationships that are formed. This could involve you taking a prominent role in a group, or simply working quietly in the background. Either way you're particularly keen on becoming a member of a group with goals that benefit humanity. You may meet your spouse through such a group, or share your group activities with your partner.

The Moon is in the 7th House

The Moon is placed in the seventh house of your birth chart suggesting that your primary relationship plays a key role in your life, dominating your moods and actions. It's likely that you marry at a young age, but if not you put a lot of time and energy into searching for the right person to share your life. The life of the single person isn't an easy one for you and you can be quite restless in your endeavours to find a partner. If you're married then you're sensitive to the feelings of your partner and keen to put them at their ease. You're likely to either adapt your behaviour to please your partner, or to rebel against his or her influence. The influence is the same in that his or her behaviour is dictating your mood swings. The problem is that you can allow your primary relationship to be too dominating, sacrificing your own needs and desires to the other person. At worse, your partner is fickle and not worth the effort that you're expending. This is an extreme representation of the astrological influences. It's also likely that your partner is simply changeable and of an unsettled nature, seeking change and stimulation through travel and work. Therefore you simply need to reassess your priorities and to work towards a balance between loving compromise and self-assertion. You need to seek a partner who honours your emotional needs. You need also to be wary of letting your relationship with a woman, possibly your mother or mother-in-law, influence your marriage or potential marital partners. Knowing your own heart and feelings helps considerably in these situations. In ancient times the Moon was considered to be in a strong position when placed in the seventh house of a chart, meaning that you're in a strong position to achieve your personal ambitions. This, of course, depends on other influences in your birth chart.

Pluto is in the 7th House

The planet Pluto is in the seventh house of your birth chart indicating that marriage and business partnerships are a challenging force in your life. You need to approach these relationships with caution and integrity, otherwise you're prone to major upheavals. It's possible that your parents' relationship was somewhat traumatic, affecting you more deeply than you had previously believed. This may affect your ability to commit to a marriage. If you're not careful you may attract an abusive marriage partner, or someone who betrays you in marriage or business. On a more positive note, you prefer a challenge in marriage rather than the comfort of a predictable partner. If you and your partner are aware of potential problems, and are able to keep the communication lines open, then you learn a great deal through your most intimate relationships. This experience of deep transformation through relationships can be most rewarding.

Venus is in Sagittarius

With Venus in the sign of Sagittarius you've a happy-go-lucky approach to your relationships, and yearn to share adventure with your partner, whether it be simply sharing adventurous ideas or taking off on a journey to another part of the world. Your motivation is to learn more about the world through your main relationships. In some cases your partner could be your teacher, perhaps even someone from a foreign country. You do enjoy relating to foreigners, because they can teach you so much about yourself and life in general. If you can't continually be on the road, then you like to hear about other people's journeys. Your friends come from all walks of life and you're popular, so there are many friends. You're benevolent and loving in all of your relationships, ready to join in on others' adventures and experiencing genuine pleasure in their company. Your generous nature means that you often encourage others in their journey through life. Your intentions are loyal, although you do sometimes have trouble sticking to your promises

because the grass can appear so much greener in other parts of the world.

Venus is Trine The Moon

You enjoy comfortable relationships with other people because of the favourable combination of the Moon and Venus in your birth chart. A charming and prudent person, you enjoy the company of other people, and they respond favourably. You're likely to enjoy success in your primary relationship, choosing someone who feels comfortable and companionable. You're also likely to benefit from your relationships with women.

Venus is Square Neptune

The planets Venus and Neptune are combining in a manner, which indicates disappointment in your primary relationship. The problem is that you're idealistic and unrealistic when it comes to personal relationships, lacking the discriminatory powers needed to form a steady and lasting partnership. This applies to both your personal and business partnerships. Consequently you often feel disillusioned and sorry for yourself, blaming others for failing to live up to your expectations. It's possible that your partner is indeed deceiving you in some manner, but it's also possible that you're not being honest. Either way it's likely that you're seeing your primary relationship through rose-coloured glasses, and as a result conflict arises because of your lack of discernment. You're caught in a web of fantasies and romantic illusions, either of your own or your partner's making. Coming to terms with the reality of your relationship helps you obtain a better understanding of your primary relationship, and prevents you from becoming disillusioned. Taking off the rose-coloured glasses means that you can make a proper assessment of your primary relationship. As a result you'll experience fewer feelings of resentment and disappointment, and won't be in danger of overlooking some major flaws such as drug addiction or deceit. With the right partner you'll enjoy a sense of peace and fulfillment. You may also enjoy artistic or spiritual pursuits together. You're ardent and loving, responding quickly to your partner's need. In turn you benefit from acts of kindness, love and appreciation.

Synastry Between Ted and Jane

Personal Issues

This section looks at the interaction between two people and their two birth charts. It notes the nature of the relationship, whether it is likely to be a successful personal relationship or whether the forces at work are suggesting a less intimate bond. In other words how do these two people come together on an intimate level?

Ted's Moon is Sextile Jane's Sun (Orb 1°15')

This is an ideal combination for a close, personal relationship whether it be a close friendship or love relationship. Ted and Jane enjoy each other's company and feel that the other person is giving something special to the relationship. They have a lot in common and the ability to share enjoyable times together. Jane is likely to be the more dominant person in the relationship believing her identity and individuality are likely to be enhanced by the association. Perhaps Jane receives emotional support from Ted which contributes to a greater sense of being alive and an ability to achieve her personal goals. Jane may appreciate Ted's emotional insights. On the other hand Ted feels comforted by the relationship, perhaps playing a supportive role and offering emotional insights and comfort. Alternatively Ted may simply feel secure within the relationship, experiencing a sense of well being. This relationship provides Ted with a supportive base from which to explore life. Both Ted and Jane understand each other and enjoy an easy rapport, which augurs well for their association.

Jane's Moon is Trine Ted's Mercury (Orb 4°33')

This is an ideal combination for a personal relationship in which two people enjoy ease of communication. Jane and Ted enjoy each other's company because they are able to communicate comfortably. They enjoy discussions and are not concerned about arguments. Many personal relationships fail simply because two people are unable to communicate both their thoughts and feelings. The synastry of these two planets means that Jane and Ted are able to tell each other not only what they are thinking, but also how they are feeling. They are able to do so in a manner that is not threatening or hurtful to each other. Therefore Jane and Ted are both safe in the knowledge that they are not going to overreact, trampling on each other's feelings. Likewise Jane and Ted are easily able to acknowledge the value of the each other's thoughts and feelings. At times Jane and Ted may even feel they are telepathic together, seemingly not needing words to communicate but understanding each other's unspoken thoughts. Together Jane and Ted are able to take a balanced approach combining passion and reason. They have an understanding and rapport that enables them to clarify their own thoughts and feelings. Jane is likely to be the more intuitive of the two, while Ted is likely to rely more on the intellect when communicating.

Ted's Moon is Trine Jane's Mars (Orb 1°50')

This combination of planets denotes a relationship that is exciting and animated. Ted and Jane's discussions are lively and impassioned and their shared pastimes are also likely to be energetic and fun. Ted and Jane enjoy spontaneity and both tend to be impulsive when together. Both of them feel that their lives have become more effervescent with the advent of this relationship. Ted is most likely to feel that Jane brings excitement into his life. Ted is aware that Jane's drive and energy contributes positively to his life. Whereas Jane feels inspired by the relationship to

achieve her goals. Jane acknowledges that Ted's support and understanding is helping her to advance in life. There is also likely to be a strong sexual attraction that helps to add a little spice to life. However, this sexual attraction is most powerful when both Ted and Jane are feeling comfortable within the association. The attraction can lose its spark when there is emotional tension. Fortunately, this does not happen often. Ted and Jane are mostly able to resolve their differences and enjoy an enlivened and satisfying union.

Jane's Moon is Square Ted's Sun (Orb 4°35')

'Opposites attract' could be the theme for this combination of personal planets. There is an instant spark when Jane and Ted meet, whether they choose to enjoy a friendship or a more intimate relationship. The world seems more exciting when they are together. When together Jane and Ted are able to broaden their horizons in ways they had not thought possible. Each one seems to fill a void deep inside the other. In astrology it is considered important to have a combination of personal planets in order to enjoy a deep relationship, but this can be a difficult combination once the initial excitement has worn off. Friction easily arises and what was once attractive becomes irritating. The success of this relationship largely depends on each person's ability to accept the other person's differences. Ted may eventually have difficulty understanding Jane's emotional nature. Ted may feel impatient and frustrated by the limitations placed on him by Jane. Jane may feel overwhelmed by Ted's personality. The initial excitement of the association with someone so opposing in nature may be replaced by feelings of insecurity. It's important for both Jane and Ted to continue to appreciate each other's differences at all times and to realise that this relationship is potentially very rewarding if the difficulties can be faced and resolutions found.

Jane's Moon is Square Ted's Venus (Orb 5°42')

When planets combine unfavourably in personal relationships it can produce either sparks, which excite both parties, or friction. Either way a challenge is presented which needs to be met in order to succeed in the long term. With this combination Jane and Ted have difficulty expressing their feelings and often feel misunderstood by each other. Jane and Ted have trouble relaxing and feeling at ease with each other. There is a lack of harmony that troubles them. Jane and Ted sometimes feel that they are battling to find shared activities that they can both enjoy. In extreme cases they may feel that they are fighting against the other person's involvement with an absorbing pastime. Or perhaps they feel that their partner stands in the way of them really enjoying their own pleasurable pursuits. No matter how much Jane and Ted want to enjoy themselves, their partner seems to be standing in opposition, or determined to do their own thing. Depending on other aspects of their relationship and the nature of the combination of these planets, this can be a real problem. It's also likely that they have difficulty deciding how to save and spend their money. Jane is likely to feel some insecurity in the relationship. Ted is likely to feel that the Jane's feelings and insecurities are holding him back from relating to other people and the world in the way that he wants. On a more positive note this combination can add a spark to life and keep Jane and Ted willing to resolve difficulties to a satisfactory conclusion.

Ted's Sun is Sextile Jane's Ascendant (Orb 1°44')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Ted's Sun is combining with Jane's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant personal relationship. Ted and Jane feel strongly drawn to

each other, experiencing a sense of completeness in each other's company. Ted can really shine through his association with Jane. He appreciates the benefits that this union brings into his life and the way in which Jane helps him achieve his personal goals. In turn Jane has a greater sense of well-being through her association with Ted. She welcomes the sunnier aspects of Ted's personality and appreciates their mutual respect and affection. While this combination is most likely to indicate an intimate love union, it can also augur well for friendships, family relationship and work associations.

Ted's Sun is Square Jane's Mars (Orb 3°18')

This is a relationship that begins with a fanfare and ends with a bang. This fiery combination of the Sun and the planet Mars is a difficult one. Any relationship with this combination is likely to be difficult to maintain unless there are other more positive connections. There is much excitement when Ted and Jane first get together; an electric sexual energy pulsates between both of them. Both Ted and Jane feel a rush of energy when in each other's company. However, this quickly becomes friction because Ted and Jane are trying to head in different directions. Conflict is likely. The problem is that Ted feels overpowered by the demands of Jane, and unable to positively express himself in this union. The frustration can build to the point where Ted's attitude aggravates Jane. Ted feels that his personality is squashed by Jane. Jane is frustrated by the demands of Ted, feeling unable to pursue her goals. In the end the sexual attraction may fail to be enough to maintain a long-term intimate union. Depending on other connections in this relationship Ted and Jane may finally decide to end their association. They may need to seek counsel on how to resolve conflict, which at times could be quite fiery.

Ted's Mercury is Conjunct Jane's Venus (Orb 1°13')

The combination of the personal planets of Mercury and Venus is a desirable one for an intimate union, and certainly advantageous to any association which requires harmony and collaboration. Ted and Jane enjoy each other's company, finding it easy to co-operate and share their experiences. They are compatible. Conversation has an easy flow and pastimes are fun, free of the restraints that sometimes hamper clear communication. Ted and Jane share an appreciation of the arts, perhaps even partaking in a joint creative or artistic activity. Discussions are harmonious because Ted and Jane are so often in agreement, including money. They concur on how money is saved and spent and enjoyed. Ted and Jane value the intellectual stimulation provided by each other. Ted, in particular, experiences mental inspiration from his association with Jane. Perhaps Jane is Ted's muse in some form of the arts. Ted gains confidence in his opinions and ideas as a result of his relationship with Jane. In return Jane appreciates Ted's intellect. Jane feels able to relax within this relationship knowing that Ted encourages rather than criticises her.

Jane's Mercury is Square Ted's Mars (Orb 0°22')

A feisty relationship is the result of this combination of the planets Mercury and Mars. When Jane and Ted are together the sparks fly. The nature of these sparks depends on other aspects of the relationship. On the one hand Jane and Ted may be positively stimulated by each other's company, enjoying lively conversations and energetic activities. Both Jane and Ted learn much from each other and may enjoy facing challenges together which in turn help them to move forward in their own lives. However, it is more likely that this combination indicates a combustive reaction when Jane and Ted are together. The relationship is likely to be fraught with misunderstandings and angry reactions. In particular Ted is aggressive, perhaps even trying to

bully Jane to do things his way. Ted honestly believes that he knows what is right for Jane and energetically sets about trying to achieve his goals. However, Jane resents these tactics and becomes critical of everything that Ted does. There seems to be no middle ground and tempers are frayed. Jane is usually able to have the last word, but Ted knows how to act in a way that is guaranteed to escalate any argument. Of course there is always the possibility that both Jane and Ted enjoy the drama of this relationship. However, if this is not the case then the lesson is to learn to respect each other's differences and to channel all of the energy created by this partnership into positive activities and lively discussions.

Ted's Venus is Sextile Jane's Ascendant (Orb 0°37')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Ted's Venus is combining with Jane's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant personal relationship. Ted and Jane feel strongly drawn to each other, experiencing a sense of completeness in each other's company. Ted is in love with Jane, wanting to enjoy pleasurable activities and intimate moments. He appreciates the benefits that this union brings into his life. This relationship brings a wealth of benefits for Ted. In turn Jane has a greater sense of well being through her association with Ted. She appreciates Ted's love of intimacy and his attitude to this union. Together they share a mutual respect and affection. While this combination is most likely to indicate an intimate love union, it can also augur well for friendships, family relationship and work associations.

Ted's Venus is Square Jane's Mars (Orb 2°11')

This is a strong combination for a love union because it creates an intense sexual attraction. The durability and nature of the relationship depends on other connections between Ted and Jane. Desire is strong, perhaps too strong at times in this relationship. Ted and Jane are likely to fall in love at first sight enjoying a passionate union, the type of love affair featured in romance novels. At first both Ted and Jane enjoy the intense physical nature of the union, but as time goes on the flames seem to burn too strongly. Jane begins to feel possessive and perhaps somewhat obsessive, eager to maintain the force of passion. Ted feels overwhelmed by the passion of the romance and the force of Jane's nature, and is in danger of becoming repulsed rather than attracted to Jane. As a result the relationship becomes a combat zone. Ted and Jane start to compete rather than co-operate. The positive side of the relationship is the strong attraction felt by both Ted and Jane. However, it is important for both Ted and Jane to learn to temper their desires in this union. They need to remain focused on co-operation and communication in order to keep an appropriate balance in the partnership. While this combination is often found between marriage or sexual partners, it can also be encountered in friendships or work associations which involve working on an artistic project. However, it is important that both individuals remain focused on the creative project at hand because a sexual flirtation could easily get out of control.

Primary Forces

In addition to the intimate aspect of a relationship, there are usually a number of fundamental driving forces, which can be either major challenges or inspirations to the individuals involved. This section looks at how Ted and Jane stimulate and provoke each other.

Ted's Moon is Trine Jane's Chiron (Orb 0°13')

Ted and Jane have a gentle and loving relationship, which plays a significant role in their lives. They have an intuitive understanding of each other's needs, an empathy that sometimes seems to go beyond the bounds of human understanding. Ted feels that destiny has played a role in attracting Jane into his life. It is true that Jane has the capability of sensitively changing Ted's life, helping him satisfy previously unmet emotional needs. Jane may play a nurturing, healing or teaching role in this relationship. It is likely that Ted feels safe in this relationship. In turn Ted provides Jane with opportunities to discover new talents, particularly in the fields of teaching, or orthodox or unconventional medicine. This is likely to be a close, intimate relationship that helps both Ted and Jane weather life's troubles and discover joy.

Ted's Moon is Square Jane's Jupiter (Orb 2°15')

Although there can be some difficulties with this combination, on the whole this is a positive combination. Ted and Jane enjoy each other's company and feel a certain zest for life when together. Ted and Jane share a need for fun-filled adventures and the capability of achieving their goals. They both feel that the world is their oyster which is ready to explore together. This can include holidays in far-away places, adventure travel and also encompasses any activity which expands their minds and views of life. This is a meeting of higher-minds. Ted feels that Jane expands his horizons. Ted feels safe and appreciated in this relationship. Jane knows that Ted is a comrade in arms when it comes to fun and adventure. Jane knows that she is truly appreciated for her generosity and optimism. Together Ted and Jane can conquer the world. Nothing seems too far-fetched. And this is where problems can lie. It is possible that neither Ted nor Jane know when enough is enough. There is a saying that 'you can have too much of a good thing'. This is one of the underlying problems of this association. Ted and Jane need to make sure that they do not become too grandiose in their dreams. Overinflated ideas of their capabilities are not helpful and can lead both Ted and Jane into troubled waters. Another complication can arise if Ted and Jane do not share the same values, because morals and beliefs play an important role in this relationship. However, if Ted and Jane share the same beliefs and can exercise some restraint this can be a positive combination for a long-term relationship.

Ted's Moon is Square Jane's Pluto (Orb 1°33')

This is an intense and powerful relationship. Ted and Jane feel a strong attraction to each other, one that seems to unconsciously draw them together. Ted's and Jane's deep feelings for each other need to be nurtured in a loving manner in order for the union to be long lasting. However, this can be quite difficult for Ted and Jane to achieve. It's not that they don't love each other, because they do care very deeply. The problem is that at times their intense emotions seem to erupt from nowhere. In fact the feelings have been simmering under the surface ready to be expressed at any moment. The pressure builds up quickly between Ted and Jane and before they know it they are embroiled in an emotional drama. Of course this can vary, depending on how Ted and Jane handle intense feelings. Some individuals thrive on intensity, while others feel threatened and powerless. Ted is likely to feel that his life has been transformed in some way by Jane. It's possible that Jane has changed the way that Ted feels about the world, making him conscious of things that have been bubbling under the surface for a long time. Life is not the same for Ted once he encounters Jane. He may feel powerless, overwhelmed by Jane's volatile nature. The key is for Ted is able to see through the explosive behaviour to the true heart of Jane and to nurture Jane's goodness. As a result Jane will deeply appreciate the emotional support offered by Ted. If this does not occur then it is likely that Jane will feel angry about the constant

demands being placed on her by Ted. Jane will start to withdraw and become isolated, only initiating contact in the relationship when she feels at boiling point. The challenge for Jane is to maintain a loving attitude and to give Ted time to learn his emotional lessons. This is indeed a passionate personal union and one that needs to be loving, otherwise there is a danger of abuse. This combination can also signify a secret love affair in which intense feelings are indeed in the background. It can also depict an intense working relationship in which power struggles abound, but it is more likely to point to a personal union.

Jane's Moon is Square Ted's North Node (Orb 4°10')

This is a significant combination in relationship astrology, indicating a strong emotional bond with far-reaching consequences for both Jane and Ted. When Jane and Ted meet chances are that their emotional lives are irrevocably changed by the experience of their union. Whether lovers, friend or colleagues Jane and Ted have to contend with strong feelings. It is possible that their relationship is filled with emotional difficulties, which need to be overcome in order for the bond to be long lasting. There is a saying, "the path to true love is not easy". This is certainly true for Jane and Ted. On a positive note, this combination of the Moon and the North Node indicates that Jane and Ted are destined to be together. As a result they are likely to resolve their differences.

Ted's Sun is Sextile Jane's Jupiter (Orb 3°43')

The Sun and the favourable planet Jupiter are combining suggesting that this relationship is blessed with good fortune and happiness. It is an ideal combination for an intimate relationship such as marriage because it indicates shared philosophies on life and the ability to grow together. Together Ted and Jane land on their feet no matter how difficult a situation. They seem destined to be in the right place at the right time. Ted and Jane enjoy each other's company, feeling all of the benefits that come with this union. Their optimism and enthusiasm are infectious, and as a couple they are popular. In particular Ted shines as a result of his association with Jane. Ted feels able to embrace life and all it has to offer. He is aware that his union with Jane is truly blessed and that it helps him to achieve his full potential. Jane knows that her horizons are continually expanding through her association with Ted. Jane feels able to conquer the world. In fact it is likely that both Ted and Jane enjoy travelling, studying or teaching together. They enjoy sharing anything that expands their minds and contributes positively to their lives.

Ted's Sun is Trine Jane's Saturn (Orb 2°07')

Many astrologers believe that a connection between the serious planet Saturn and a personal planet such as the Sun is important, providing the cement for a long-lasting relationship. In other words a serious planet is needed for a serious, meaningful union such as marriage. It is certainly true that the combination of the Sun and Saturn is found in many, meaningful relationships. However, the harmful planet Saturn can also cause problems. The extent of the problems varies according to the astrological aspect. Certainly this combination indicates that Ted and Jane both view this as a serious association, whether it is a marriage, friendship or a working partnership. Both Ted and Jane are committed to their association. It is likely that they experienced a strong attraction in the initial stages of their relationship, and it is likely to be long lasting. When Ted and Jane first meet they each know they have discovered a potential serious relationship, one to which they can commit and build on over a lifetime. If they believe in reincarnation, then it is likely that they feel a karmic attraction, a moment of recognition when they first look into the

other person's eyes. However, the very qualities, which they seriously considered as attractive in the initial stages of the relationship, can become the source of friction if they are not careful. In particular, Jane needs to be wary of becoming too critical and judgmental. Initially Jane found Ted's personality traits to be worthy of a committed union. She admired Ted's qualities as complementing her own. However, it is easy for Jane to forget this attraction. As the relationship develops she feels threatened by the force of Ted's personality and takes a superior attitude in defence. As a result Ted feels threatened, disliking the authoritarian side of Jane. If Ted is not careful his self-confidence is whittled away and the relationship becomes onerous. It is vital that both Ted and Jane work at developing a stable basis for communication and understanding in this relationship. If both Ted and Jane work at maintaining their own self-confidence as well as mutual respect then they have the makings for a very successful marriage or working relationship. If this is the case they both benefit from the stability offered by this union, growing in integrity in their own lives.

Ted's Sun is Trine Jane's Pluto (Orb 3°02')

This combination of planets indicates a relationship, which is life changing, whether it be a friendship, love union or work association. Both Ted and Jane feel a powerful attraction for each other. It is as if they are both compelled to relate. The nature of the relationship depends on other aspects of their relationship. It is possible that this relationship is a positive one for both Ted and Jane bringing rewards and challenges that lead to greater fulfilment in both their lives. Power and wealth may result from this relationship. Both Ted and Jane are ardent in their pursuits enjoying intense and fulfilling pastimes, which are ultimately life changing. However, it is also possible that both Ted and Jane experience the less attractive aspects of this relationship. They may become embroiled in a struggle for dominance, their relationship resembling a battleground from which neither emerges triumphant. They can be either intensely loyal friends or formidable opponents. Ted feels empowered by this union, learning to rise to the challenges set by Jane. He feels that life is more exciting and intense, thanks to his union with Jane. Jane is a powerful force in this union.

Ted's Sun is Conjunct Jane's North Node (Orb 9°17')

Both the Sun and the Nodes individually are significant in relationship astrology. The combination of the Sun and the Nodes indicates that this is an important personal relationship, one that changes the course of Ted's life and helps Jane shine brightly in her's. Ted and Jane feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. Whether the path of this relationship is smooth or rough, Ted and Jane's paths were meant to cross. The nature of this association depends largely on other aspects of Ted and Jane's charts. Passion may ignite if the right ingredients are involved, or friendship may be most appropriate.

Jane's Mercury is Trine Ted's Uranus (Orb 0°11')

This is an exciting and unpredictable relationship. Jane and Ted enjoy a lively union, whether it be a romance, friendship or work association. They take pleasure in topical conversations, sparking new ideas and ways of thinking. They may also enjoy taking part in an unusual activity or pursuing an environmental, humanitarian or political cause. This combination of planets indicates intellectual, rather than emotional, stimulation. Consequently this combination may indicate a friendship or work association, rather than a more personal union. However, an

intimate relationship with other aspects is enhanced by this combination if both partners enjoy freedom. Jane and Ted are excited by each other's minds. In particular Jane realises that Ted sparks her creativity. Both Jane and Ted enjoy a new-found sense of freedom in each other's company.

Jane's Mercury is Sextile Ted's North Node (Orb 2°14')

The North Node is a significant point in relationship astrology, indicating fate in any association. In this case Jane and Ted are destined to meet and learn from each. Perhaps they meet in a study group, as pen pals or at a college. Ted gains insight and understanding through his association with Jane. Perhaps Jane is a teacher imparting specific knowledge, or maybe Jane's presence communicates certain messages that are valuable for Ted's life lessons. Either way Jane and Ted are comfortable interacting with each other. Depending on aspects of Jane and Ted's birth charts, this association indicates an intellectual rapport rather than a passionate or emotional bond.

Jane's Mercury is Square Ted's Saturn (Orb 3°45')

A lasting union is indicated by this combination of the planets Mercury and Saturn, but only if the pitfalls are avoided. The problems could include poor communication, judgmental or critical attitudes to each other or a fear of intimacy. On a positive note both Jane and Ted share a mutual respect for each other and are willing to work towards sound communication. However, they are likely to strike obstacles along the way, which will test their commitment. If Jane and Ted can overcome these obstacles then they will strengthen their bond. If not, one or both of them is likely to feel imprisoned by the relationship. It's also possible that Jane's self-esteem is adversely affected if Ted is too critical. A personal relationship is the most difficult to balance with this combination. A working relationship is also a challenge.

Ted's Mercury is Square Jane's Neptune (Orb 3°43')

This is an inspirational relationship whether it be a romance, friendship or a creative working partnership. Both Ted and Jane feel excited by this union. Their imaginations are enlivened. However, it is also a difficult combination of the planets Mercury and Neptune. Ted and Jane need to ensure that they face this relationship honestly. Otherwise they may both be caught in a web of deceit. This could mean viewing each other with rose-coloured glasses, failing to realistically assess the merits of their association. However, it could also be possible that the relationship has an element of deceit or abuse, in particular drug abuse. Both Ted and Jane could feel disillusioned by their association. It is important that they ensure that the creative, rather than the destructive, elements of their union are emphasised. Perhaps working on an artistic, spiritual or philanthropic project would be beneficial. However, they need to ensure that this project is a positive and appropriate one.

Jane's Mercury is Opposite Ted's Chiron (Orb 6°09')

This is a difficult combination of the planet Mercury and the asteroid Chiron. Jane and Ted have difficulty communicating in a manner that is rewarding. Instead they seem to hurt each other's feelings through saying the wrong thing. In particular Ted seems to upset Jane. The problem is that old hurtful memories surface in this relationship. Jane and Ted have subconsciously attracted each other in order to learn valuable life lessons, but the journey is not smooth. Jane is particularly sensitive to the words used by Ted, and has difficulty listening with emotional calm. Jane may accuse Ted of being insensitive and uncaring; however, Ted feels wrongfully accused.

He genuinely struggles to find a better way of communicating what he means. These misunderstandings could lead to a breakdown in the relationship, or they could finally result in a better understanding of themselves and each other. Either way compassion is a key ingredient to successfully overcoming past hurts and developing loving communication.

Ted's Venus is Trine Jane's Saturn (Orb 0°59')

The planet Saturn is an important ingredient in any committed relationship. This sombre planet can take away some of the short-term excitement of any union, but on a positive note it adds commitment and security needed for a long-term association. In other words Ted and Jane take this relationship seriously. They are devoted to each other and joyful in making promises that they are both able to keep. From the start of their association they enjoy taking their time getting to know each other, experiencing stability and understanding that grows slowly over time. They genuinely love each other and want to work towards a strong partnership. At times Ted would like more fun and spontaneity, but he appreciates Jane's wisdom in slowing things down in order to build a lasting union. Mutual respect is a central theme to this union. There is also a strong feeling of fate in this relationship. Ted and Jane may tell a story of how destiny meant for them to be together. While this combination of planets indicates a serious personal relationship, it can also be a positive influence on a partnership formed for the purpose of an artistic or creative project requiring both inspiration and hard work.

Ted's Venus is Trine Jane's Pluto (Orb 1°54')

Intense emotions are central to this relationship. Ted and Jane feel a passionate attraction to each other, a compelling need to be together. Sexual magnetism plays an important role in the initial stages of the union and continues, even through times of emotional difficulties. It is also possible that Ted and Jane share an artistic or creative pursuit about which they are both ardent. Whatever the outlet for the emotions, the key is intensity. On the whole this combination of the planets Venus and Pluto has a positive influence on any association, but it can be overpowering in some instances. If both Ted and Jane enjoy intensity then this relationship positively transforms both their lives. Together they embrace the changes that challenge any relationship. If one of them dislikes emotional upheaval, then there are likely to be problems. In particular Ted may feel overwhelmed at times by the force of his own emotions or the power of Jane's personality. At other times Ted enjoys learning about how to be more influential in his life. Jane feels more powerful as a result of this union with Ted, more able to achieve her ambitions.

Jane's Venus is Square Ted's Neptune (Orb 4°18')

This association of the planets Venus and Neptune indicates idyllic love. Jane and Ted meet and fall deeply in love, fully appreciating each other's unique qualities. Romance abounds. Together Jane and Ted feel that they have found true love such as only Romeo and Juliet and Daphnis and Chloe experienced. However, there are problems associated with this combination of planets. Jane and Ted find that the initial idyllic love can start to prove illusory in the long term. As the relationship develops it becomes more difficult for them to escape from the demands of the mundane world into a world of romance. They become disillusioned. They would rather stay lost in a sea of blissful love than be reminded of the responsibilities of their separate lives. Both Jane and Ted are vulnerable in this state of pretence. They need to be wary of circumstances or people who prey on their impressionable state. In particular they need to avoid any spiritual groups, drugs and artistic enterprises that may be deceptive in their nature. Once Jane and Ted have

learned to face their relationship honestly and with discrimination then they can enjoy a creative and loving partnership as well as artistic and spiritual pursuits.

Jane's Mars is Conjunct Ted's Jupiter (Orb 5°53')

Jane and Ted are able to combine their talents well under the positive influence of the planets Mars and Jupiter. Their association provides them both with a zest for life. Jane has the drive necessary for any joint projects, and Ted has the know-how and planning capabilities. Jane and Ted set goals, work towards them while overcoming obstacles along the way. Together they successfully achieve their ambitions. They enjoy collaborating, gaining the respect of each other in the process. Jane admires Ted's inspirational ideas. In turn Ted appreciates Jane's initiative and energy. As well as working together Jane and Ted also delight in playing together. It's possible that they enjoy sharing travel and sporting activities. Whatever joint project they undertake Jane and Ted enjoy good fortune.

Ted's Jupiter is Trine Jane's Chiron (Orb 4°16')

A beneficial and joyful relationship is the result of this combination of the planet Jupiter and Chiron. Ted and Jane are able to close the door on problems and hurts from previous relationship and enter into this liaison with a sense of joy. Together they heal each other's emotional pain, gaining understanding and insights into relating. Ted and Jane have common values and teach each other the joy and comfort that comes with a responsive and understanding union. Together Ted and Jane enjoy exploring new territory, perhaps in the healing, spiritual or teaching faculties. Ted is a positive influence on this union, bringing an optimism and enthusiasm that is attractive and bountiful.

Jane's Jupiter is Opposite Ted's Pluto (Orb 1°08')

Obstacles are strewn along the path of this relationship because of the difficult combination of the planets Jupiter and Pluto. On the one hand Jane and Ted feel a compelling need to relate to each other. On the other hand they find their opposing values a formidable hurdle. The problem is that they fail to understand each other at a deep level and yet this is an important component in their relationship. Jane believes that she attempts to take an honest approach to her partnership, but is undermined by Ted's insistence on delving beneath the surface. Ted is frustrated in his efforts to get to the bottom of matters. He is particularly angry when he perceives that Jane contradicts herself. Their challenge is to find personal meaning in their own lives, while respecting the other person's values and beliefs.

Ted's Neptune is Trine Jane's Ascendant (Orb 5°21')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Ted's Neptune is combining with Jane's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant relationship. Ted and Jane feel strongly drawn to each other. Romance is in the air. Both Ted and Jane are in love and floating on air, as the saying goes. They enjoy the first throes of romantic love and have a knack for re-creating romance. It is possible that this relationship could falter under the demands of daily practicalities. This combination can indicate an association based on mutual spiritual, artistic or philanthropic interests, but it is most likely in a romantic union.

Generational Values

Underpinning the success of many relationships is a sense of shared values. Often this comes from simply being born into the same generation. However, sometimes it is more complex. In this section we explore whether or not Ted and Jane share the same societal values.

Jane's Saturn is Trine Ted's Pluto (Orb 2°45')

The combination of the planets Saturn and Pluto indicates that this is an important relationship, although not necessarily a personal one. Jane and Ted combine their talents in a way that enhances their lives. Jane provides structure and security so that Ted can safely make any changes necessary in his life. In return Ted helps Jane break through any barriers created by his fears. For these reasons this can be a dynamic and satisfying union.

Ted's Saturn is Trine Jane's North Node (Orb 5°55')

The planet Saturn is a vital ingredient in relationship astrology. It is the planet that represents stability and commitment and is seen by astrologers as the necessary glue that holds a relationship together on a long-term basis. Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. This is particularly true of connections between one person's Saturn and another person's Sun, Moon, Ascendant or Nodes. In this case Ted's Saturn is combining with Jane's Node indicating that this is a significant relationship. Ted and Jane feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. This is a significant relationship.

Jane's Saturn is Opposite Ted's Neptune (Orb 5°44')

The planet Saturn is a vital ingredient in relationship astrology. It is the planet that represents stability and commitment and is seen by astrologers as the necessary glue that holds a relationship together on a long-term basis. Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. In this case, however, the planet Neptune negates some of the influence of Saturn. The planet Neptune is one that dissolves and confuses matters. So on the one hand Jane and Ted feel strongly drawn to each other, but on the other hand they have difficulty maintaining a meaningful relationship. At first Jane and Ted may experience a feeling that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. This could be a personal relationship or a friendship that involves a spiritual, artistic or philanthropic project. Whatever the form of their relationship, Jane and Ted initially enjoy a meaningful bond. The difficulty lies in the long term. Jane and Ted begin to feel that they are pulling in opposite directions. They need to respect each other's differences in order for the relationship to succeed in the long term. Of course they may both agree that their union was destined to be for a short period only.

Ted's Uranus is Conjunct Jane's Uranus (Orb 5°19')

This combination of the planets Uranus indicates an electric connection, which excites both Ted and Jane. They feel that they are on the same intellectual wavelength, and welcome each other's creative ideas. Together they enjoy innovative projects. Technology, science, politics, the environment, metaphysics and world events may spark their curiosity. The key is intellectual stimulation and joint discovery of new uncharted territories. Their relationship undergoes periods of upheaval, but on the whole both Ted and Jane prefer the unexpected changes to settling into a

routine. Together Ted and Jane are able to enjoy independence, enabling each other plenty of freedom to pursue their individual activities. In some cases this combination may simply indicate that Ted and Jane are a similar age. Nevertheless the effect is still one that enhances their relationship.

Ted's Uranus is Trine Jane's Neptune (Orb 5°47')

This combination of the planets Uranus and Neptune does not necessarily indicate a personal relationship, but rather an impersonal type of association. Either way, it is likely that life can be approached in a new and imaginative fashion for Ted and Jane as a result of this union. Together they stimulate growth and change in each other. Ted is particularly interested in keeping this association fresh and alive. He finds Jane's ideas and opinions intellectually stimulating, prompting his own creative ideas and shared activities. Jane's imagination is more to the fore in this relationship. She is able to express a more intuitive side of herself. Together Ted and Jane share insights and this encourages their ingenuity.

Jane's Uranus is Sextile Ted's Chiron (Orb 0°37')

Healing and growth are possible in this relationship. Jane and Ted are able to leave behind painful memories of previous associations and pave new paths of understanding. Together they enjoy exploring new ways of communicating and learning about each other and their own personal lives. They are an inspiration to each other.
