Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sew." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will

strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Pisces

You had a history of being dedicated to causes. One of your key impulses was tapping into your intuition. Your soul was normally intoxicated with the prospect of reincarnating, seeing another chance to witness life's magic. The archetypal theme for your life destiny was to be an inspirer. A crucial lesson was to not rely so heavily on your

instincts that you forgot to use your intellect. Sound reality testing kept you from overly idealizing the wrong people or situations.

When you didn't doubt your feelings, your spontaneity was freer. You tended to find your way through faith and even adopting a very spiritual outlook. A trickster was thinking you weren't perfect enough to be a success. It caused great anxiety and self-consciousness. Finding a way to balance your great intuitive power with a scrutinizing mind was a key to happiness. You saw imperfection faster than most and had high standards for excellence. Losing yourself in what you loved doing was a high. The arts and healing arenas showcased your abilities in the past. When you met a soul mate or had transcendental insights, your consciousness leapt out of ordinary mortal time.

Node in 5th house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? Finding creative outlets big enough to express your vitality was essential. If you held back your inventiveness, you lacked the gusto to manifest your talents. A common concern was "how can I get my ability noticed?" When you didn't try to steam roll your desires over the needs of others, you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? Falling in love was a big one! It always took you out of your worries. Another one was getting a chance to demonstrate your capability. When people showered you with attention, it gave you an extra boost. If you became too eccentric or egocentric, eventually your momentum came to a crashing halt. A youthful spirit that energized others was part of your past. When you let others feel free to reach their own potentials, this kept you on track as much as not giving your support alienated those trying to love you. Somewhere, always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks was a heart-filled generosity instinct mixed with a tinge of rebelliousness and independence. When using this wisely and timely, life was colored with a unique eye for progressive trends and a way of sniffing out those trails leading to reinventing yourself.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Taurus:

The sign of Taurus the bull lighted the mid-spring astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Taurus is "I desire". Another one is "I have". You had a pattern related to ownership and strong drives to taste what the world was serving.

Archetypes for Taurus include the peacemaker, nature lover and economizer. More than likely you had a healthy fear of poverty. This drove you in past lives to steadily develop knowledge that was marketable. A pragmatic attitude usually surfaced in key areas of your lives. Sooner or later you realized the value of stability. It's when you grew too attached to having particular outcomes that life got murky.

The cosmic principle at work through many of your past incarnations was to depend heavily on what you could see and touch. You found ego strength or self-confidence through imposing your will power on what you wanted. Appreciating beauty in all of its

forms was a way of life. A steady determination defined you. Sometimes in past lives you became inert. This was due to either dulled senses, or events knocked the wind out of you. A test was deepening your intuitive eye. Chances are you were successful in business. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting persistence. An intense tendency to have things on your own terms was a theme that ran throughout your incarnations and was a key to your self-mastery. It was when you put forth a dynamo of creative enthusiasm that this energy was a true champion!

Sun in 3rd house

You had solar power that went right through your mental processes in previous lives. It radiated out curiously and quickly, taking advantage of new learning opportunities. You enjoyed a sense of pride in your communication ability. People responded to your confident ideas. Your creative vitality became awakened when slipping out of the usual routines. Repetitive thinking bored you in a hurry. Changing circumstances delighted you.

If there was a challenge, it was getting distracted by walking in too many directions simultaneously. It's not that you couldn't do this successfully. You did at times lose your focus. Your perceptions were your key to opening doors of opportunity. Bouncing concepts off of the minds of others was stimulating. The exchange of information with peers or colleagues made you feel invigorated. Experiences that offered diversity were pleasing. Insightful ideas lived brightly through you. Your self-expression found inspiration through travel and education. A change of scenery was your way of keeping problems in perspective. The world responded positively to your energizing mental outlook, but less favorably when you seemed scattered. Channeling nervous energy into productive outlets was rewarding. You found fulfillment in influencing positive change in others.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Aries:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Aries. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual fighting spirit allowed you to survive calamities and dilemmas. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a pioneering spirit. You searched your soul for the courage to act decisively.

Your inner landscapes were colored with a restless atmosphere for adventure. Competition pumped you with a feisty attitude. There were lives where you lacked the backbone of your convictions. Moon in 4th house

The Quest

Mercury: Communication, Perceptions and Logic

Mercury in Gemini

You were Mercurialized at birth through the sign of Gemini pointing to speedy mental impulses in past lives. Being excited in speech was your communication style.

You exercised greater patience when knowing you had enough to keep you mentally occupied. Although it should be said, that when you felt overwhelmed by too much stimuli, you didn't fight against a relaxing break in the action. Repetitive routines grew monotonous. Mercury in 3rd house

Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity

Mars in Sagittarius

What would a warrior planet in the fiery sign of Sagittarius mean regarding your past lives? You were a restless adventurer. Sitting still and waiting for life to happen to you wasn't your style. Fighting for your beliefs was a regular pattern. You liked to travel, even along unexplored territories. Finding those back trails made you excited. Your initiating impulse was accelerated when chasing your romanticized dreams. You needed idealism to keep fueling your drive. Taking risks that others feared to try did cause you various injuries and loss. A competitive streak developed when someone was trying to outsmart you.

Your identity was strengthened through incorporating the beliefs and knowledge of those living beyond your home territory. Jupiter in 11th house

Your patience wasn't the best in being a team player. Being treated independently and equally were sensitive needs. You weren't always a revolutionary. As a matter of fact sometimes you opposed new trends if they were conflicting with your belief system. Travel elevated your mind above your worries. It had a way of exciting your brain to think with greater energy. Luck smiled favorably upon you when not afraid to walk your talk, whether the applause occurred or not. Good fortune came through a determination not to compromise your integrity and listening from your heart to hear those most inspiring new directions.

The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Taurus

Ambition came forward slowly but surely, says your past history, with Saturn placed within the calming sign Taurus. Discipline was usually preached to you early in life. It wasn't wise to force you to be something you really didn't want to be. You were serious about money. This means you knew quickly that few things came without a price. Business sense was in your veins. Some accused you of being too cautious. Moving with a steady pace toward success was your style. You were willing to work hard, but you didn't like everyday hassles. Your greatest fear was whether you could find the love and sense of well being you desired. When you satisfied this dilemma, you were then able to proceed ahead with less anxiety.

A karmic shadow was getting lost in either material desires or having a poverty consciousness. When you mastered this dilemma, you enjoyed greater balance. Saturn in 4th house

Clear definition of emotional boundaries was a challenge. You really valued privacy. You needed to learn not to take family and your most trusted allies for granted. A major redefining that was associated with becoming inwardly strong and self-reliant occurred regularly in lifetimes. A location that offered you prosperity was sought. Wisdom came in recognizing how much responsibility for others was reasonable to accept.

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

Uranus in Libra

You had a tendency to weigh the consequences of future goals, indicates Uranus in the sign Libra. Your mind did switch to fast forward when you made a clear choice that you knew would bring you beneficial results. Your social life was as stimulating as they come. Being out in the public made you feel alive. Being a loner wasn't likely, unless you became so eccentric that you alienated others.

Inventiveness was triggered by your partnerships. You found confidence in sharing your unique ideas. Your insights into the legal arena and the arts were powerful. Trusting your own discoveries was the real test before you talked yourself out of them. Maintaining a sense of direction kept you decisive and guided you toward doors that offered fulfilling relationships along with energizing new experiences.

Uranus in 11th house

In what way were you unconventional? It was in regard to experimentation. You were willing to try anything once. You had futuristic vision that propelled you onto exciting paths that pointed the way to reinventing yourself. Original ideas are what you found enlivening. A sense of direction was maintained through a rugged self-determination. Though you could change your mind in midstream, if the spirit moved you to do so. Why? Usually it was because something more interesting came along. This didn't exactly make you dependable. You rebelled against either backward thinking, or ideas that lacked originality. Even when staying silent you inwardly protested against repressive institutions or regimes. Going into fast forward occurred when you perceived it was the opportune time to leap into a new life. You didn't like thinking for too long before taking a risk. This did cause you to burn a few bridges too soon. Your own agendas sometimes became too important and caused tension in partnerships. Accommodating what others wanted was easier if it didn't interfere with your own desires. You were inventive in spotting trends that others would appreciate.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Scorpio

You believed in ideals that spoke to the passion within you.

Your idealism was awakened through finding symbols that gave you a sense of rebirth. Crisis situations were the catalyst that made you use your intuition. The mystical forces of the universe often spoke to and through you. It was not unusual for you to go on silent retreats where you went into deep meditative experiences. Romance had its highs and lows. Balancing the extremes was important. You liked passionate relationships with a bit of mystery surrounding them. Though eventually you often looked for a comforting bond. A lack of trust caused you emotional upheavals. It was reassuring when you found a lover understanding your innermost needs.

A major challenge was addiction to love, sex, and other forms of escape. This isn't saying you always fell into these behaviors. When you found the clarity and strength to channel this intensity positively, life was more enjoyable. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to create a life that reflected your self-mastery. You had strong dedication to those you loved and a determination to show the world your talents. You found transcendental growth through dealing with unfinished business from the past, and walking forcefully toward the challenges you instinctually knew would scare and fulfill you at the same time.

Neptune in 9th house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to having long range outlooks. You could see miles and miles ahead of many. It was those nasty little details that were a nuisance. Going to foreign places and meeting people from various locations mesmerized you. It was getting out of your home terrain that made you feel special. Your idealism caused you to seek growth through education and learning. You had a strong inclination to teach. Sharing your understanding with others was fulfilling. Being a counselor or advisor came naturally.

A test was in not becoming so expansive that you never focused on immediate needs. You were accused of lacking commitment. Though you rationalized this as being distracted by other interests. You did often manage to reach great heights when you felt the inspiration of your beliefs. When you tapped into a positive attitude it wasn't easy to talk you out of a choice, whether a good one or bad. Your spirituality was usually cherished. You had an eclectic belief system. What was the biggest challenge? It was in how you responded after an extreme disappointment. Not wanting to face your loss of hope made matters worse. Faith transformed your denial into a renewed positive thinking. You searched for a purpose that had open-ended questions that gave you the opportunity to keep seeking growth-promoting answers.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Virgo

Empowering yourself through using analytical ability was a past lives tendency. Perfection drove you on to try to do great things. Being reasonable in your expectations was wise. Extreme worry was sometimes a downfall. Curbing this tendency did make you happier and allowed for greater productivity. Charisma was exhibited through working forcefully at whatever you made your life mission. Escaping into projects made you less nervous. There was a habit of putting your heart and soul into a cause.

There was a shadow. What was it? Criticism. You could spot if something was out of place in a second. You did at times overly pick apart yourself or others. When you got this one under control, good fortune was never far away. Self-mastery was discovered through deciphering the ways to work smarter rather than harder. You found rebirth or a sense of fulfillment when overcoming negative thought patterns, and seeing that altered perceptions were truly miracles.

Pluto in 11th house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? You latched onto those goals that set you as free as Jonathan Livingston Seagull, flying high above the crowd. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through meeting individuals that stimulated you to breathe with a greater spirit. Getting refocused in a more creative direction was usually the answer. A get off of my cloud mentality didn't always make you popular, but gave you the room to test the depths of your own waters. You weren't one to rush into experimenting with new things, until being assured there were no strings too tightly attached. A powerful self-examination manifested if you became too self-focused. Forgetting to support the ideas of others caused tension. A compulsive tendency to control the movement of others, or they acting like this toward you, got you to ask thought-provoking questions. Power struggles over money were not uncommon. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations linked to being too cold emotionally or distant. When you thawed out the ice, you enjoyed closer relationships.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These

two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon conjunct Saturn

You usually took on great amounts of responsibility for others. A serious approach to life started early. People with a plan you trusted as you never liked having your time wasted by idle dreamers. Disappointment and rejection did at times cause depression. You spent your fair share of time alone. Solitude helped you collect yourself. You were not really a loner as much as wanting to be with people you could count on. A sober attitude pretty much defined you. Whatever roles you performed, you gave your best. Not being too hard on yourself was not an easy lesson to learn. A determination to find a profession that would provide adequate money and status was an innate need. A challenge was keeping a positive mental approach.

Moon oppose Midheaven

You didn't exactly set the world on fire in making your serious plans visible. It was a long-term process in gaining the confidence in taking your show public. When you gained the support of key people, you were more apt to display your talent. You did have good instincts in figuring out how to become a success. You were more comfortable in helping others accomplish their milestones. Family and career were sometimes at odds.

You felt a pull to pursue professional paths, which occasionally pulled you away from those you loved. Finding a way to enjoy both worlds made you more content. The hermit archetype surfaced within you when you wanted great privacy. Your intuitive power grew the more you believed in it!

Sun trine Jupiter

An anything is possible mind-set either led you to do great things or forget to consider the consequences. You were so likeable that people often forgave you even after disappointing them. A bright spirit that motivated was your style. You made a great teacher and trainer. Generous giving of your resources, often brought you in return twofold more than you gave. If you lacked determination, it was usually due to becoming distracted by other interests. When you got focused, you were capable of accomplishing great feats. Expanding your horizons was forever coaxing you to fulfill a dream.

Sun oppose Neptune

Relationships have tested you as much or more than anything. Finding a soul mate was intoxicating, making you feel on top of the world. The trick was not denying your feelings. Falling in love with what appeared to be pretty and lovely wasn't always what was being hidden deeper down in the package. You were more successful in partnerships when learning to take a second look before committing. In some lives, it was not easy to be with anyone. You were pulled away by dreams. Pursuing what you saw as magical or inspirational felt like a calling. Over-sensitivity held back your talents, fearing people could see right through you. Destiny seemed to bring you into the company of those able to help you reach the highest plateaus. Though being careful in whom you believed in proved wise.

Sun trine Pluto

You had considerable self-confidence. The challenge was acting on it. Complacency set in if you weren't up to dealing with resistance to your plans. A sunny disposition attracted support. Creative success made you feel fully empowered. A wise use of power made others want to support your life aims. You had good sense in saving and earning money.

Mercury oppose Mars

Being direct and getting right to the point was your communication style. You became indecisive the more you pondered over things. Bouncing your ideas off of partners and friends was what you liked to do to gain clarity. If they didn't agree with you, this did occasionally cause friction. Keeping an open mind allowed you to see another person's point of view. Angry people made you uneasy, but slow thinkers did as well. So somewhere in the middle, assertive but with a drop of reflection was what you needed in a lover or close peer. When you had a strong opinion or a fiery idea, there was

a fight to the end mentality displayed. Well-calculated risks sometimes put you into the fast lane of success as much as just plain diving in immediately. With experience, you got better at knowing whether to follow the immediate gratification impulse, or the one that said to slow down. Listening to others took much practice.

Venus trine Mars

You had a good feel for being assertive and diplomatic as needed. You liked highly motivated individuals as lovers and friends. You sometimes lacked the drive to go after what you desired. However, when finding the confidence to pursue your dreams, you could act courageously.

Venus oppose Midheaven

Finding the right balance between home and work was important to you. You were sensitive about getting emotional support from those you loved. Doubting your decisions was something you had to overcome if you were going to be happy. You liked having a soul mate or a special someone with whom to share ideas. A team spirit gave you greater confidence. Living up to the expectations of others was a challenge. You were more content when becoming your own person.

Jupiter conjunct Uranus

Freedom. It meant everything to you! Your mind went off on a tangent, like an inventor, not able to stop the force of new ideas. A rebel that struck with great wit was you. There were those not fond of your ideas. You were not exactly the most stabilizing factor. You had a philosophy that woke up the minds of your contemporaries, sometimes infuriating them. It was when you threatened someone's comfort zones that you got the strongest reaction. You didn't always greet change warmly. Innovators had to prove their thinking was for the good or you resisted ruthlessly. Developing consistency and follow through was a challenge.

Jupiter conjunct Pluto

A passionate search for meaning didn't exactly make your life easy. Your ethics and truthfulness guided your actions. If you decided to manipulate or be overly judgmental, life had a way of holding back its gifts. You were an avid student. You were willing to probe far beneath the surface appearance of things to get answers. An investigator shined through your face. Your faith strengthened after surviving a crisis. You learned that it was wise not to wait for things to get dangerous or tragic before finding reasons to celebrate. Perhaps your biggest test was not being afraid of your own shadows. On the mundane level, you knew how to survive. Good luck came through putting faith into your hunches.

Jupiter oppose Node

If you are reading this one, many of your past lives had a pattern of anxiously finding something or someone to believe in. In the final analysis, it was your own self-confidence and self-understanding that was the key to your fulfillment. A tendency to go where the grass was greener did cause you to leave situations in favor of better opportunities. Twenty-twenty hindsight taught you that patience might have been wise. However, at times you smartly left behind very limiting circumstances. Being dogmatically attached to a narrow philosophy didn't open the door to many possibilities. Nor did being compulsively expansive help you get much accomplished. An open-minded perspective with a passionate longing to express your knowledge was a winning combination. The teacher and advisor in you became evident to others. When not running from your shadows, you became incredibly strong.

Jupiter square Ascendant

Overconfidence was a strong tendency. So was exaggeration. But then again, it was taking chances that propelled you forward into new panoramas. You perhaps believed too much in what others were selling when a little stepping back to think would have saved you time and money. Sharing information was a drive. Your timing wasn't always accurate when it came to making changes. Being somewhat unpredictable made others nervous. You were emphatic about self-discovery. Discipline and focus were tests.

Uranus oppose Node

You knew that maintaining your freedom was your lifeline. If you became comfortably numb, no longer caring about your personal autonomy, something within you died. Then it took meeting a rebellious soul or having an experience awaken this side of you again. If you went to the extreme of only serving yourself, it was hard for anyone to get real close to you. There was an inventor and innovator pulsating lively inside, just waiting for the chances to be discovered. You didn't fit into traditional institutions unless making great adjustments. This isn't saying there were no instances when your gifts didn't benefit a mainstream society. You had trouble waiting for others to catch up to your thinking! A revolutionary spirit dominated your mind. Your gift was great vision. A shadow was lack of foresight when you moved with reckless abandonment. It took courage and insight to make this very special dimension of your consciousness work in your favor.

Uranus square Ascendant

Ideas traveled through you at the speed of light, sometimes causing you to ride one suddenly onto a new highway. Your fast changes of direction made some think you to be undependable. You enjoyed shocking others with actions and thought-provoking ideas. It wasn't in your nature to be a copycat. You were trend setting for sure. Causing friction with no real purpose behind the action wasn't productive. You were quite a catalyst for

change. Erratic inconsistencies in behavior proved problematic in maintaining closeness or finishing what you started out to do. When you discovered your unique personal style it did find you with a clearer sense of direction.

Neptune trine Node

Destiny had a way of sending you messages about which doors to knock on. You sensed the trails that led to fulfillment. Occasionally you took a detour to see if the scenery was different. You found what you were looking for by not doubting that life would bring the experiences that were needed to fulfill your dreams.

Pluto oppose Node

Defying the odds against you being successful was something you enjoyed taking on. You didn't use the best judgement necessarily in selecting partners. However, through trial and error, you got better at knowing who were your true friends and allies. Betrayals haunted you when investing in individuals that dealt off the bottom of the deck. When you found those right people, your partnerships were totally empowering. Lovers gave as much as they took when you made clear choices. Equal power was essential in your personal dealings. There was a tendency to process things long after they happened. The loss of someone close was never easy to handle. The reason being you bonded so deeply. Trust took you a lot of time ordinarily to establish. Facing your shadows kept them from ruling you. Rebirths were common, especially after dealing with a crisis.

Ascendant square Node

You had a tendency to either react quickly to taking advantage of an opportunity or to stew in a quandary. You felt conflict in trying to fight off strong willed individuals to pursue your own dreams. Being your own person wasn't comfortable if giving into the expectations of others continuously. Then again, if you always demanded your own way, nobody stayed your friend for all seasons. Finding the right roles that best expressed your potential was a fight to the finish. This gave you strength. Patience was a key to making solid, well-conceived decisions.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.

Gemini on 2nd House:

A tendency to find multiple ways to earn a living was a reality. Your mind was

always considered to be your most valuable resource. You didn't like to have your choices forced down your throat. Mental determination came forward when you discovered a life purpose. An unwillingness or inability to be disciplined frustrated you and others. Developing shortcuts that saved time and money served you well in your past. You admired those individuals able to concretely express their ideas. When people listened to your concepts it won your heart. People who thought before they acted made you feel more at ease with them.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.

Taurus on 3rd house:

Slow and calm thinking was what you favored. You often displayed a relaxed demeanor in the midst of intense negotiations. Flexibility wasn't always your strong suit. You got into problems when refusing to change directions even though storms were visible in the nearby horizon. Patience though still tipped the scales of good fortune your way more often than not. You didn't like for people to rush your thinking. They were met with a stubborn resistance when pushing too hard. You respected people showing sound logic.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.

Aries on 4th house:

Moving frequently colored past incarnations. There was an inner restlessness that got you going. An adventurous streak led you to strike out in new directions. You tended to be impatient at times with those you loved. However, your emotional intensity in showing you cared often won their hearts. Your inner motivation to be successful needed to stay inspired through adventurous challenges.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.

Pisces on 5th house:

You had fun with creativity. Whatever roles you chose, drama was never far behind. Your intuitive energies came forward powerfully when you let them do so. A fear of expressing your ideals held back your creative power. A lack of self-confidence had to be overcome if it was interfering with you showing that light hidden under the bushel. Finding the ego strength to make your dreams come true was essential. You often gave more than you received. It wasn't easy to set limits. Keeping realistic expectations kept you in balance. You liked falling in love as it gave you creative stimulation. A tendency to overly idealize those you loved had to be kept reasonable. You found inner peace when courageously putting your beliefs into action.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.

Capricorn on 6th house:

You applied yourself seriously to the job in front of you. Discipline along with a hard

work ethic guided much of your thinking. Becoming a workaholic occurred. You did need to discover that delegating work to others did lighten your load. A tendency to try to do too much of the work on your own grew burdensome. Trusting others to help became a wise policy. You could be tenacious about solving a problem. The trick was figuring out when enough was enough. Learning new trends and habits didn't come easily due to allegiance to the past. Your determination got you over obstacles.

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.

Capricorn on 7th house:

You preferred relationships that were stable. Trust didn't come easily, but with time, you did manage to warm up to your fair share of mates. Time was your ally in romance because you needed this to deepen your commitments. You didn't impulsively rush into partnerships. Your love relationships got out of balance if you treated someone too businesslike, rather than as a lover. When you exhibited a cold personality it was more out of fear. Some of your partners were a bit reserved. You chose to live alone at times because this made it easier than trying to please someone. A resistance to a lover's need for new experiences did cause tension. There were times when a lack of flexibility in a lover put considerable pressure on you. You did sometimes learn that trying to control others didn't bring them closer. People that didn't let your seriousness bother them often became your friends. Your bark was louder than your bite. Finding ways to stay playful kept your relationships longer lasting. Balanced dependency needs was important to the stability of a partnership.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.

Sagittarius on 8th house:

You preferred generous partners. Trust was something you worshiped. This meant you didn't have much use for those betraying you. You cut people a lot of slack until they hung themselves. You had deep convictions about your beliefs. You had luck in the nick of time to escape close calls. Avoiding dangerous situations through following spontaneous instincts kept you free of harm's way. The exception was when you carelessly overlooked the odds. Life went better when you tolerated the freedom needs of others. There was a tendency to be overly idealistic. Reality testing helped.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.

Scorpio on 9th house:

You were passionate about your beliefs. Fighting to the death to preserve them was a reality. It was your faith that often made or broke your opportunities. You had a high standard for morals, and yet every once in a while, you liked to indulge in whatever the taboo of the day might have been. When you lacked confidence, your world stood still. In those magic moments when you rose above self-doubt, mountains could be moved. A stubborn conviction about knowing the truth was a blessing or a curse. The blessing found you guided by clearly defined rules and ethics. The curse was expressing a strong

dislike for those not living up to your dogmatic opinions. You liked in-depth studying rather than skimming the surface. Facts that had no real substance didn't impress you. Your philosophy about life was fairly reality based. You valued honesty and integrity. When you were betrayed it took you a while to get over it. Your follow through intensified as you discovered the avenues that best expressed your talents.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.

Libra on 10th house:

You worked extensively with the public. Knowing what you wanted to do professionally tested your wits. Making up your mind which paths to explore challenged you greatly. There were times when your ambition went to sleep. Either you couldn't get focused or the effort didn't seem worth the trouble. When you did find your niche, you impressed people with your dedication. You certainly possessed great diplomatic skills. Being able to mediate disputes between opposing factions was something else you did well. Stress in your profession was never all that desirable. You might have had to put up with a bit of heat to reach a goal, but your preference was a more relaxed atmosphere.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.

Virgo on 11th house:

You looked carefully before leaping. The future worried you, unless it looked real user-friendly. It wasn't easy to express your uniqueness for fear of ridicule. When you overcame what other people might say, you shot a full throttle toward your favorite aspirations. You were motivated more by what was reasonable to achieve than what was mere fantasy. A methodological planning of each step along the way was how you approached a goal. Friends and lovers grew impatient with your being too careful. When you became bored with routines was when you displayed rebellious and unpredictable favors. People either loved or detested you for this. You were a happier person when your self-expectations showed commonsense.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.

Cancer on 12th house:

You preferred not being all that visible. When there was vagueness in making your needs known, confusion resulted. You tended to idealize your closest relationships. This did lead you to sometimes expect too much from people. It was your inspiring belief in those you cared about that did get them to attempt great things. Learning how to regulate closeness and distance in relating to others kept you balanced. Having confidence in your deepest beliefs brought you fulfillment.

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving

retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Mars retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in determining the ways to express your warrior nature. What does this mean? Well for starters, in lives where you were too aggressive, you had to learn how to tone down your demands. What about the lives you weren't so direct? You needed to get more outspoken. The idea was to land somewhere in the middle on the assertion scale. You were happiest when sensing how to act spontaneously, with an instinct that didn't trample over the people in front of you. Actually, maybe it's more accurate to say your friends, family and lovers were ecstatic when you had great awareness of the impact of your movements and choices. If you became too timid in behavior, you tended to get confused. People took advantage of you. If you were a fighter with no sensitivity, the battles may have been won, but sooner or later a faster or better shooter caught up with you. There was excitement in overcoming challenges. You didn't really like losing control of your anger. When you stuffed it back it did explode. Knowing this slowed down or sharpened your response time. Your impulse to initiate new directions was at its best when guided by your intuition. Your raw energy to be a creative was aroused when finding the courage to transcend the obstacles in front of you.

Jupiter retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in not foolishly believing in the wrong things or people. When you were on target and accurately assessing situations, you were a dynamo of efficiency and inspiration. Another challenge was in the area of confidence. When you lost faith it took the wind out of your sails. The search for an expansive enough vision was an innate drive. People didn't respond as well if you preached dogma or grew too judgmental. When you kept an open mind there was less friction. You had a capacity to embrace a positive outlook, that is, if self-doubt didn't seep into your thinking. Another challenge was running too fast to where the grass might be greener, running away from facing problems. The optimist in you needed to know limits. When you walked with commonsense and put your ideas into worthwhile actions, the world had no choice but to eventually give into your needs for self-discovery.

Uranus Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had unique goals, reserved just for you. When you didn't do this, life lacked meaning. When you solely served your own purposes this caused quite a ruffle in the feathers of those you loved and cared about. Finding the midstream worked the best regarding these two extremes of sacrifice and doing your own thing. Your ideas sent shock waves at times when individuals or collective bodies didn't like the message. You did sometimes tap into a collective trend before it became in vogue. It did make you nervous about how you might be judged. Many ideas were kept internalized until you were sure the coast was clear and safe enough to present the notions. Were you ever more outwardly disruptive? For sure! This usually occurred when

you were so aroused by injustices or thinking restrictions imposed upon you. There was a need to perceive with fore thought, which fights were worth the struggle. Being different just to be different or starting conflicts with no purpose, were ways you took many steps in the wrong direction. Listening to cues from the universe on which directions promised accelerated growth was wise. Your vision of the future was as strong as the ability to remember what gave your imagination an electrifying sensation. Patience took effort!

Neptune Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you needed to watch out what you asked life for. Do you know why? Because you were apt to get it! A tendency to have a strong intuitive quality was a past pattern. In some incarnations you were quite the poet, artist, entertainer or mystic. Perfection wasn't so nice to you in that divine discontent was troublesome, making it a challenge to be satisfied. When you were reasonable or grounded, life was simpler. Getting focused occurred after becoming inspired. There were times when you had premonitions of things to come. This either gave you great faith or was scary. The more you accepted your sixth sense, the easier it was to express outwardly. Another challenge was achieving discipline and utilizing reality testing. When you made a commitment not to run away from conflict, you found clarity. When letting your ideals guide you, life seemed more magical and full of inspiring symbols. Belief in a higher power sustained you through many tough challenges. Lovers were inspirational in stimulating your creativity. You liked the idea of a special someone with whom to share your dreams. Developing a spiritual understanding and a sacred place within kept you walking on the straight and narrow with great awareness, pointing you to pleasurable escapes, and kept you guilt-free.

Pluto retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern to know your way around Intensity Street. In some lives you were overpowering. In others, you didn't usurp enough power. Having a sense of empowerment was crucial to reaching self-mastery. Survival instincts you possessed. Being emotionally intense was a past pattern. Learning to communicate your feelings made you easier to understand. Self-honesty was liberating but it was a test to admit your faults. Defensiveness had to be conquered. You didn't believe in going halfway when exploring a subject. Compulsive lusts for riches and leadership sometimes brought out your worst manipulative traits. You were happier when feeling inwardly secure and having allies that you could trust. You had to beware of an urge to win at all costs. You found rebirth through not fearing your own shadows, and being big enough not to run from those you loved. You processed experiences long after they occurred, revisiting the past often, healed when able to embrace forgiveness.

Hopefully you have enjoyed your tour through this report. Remember that astrology's language is a great teacher. There are many other reports that you can explore.
