Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sew." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will

strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Sagittarius

You had a history of seeking adventurous learning expeditions. One of your key impulses was discovering various ways to satisfy an animated imagination. Your soul was normally celebrating another opportunity to reincarnate, to travel the world over in search of self-discovery. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a motivator. A

crucial lesson was not to bite off more than you could chew. You liked broad perspectives that didn't make such a big deal over the details. Expansiveness occasionally got you to overestimate your ability. Many times, a radiant self-confidence made you a winner anyway.

There were instances when you simply had to be that rogue or gypsy and cast away caution. A trickster was when you became too analytical. Usually you became a nervous wreck. Finding a way to balance a need for being the idealist with having reality-based perceptions was a key to clarity. You required many diversified experiences in your incarnations. You liked meeting people with captivating minds. Learning stimulating information or going to exotic locations made your brain synapses skip a beat. Communicating and exchanging belief systems with others was a definite high.

Node in 10th house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? Reaching for the pinnacle of success was what lit up your life regularly. If you feared failure it delayed your chances to get ahead. Another important theme was building a home life that was a source of your strength. A common concern was "how do I determine those roles that will make me happy?" When you didn't become overly consumed with work you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? Leadership positions pumped up your adrenaline. A chance to wield power did at times entice you. Management was a key expression. Your energy levels peaked when your ambition was awakened. If you sacrificed or ignored the people who loved you, you later paid the consequences. When balancing your private and public lives, it kept you on track as much as becoming a workaholic or isolationist was in many instances self-defeating. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks was raw persevering instinct mixed with a tinge of strong intuition, shaping your life with determination on one hand, and a window for mystery on the other. When using this wisely and patiently, life was colored with worthwhile milestones and dependable partners.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Scorpio:

The sign of Scorpio the scorpion lighted the mid-fall astrological skies at your birth in this life. Let's explore the significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Scorpio is "I penetrate". You had a repeating pattern of delving beneath the surface of things. Emotional intensity followed you from one incarnation to another.

Archetypes for Scorpio include the detective, researcher and even mystic. A probing set of eyes you displayed. An attraction to emotional crises and living near the edge did occur regularly. You exhibited a no nonsense mentality continuously. You really liked to scope out a situation before investing heavily in it. The taboos of your society didn't bother you all that much. Trusting someone did! Yes, it was close relationships that

pushed your buttons. Passion made you feel alive. Though you reached a point in many incarnations where peace of mind started to not seem so boring after all.

A cosmic principle at work through many of your lives was to get quite attached to what you felt belonged to you. This did make for some intense lessons if you tried to manipulate people. You found lovers or others didn't always respond positively to having power over them. When you were the object of someone else's manipulation, you could erupt angrily. You found ego strength in believing in your survival instincts. A great rebirth occurred when you found the courage to leave behind the past. Facing your shadows and fears made you a stronger person. You had a capacity to focus almost hypnotically on subjects of interest. Forgiveness of self or those closest to you taught you much. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting empowerment. This was a theme that ran throughout your incarnations and was a key to self-mastery. When you didn't run from challenges, you were a powerful force!

Sun in 11th house

You had solar power fueling your long-range goals in past lives. A futurist you often were labeled. Though at times you strongly objected to change if it conflicted with your beliefs. Institutions and you didn't always see eye-to-eye. You rebelled against authority you perceived as unjust. Your creative vitality was enlivened through engaging exchanges of ideas. You circulated amongst a wide variety of peers. Pride in your inventiveness was a regular theme. Unconventional thinkers either excited your mind or made it anxiety prone. This depended on your own needs. You could stubbornly persist on getting your own way.

If there was a challenge it was not becoming too aloof or unpredictable. Your next moves were hard for others to anticipate when you became unruly. People admired your individuality. They only wanted their own needs recognized and respected. In some lives you gave up your freedom too easily. This end of the spectrum didn't make you happy either. It was locating the midpoint between self-reliance and depending on others that worked the best. The inventor and trendsetter shined brightly through you. Sometimes these innovative instincts were readily available. In some lives it took a shock or unexpected experience to bring this forward in you. Your self-expression was ignited through going beyond everyday routines that dulled your senses. When you found refreshing life avenues, your insights guided you. You found fulfillment when embarking on a course that promised to bring you into the company of invigorating individuals and experiences.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Libra:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Libra. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual search for a soul mate followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in your past lives were linked by refined social skills and admiration for the arts.

Your inner landscapes were lined with an appreciation for beauty and serenity. Falling in love inspired you to be creative. It was important to you to find a like-minded person or at least someone able to accept your own beliefs. Indecision was a haunting and frustrating experience. Moon in 12th house

The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Cancer

Ambition came intuitively and gradually, says your past lives history, with Saturn placed in the cautious sign Cancer. Discipline was often understood intuitively. Accepting responsibility early happened more than occasionally. Loyalty to, and from family, was a serious belief. You liked a home that provided privacy and was in some respects a type of sanctuary from the world. Your family and private life were depended upon greatly for emotional support. Your greatest fear was a sense of insecurity. It sometimes drove you too far in proving yourself and to put too much time into activities you really cared little about. Saturn in 3rd house

Whether happy or sad, you wanted control over your immediate environment. Rigidity linked to your perceptions produced karmic woes. People liked you more when allowing divergent opinions. A fear of changing course got you into trouble. When you regained that stabilizing composure you enjoyed steady successes. Diversity kept you from getting bored.

A shadow was a fear of the unknown. Why? You liked to have solid footing. Clear definition in how to proceed is what you preferred, so you could slowly digest experiences as they came at you. It was a key to not ignore reality testing. Knowing the boundaries between taking a risk and playing it safe, were never far from the reach of your mind. A major redefining connected to your life strategies occurred regularly during lifetimes, often when you found that old plans just weren't as energizing as they once were. Wisdom came through the depth of your perceptive awareness that allowed you to see with great clarity.

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

Uranus in Libra

You had a tendency to weigh the consequences of future goals, indicates Uranus in the sign Libra. Your mind did switch to fast forward when you made a clear choice that you knew would bring you beneficial results. Your social life was as stimulating as they

come. Being out in the public made you feel alive. Being a loner wasn't likely, unless you became so eccentric that you alienated others.

Inventiveness was triggered by your partnerships. You found confidence in sharing your unique ideas. Your insights into the legal arena and the arts were powerful. Trusting your own discoveries was the real test before you talked yourself out of them. Maintaining a sense of direction kept you decisive and guided you toward doors that offered fulfilling relationships along with energizing new experiences.

Uranus in 12th house

In what way were you unconventional? Higher or spiritual beliefs were far different than the norm, actually downright mystical. You had futuristic vision that relied heavily on your intuition. It was through your faith that you reinvented yourself, which was often in the midst of dealing with a major crisis. A sense of direction was paramount in keeping you grounded. You had a tendency to drift away from reality. Going off on a tangent was your way of being an individual. You heard a calling that nobody else was listening to. You did need to watch that you didn't get so far out there that you became lost in causes lacking reality. You rebelled inwardly more than outwardly, unless becoming very passionate about an objective. Going into fast forward occurred when you fell in love. You didn't always pick the right partners due to unclear boundaries and dependency needs. Occasionally you were with a lover too needy and at other times you fell in love with unpredictable types. You liked the inspiration a soul mate provided. You were moody if perceiving that a new plan would stifle your creative spontaneity. Also, when someone's ideas clashed with your idealism, you sought to escape. Selfless service was fulfilling, but you did need to be careful if those receiving your best weren't deserving of this. You were inventive when you became emotionally disengaged, or mentally objective. Unique ideas flowed when you were at ease with a true feeling of purpose.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Sagittarius

You believed in ideals that took your imagination skyward. Your idealism was awakened through traveling to learning terrain, foreign to your upbringing. A burning exploring nature guided you to navigate the deepest waters of adventure. Inspiring others to look for greater truth was a natural part of you. You did need to be careful in not getting lost in unrealistic aspirations. Education was boring if it was too ordinary. You had the intuition of a dreamer, but could get down to business once you found the roads that gave you focus. Romance was forever pulsating through your psyche. Lovers with a stomach for flowing with spontaneous chasing of a new cause usually went over big with you. You liked finding a romantic partner sharing many of your highest values.

A major challenge was not failing to finish what you started. You ran out of gas if losing interest in a project. Even with relationships, you sometimes thought going where the grass was greener was better. When you became a good finisher, people liked you. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to be a person with a motivating message.

You tried to create a lifestyle free of as much conflict as possible. You found transcendental growth through having the faith to leave limiting situations by taking the risks that promised a better tomorrow.

Neptune in 10th house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to knowing how to perform roles, whether it was in the area of occupation, parent or leader. You were sensitive about being seen as doing great work. Though this doesn't mean you always could tune into this information or desired to. Glamorous professions or ones that could potentially bring fame mesmerized you. The strange thing is that so did causes that paid little other than emotional satisfaction. This duality existed side by side in many of your lifetimes. Your idealism encouraged you to try things that many wouldn't go near.

A test was not being swayed by too many opposing loyalties. In the end, this led to dreadful consequences. Your spirituality had a way of solidifying your strength. What was the biggest challenge? It was how you reacted to failure or not meeting your own expectations. Drowning your sorrows in the wrong things wasn't the answer. Another side of this coin was being afraid to make your abilities visible, as in stage fright. Faith transformed your denial into greater self-acceptance, and not to ask others to be too perfect. You searched for a purpose that gave you a clear awareness of reality.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Libra

Empowering yourself through developing key relationships was a past lives tendency. Exercising tact and wise judgments often got you to where you were trying to go. Getting too attached to a lover was sometimes a downfall. Charisma was shown when you felt extra comfortable in social situations. Instincts for knowing just the right thing to say made you sharp in business. It was in making challenging decisions that you met your true tests.

There was a shadow. What was it? You could get too dependent on others. This took the edge out of your own sharp perceptions for knowing what was in your best interest. When you weaned yourself away from relying too much on a friend or partner, your life seemed more liberated. Self-mastery was reached through marketing your creative instincts. You found rebirth or a sense of fulfillment when refusing to say yes when you meant no.

Pluto in 12th house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? You followed your idealism as far as it would take you. Acting on faith made you suddenly stronger than you thought. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through falling in love with a person or a cause. You had high expectations of life that weren't always easy to meet. Romance did take you out of the doldrums and onto higher plateaus. Your survival skills became

activated when people were trying to take away your dreams. This was hands-off territory. Without hope, you were as lost as they came. You depended heavily on lovers and friends for inspiration. A powerful self-examination manifested when you lost a lover or your idealism was crushed. It was then that you had to rally all of your strength to move forward. A compulsive tendency to grow addicted to a lover, or to a substance, threw your life out of balance and got you to ask thought-provoking questions. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations connected to losing yourself in various escapes. A lack of well-defined boundaries caused confusion in relationships. When you did some reality testing and got grounded, you found greater harmony.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon square Saturn

There was a clash between work and home. You experienced tension in finding time for both. If you became too controlling, people kept their distance. Sometimes you were just plain too serious. Disappointments stayed with you longer than many. Wanting what you couldn't have, meant you needed to become better at formulating a plan that was attainable. Letting go and trusting that life would give you what you needed didn't come easily. You instinctively knew how to be successful in business. A challenge was working smarter rather than harder. Relationships were more successful when dependency needs stayed clear. A rugged determination to ensure your sense of security was a reality.

Moon conjunct Pluto

Emotional intensity was never that far away. You had deep instincts to probe beneath the surface of things. Deep bonds were formed with those you loved. There was little forgiveness for many of your enemies. It was important to know whom you could trust. There were some secrets you never shared with anyone, as it was your way of maintaining power. Some declared you were possessive. Privacy was valued. Your survival instincts were strong. When you could let go of the past or make peace with it, you were lighter in spirit. Patience won you admiration.

Sun conjunct Venus

Relationships played a major role in your life. Being in love made you feel alive. Finding someone willing to let you be yourself was essential. Perhaps the biggest challenge was decisiveness. An attraction to exotic lovers didn't necessarily mean they were the right matches. It was a desire to share your life with a special soul mate that in the end was what added longevity to your romances. Equally important was finding a person with values you could relate to. Over indulgence in the good things on life's plate had to be watched.

Sun trine Saturn

You liked things that came easily, without great effort. It's not that you lacked ambition, it's only that you didn't want to sweat if not needing to do so. If you lacked drive, it was usually because you didn't want to take the chance on failing. You often recovered quickly from setbacks due to not taking yourself too seriously. Your management style was gentle and not so controlling.

Mercury conjunct Uranus

Your mind was often out in front of many contemporaries. Sometimes you were quite proud of your brilliance. But there were many occasions when disappointment set in, because your ideas were well ahead of your reality. An inventive streak had to find

numerous outlets. A fascination with new discoveries and technologies was a strong part of your past. Futuristic thoughts pulsed regularly through your brain. A nervous condition resulted if you became obsessively worried. Regaining your composure was a matter many times simply of slowing down. Anxiety came when you felt confined to conditions that were enslaving. You suddenly bolted to freedom when the spirit moved you. A rebellious tendency usually started early in life. You liked individuals not afraid to step out of the norm. You showed great insight in numerous instances.

Venus trine Saturn

You had at least one side of you that respected tradition. You were more inclined to trust friends and lovers that had common sense. Your relationships had a stabilizing effect on you. There was a pleasant demeanor you possessed that drew others to you. The longer you were committed to a lover or family, the more value you placed on these areas. What you lacked in ambition, you often made up for in meeting people encouraging you to go after your serious desires.

Mars trine Jupiter

You had a way of getting others wrapped up in your interests. Self-confidence made your luck. You had good fortune at times when the odds said you shouldn't. Taking risks was a constant temptation. You were better than most at gambling, but needed to know your limits. You were self-motivated and had a lively delivery when it came to sharing knowledge. Your optimism was contagious.

Jupiter square Neptune

Your faith could either be impeccable or be filled with holes of doubt. It was escapism that hijacked your happiness. Facing your shortcomings gave you the strength to deal with whatever came your way. You believed in love. Your romances were many. You found the greatest peace when realizing you could survive alone or with that special someone. There was a divine discontent with reality that either drove you to be creative or to become disillusioned. You detested limits. Whatever you could imagine you thought possible to accomplish. An intense desire to follow a spiritual path suddenly came upon you. There was conflict in chasing what the world offered and satisfying an inner longing for peace. You weren't easy to live with because you were so changeable in likes and dislikes. When you did become content, you had to stay grounded to really let the experience engulf you. Ideals inspired your creativity.

Jupiter square Node

Enthusiasm was no problem, but maintaining a sense of direction was at times. You had a habit of being distracted by indulgences that took away from your concentration. There was a tendency to get so devoted to other people's causes you forgot about your own. When you were decisive and disciplined, you could run circles around others and

get twice as much done. Your inspiring enthusiasm made others believe in themselves. If you had a lack of faith was when you suffered the most. You didn't care to be that disciplined. Routines made you uneasy. Painting the truth with various colors of convenience made those closest to you angry. Your willingness to make good on a promise was the best way to win back your friends. You did have an inclination to gamble.

Jupiter oppose Ascendant

Life was perceived to be a wide-open adventure, at least that's the way you wanted it to be. Your self-confidence was greatly impacted by the type of partners you attracted. Unfounded belief sooner or later needed sober reality testing. Sometimes you believed too much in others. Balancing your own needs with that of a partner was the challenge. You thrived on the stimulation of relating to others.

Neptune conjunct Node

You incarnated with a strong statement to make about your ideals. Looking for those paths that brought intuitive clarity was your main mission. In the way of this was getting sidetracked by people and causes that appealed to your blind faith. Learning how to distinguish what experiences promoted your growth from those that depleted it was a must. You were quite the dreamer and romantic. Searching for a soul mate and roles that best described you were heartfelt quests. You gave much to those you loved. Denial and escapism were temptations. Keeping these two tendencies in line made you a centered and grounded person. Your inspirational belief in others made them admire you.

Neptune square Ascendant

Finding out your true identity was a puzzle. This was due to being in search of expressing your highest ideals in many different ways. Reality wasn't what you liked facing. There was a tendency to escape rather than face problems. When you managed to deal with your issues, magnificent paths opened in romance and money. Sensitivity to criticism made you back off from people. You wanted so much to be liked. Your intuition worked well when you felt emotionally clear. It was fogged in times of confusion. Knowing how to keep your autonomy was halfway to finding fulfillment. You liked being needed but feared being too heavily leaned on. Keeping denial in check was wise.

Ascendant square Node

You had a tendency to either react quickly to taking advantage of an opportunity or to stew in a quandary. You felt conflict in trying to fight off strong willed individuals to pursue your own dreams. Being your own person wasn't comfortable if giving into the expectations of others continuously. Then again, if you always demanded your own way, nobody stayed your friend for all seasons. Finding the right roles that best expressed your

potential was a fight to the finish. This gave you strength. Patience was a key to making solid, well-conceived decisions.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.

Leo on 2nd house:

You preferred to know you had freedom of choice. Pride in what you owned was a common occurrence. Knowing you could have life on your own terms meant a lot to you. Flexibility was a challenge. When you showed willingness to compromise, life was smoother. You were more successful in partnerships when there were few strings attached. In other words there weren't hidden agendas. If there was something that led you astray, it was getting lost in physical desires. This was your way of coping with disappointment. Bigger meant better. Moderation was wise. Mixing pleasure and work was your best game plan. It was in your nature to want the best of both of these worlds.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.

Cancer on 3rd house:

You relied heavily on your intuition in perceiving the reality of situations. Your emotions sometimes fogged your seeing clearly. You did better when taking your time on the big decisions. A pattern of wanting to process before moving too rapidly was what you favored when possible to do so. Acting on impulse did occur when your feelings really got you to go for it. You were able to elicit strong emotional reactions from others through your ideas. People found you an unpredictable sort when your moods caused you to think spontaneously. If you manipulated by using the silent treatment it caused tension and confusion. You were sensitive about being critiqued. You released full creative power when you transcended a tendency to be too self-conscious.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.

Gemini on 4th house:

You had a restless nature to see what the world had to offer. Your creative mental power was reinforced when living in locations that allowed you to more freely express yourself. An inability to get focused was your big challenge. Your sense of security often depended on the degree of your mental and physical freedom. Living in places where the people were open to new ideas, made you feel more at home. You kept your emotional distance until getting to really know someone.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.

Taurus on 5th house:

A tenacious creative spirit played a big part in your success. Romance inspired you to be creative. You tended to be somewhat possessive of others. Learning to let others express their thoughts freely proved wise. Inspiring confidence in those you cared about made them trust you. Drives to be powerful caused some conflicts. Your steady determination often made you a success. You were at your best when showing a tremendous physical and psychological endurance to endure life's challenges. Pride caused distance from those you loved. When you acted more from the heart than a false show of strength, people supported you.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.

Aries on 6th house:

A fast work pace colored past incarnations. Paying attention to details didn't coming easily. Everyday life seemed to move too slowly. Making up your mind fast when solving problems was a past pattern. You were usually impatient with obstacles. You often did better when being able to channel this fiery energy at projects rather than taking it out on others. When you did develop the powers of concentration you were capable of longer commitments to expressing your talents. You had a habit of reacting angrily to criticism. Also, it was important that you didn't jump to conclusions in analyzing others. When you overcame a lack of confidence, life became wonderful!

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.

Pisces on 7th house:

Relationships were a panorama of splendor. They fascinated you! Defining your boundaries in partnerships was never easy. You did seek a soul mate intensely. Romantic encounters led to confusing circumstances. If you settled for vague definitions it got worse. When you didn't receive the love you sought, occasionally the emotional pain took you down self-defeating paths. What turned this tendency around? Your faith in self and a higher power was the usual remedy. Your partners ranged from individuals with vision to those with their eyes on escapism. You enjoyed great love when the two of you had similar values. Your expectations of people needed to adjust to a more reasonable level so that divine discontent didn't rule you. Sooner or later you began to see there was no perfect person. This often gave you the greatest clarity. When you put too much hope in others it didn't always yield the best results. When you carefully balanced your own needs with that of a lover or friend, life was more pleasant. Also, getting the giving and receiving in proper proportion was wise.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.

Aquarius on 8th house:

You needed to be your own person in relationships. You did better with lovers when you were self-reliant. If you or your partner leaned on the other too heavily, the harmony suffered the consequences. Power struggles with controlling people did occur. Those that were jealous of your free spirited ways could become adversaries. When you tried to get too bossy with independent individuals it often blew up in your face. A mutual respect for autonomy with a lover or friend made for more peaceful outcomes. Dealing with untimely losses did one of two things. It either stopped you dead in your tracks for long periods of time or propelled you forcefully ahead with great determination. A loss of direction felt like death. You found rebirth through discovering the paths that unleashed an unbridled passion for unique splendor.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.

Capricorn on 9th house:

A pragmatic philosophy governed much of your thinking. People with reasoning that lacked solid logic didn't usually capture your attention. This doesn't mean you had no idealism. Only that you responded better to those with sensible thinking. You had a sober belief system. Traditional rites and rituals were more readily accepted. Your commitment to ethics was strong. Staying positive in thought took you many more miles to your destinations than did self-doubt. Focusing excessively on what you lacked never did much for your mind. A healthy respect for failure combined with an optimistic flight pattern toward success, was a better path to go. You knew your limits, but were happier when not ruled by them. Taking carefully defined risks was what you liked.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.

Sagittarius on 10th house:

You never liked to feel confined in limiting roles Your self-confidence kept your options open, and occasionally defeated great odds against you. Where did you have difficulty? When you couldn't get focused or disciplined. A lack of commitment came when you wanted to try more than one thing at a time. You didn't always get focused real fast. When you did find your true paths, a tireless energy to go to the top did emanate. You did arouse the wrath of others when thinking you had all of the answers. Tolerance took you further. You detested taking orders, especially from people you didn't respect. You had a way of getting people to believe in you. When you followed through on promises you made, you kept more friends. Learning to keep exaggeration of your talents to a minimum proved wise. A positive attitude brought you good luck.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.

Scorpio on 11th house:

A slow and persistent approach to reaching future goals was how you operated. You had to warm up to new directions. There was a preference to process circumstances first

and then act later. Keeping your goals hidden from others gave you a sense of power. Your hopes vacillated between waning and waxing almost as fast as the Moon changed phases. Sensing your moods was how you instinctually prepared to make changes. Fighting for your freedom was not uncommon. Though when you rebelled with no true purpose havoc was the result. When people tried to mold you into someone else, you did resist fervently. Individuals who betrayed you didn't stay on your guest list. It was in not seeking revenge you showed wisdom. Dealing with possessive acquaintances could be tiring. You broke free from manipulative types more than once. Indecisive individuals didn't impress you. Those people with an intensity to make things happen excited you.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.

Libra on 12th house:

You believed that love was worth taking the risk. Falling in love was a real high and stimulated your creative thinking. You didn't have much use for being alone. Seeking a soul mate was often a number one priority. You were at times attracted to people with escapist tendencies. They couldn't face reality. Your faith was tested when love failed. You found great strength when able to move ahead, with or without a partner. You were happier when finding balanced relationships where neither you nor your lover had to do most of the compromising. You usually had to adopt tougher skin so other people's opinions didn't hurt your feelings. Sensitive you were. But a doormat not always so! You did overly idealize others until reality struck. Indecision felt like a curse. Acting on what you believed to be true made you happier than compulsively thinking about the possibilities. When you reflected calmly while life was testing you, and listened to your intuitive voice for additional clarity, you were on top of your game!

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Saturn retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had much to learn regarding flexibility versus rigidity. These two opposites were a sore spot of contention. A tendency to get extremely focused when you enjoyed a role was a past pattern. You were happier when feeling in control of your life. Knowing when to show vulnerability and when to show a tough set of armor was wisdom indeed! Some thought you lacked ambition. What they didn't see working behind the scenes was your inner search to find professions and directions that seemed worth the effort. An inclination toward becoming a one-dimensional workaholic was a potential trap. Remembering that life was a multidimensional panorama made for happier times. There was a need to steer clear of icebergs that brought depression and feelings of rejection. Responding with courage to your commitments lessened your

anxiety about them. It was in not letting fear keep you from the love and success you painfully wanted that you reached the highest of milestones.
