Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sew." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will

strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Leo

You had a history of expressing a dramatic passion. One of your key impulses was to seek out ways to shine. Your soul was normally on ready alert to reincarnate, energized through knowing the creative sparks were soon to begin. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a promoter. A crucial lesson was that it was okay to be determined, but

not with excessive force and arrogance. You attracted attention when you found self-confidence. Your actions inspired others to get moving. Believing in your ability ignited the ego strength needed to take you far.

When you didn't assume enough of your own power or individuality, you deprived yourself of great potential. A trickster was when you continually talked yourself into marching to someone else's drumbeat. Eventually you either rebelled or lost all of your momentum. Finding a way to balance playing a few of your own tunes while fitting into the melody of others was a key to your freedom. You needed equality and independence. Feeling the excitement of personal autonomy and having the impulse to be an inventor was stimulating. A fondness for new trends kept your thoughts pulsating in the future. You fell in love with individuals who appreciated your youthful and enterprising spirit.

Node in 1st house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? When you took the initiative to courageously put your ideas into motion, life rewarded you. You found that waiting too long to make decisions cooled your interest quickly. A common concern was "who am I?" When you didn't panic and start looking for too much of yourself in relationships, you more easily managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? The freedom to act spontaneously. You had leadership qualities that people perceived to have a potential for being decisive and strategic. Your energy levels peaked when you were in a competitive mode. Indecision is what took the punch out of you. You were more fluid in movement and happier when not worrying too much about how others would respond to your actions. If you became too self-focused your fans didn't stay as loyal. Being assertive kept you on track as much as becoming too attacking made you seem like an unruly warrior. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks, were daredevil instincts mixed with a tinge of weighing your options. When using them wisely and appropriately, life was colored with a never-ending, adventure-filled story.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Capricorn:

The sign of Capricorn, the goat, lighted the early-winter astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Capricorn is "I build". You had a repeating pattern tied to ambition. Slowly and methodically putting together a plan for success was a regular theme. You were usually someone seeking the structure that allowed you to feel secure. Change wasn't really a welcome sight in past incarnations unless you were the one controlling it.

Archetypes for Capricorn include the leader, authority figure and self-reliant one. You normally attracted responsibility early in life. The sooner you realized that you couldn't always be in control, the happier you were.

The cosmic principle at work through many of your past incarnations was a reality

oriented mind. This doesn't mean you never had a good time. You didn't trust possibility as much as the definite. Leadership roles influenced you to get good at managing your time. It was less stressful when you learned how to delegate. People tended to trust that you would do a job with conscientious effort. You found ego strength through gaining respect for the commitment you put into whatever roles you chose. Fear of failure was the greatest shadow. It held you back a time or two. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting focus. This was a theme that ran throughout your incarnations and was a key to self-mastery. It was when you acted with flexibility and even a teaspoon of vulnerability that good fortune smiled upon you.

Sun in 9th house

You had solar power lifting your adventurous mind to explore alternative realities in previous lives. A restless drive to travel far from birth was a repeating pattern. Your creative vitality was insatiable when you were intent on making your ideals come true. Communication and education were favorite interests. You were a good debater and could argue a point until others became exhausted. Pride in your beliefs was a trait. You were admired for your relentless search for truth and a broad vision.

If there was a challenge it was becoming too dogmatic and judgmental. When you became too narrow in scope, people weren't as fond of you. When you maintained a more eclectic approach, you were a real hit. The student and teacher shined brightly through you. It was your capacity to motivate others out of their doldrums that won you accolades. Travel was one way you kept your mind entertained and growing. It took you longer than many to learn discipline. It's only that you didn't want to be tied down to commitments that kept you trapped. Your self-expression developed quickly when you finally found your piece of the pie. You liked having a sense of humor. You found fulfillment when seeing your ideas gaining acceptance, and being true to your philosophical beliefs.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Sagittarius:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Sagittarius. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual urge to explore life from multiple directions followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a love of the foreign, and a high-powered belief system.

Your inner landscapes were colored by a strong faith, which sustained you through the tough times. Many called it luck, but didn't see how much effort you put into the positive. Freedom was a word you understood early. You sought after knowledge because it kept you young in spirit and near the heartbeat of developing new trends. Travel made you feel in touch with creation and helped develop your creativity. Writing and all forms of communication were in your soul.

You frequently lived in various locations. The gypsy in you was restless for adventure. Concentration and discipline were challenges. Overconfidence got you to bite off more

Moon in 9th house

Ascendant: Persona, Identity, Calling Card

Leo on Ascendant:

The Quest

Mercury: Communication, Perceptions and Logic

Mercury in Sagittarius

You were Mercurialized at birth through the sign of Sagittarius pointing to enthusiastic mental impulses in past lives. Your communication style was often blunt and to the point.

You did get into hot water by promising more than you could deliver. Decision-making wasn't that difficult, unless you were presented with too many options. Mercury in 9th house

Venus: Relationships, Values, Comfort.

Venus in Sagittarius

With the love goddess adorning you through the sign of Sagittarius at birth, you came from past lives where you repeatedly found love in places far from birth. Many people experienced you as symbolizing free-spiritedness and adaptability. Your social instincts were shaded with a hue of a talkative, entertaining storyteller, yet there was an

Venus in 9th house

Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity

Mars in Aquarius

What would a warrior planet in the air sign of Aquarius mean regarding your past lives? An innate fast-paced energy that wasn't afraid to do a somersault or two when pursuing your goals. Your initiating impulse was electrified by the excitement the future

awakened in you. Yesterday's dreams weren't nearly as important as tomorrow's possibilities. This didn't always go over well with those depending on you in the present. Then again your eccentric and unusual way of doing things made you unique. Could you exercise any patience? Yes, if someone could get a lasso around you long enough to get you interested in their way of thinking. There was a tendency at times to intellectualize so much that you didn't act on an idea. This was good when it turned out that foresight kept you out of harm's way. It backfired if you kept missing new opportunities. increase your earning power was a solid part of your past. Knowledge that could be turned into profit interested you. You liked to digest information slowly when learning. A positive attitude brought you greater abundance. Luck came through a steady persistence in making a dream come true. Watching nature performing with its panorama of colors and landscapes was your silent meditation. You felt more confidence when you had the buying capacity to get what you desired for pleasure or comfort. Travel relaxed your psyche and made your problems seem less relevant. You enjoyed people with common sense. Teaching art, dance or music was a regular occurrence. When maintaining a broad perspective you got to experience the benefit of a wider range of differing perspectives.

Jupiter in 4th house

A positive and enterprising outlook influenced you to seek adventurous living places. You tended to roam freely. At times you didn't lose any sleep over not having roots. However, eventually you did tire of being the gypsy and nomad, desiring to settle down. Spontaneity made you feel unrestricted by rules and the expectations of others. You did need to watch your own leaning on lovers or family to the extreme. It undermined your self-confidence. Travel to other lands broadened your understanding. Living far from birth was a pattern. Good fortune came through believing in those who loved you, and trusting your intuition.

The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Aquarius

Ambition came through you unexpectedly or in unusual ways, says your past lives history, with Saturn in the futuristic sign of Aquarius. Discipline was more a matter of finding those goals that kept you interested in fulfilling them. Long sustained efforts only were possible when you felt stimulated enough to see a plan through to the end. You had a unique talent in being able to combine the traditional and unconventional worlds into a harmonious expression. Your greatest fear was being limited to dead-end roads that gave you little chance to discover your own unique gifts. It sometimes took extra effort to force open a door that otherwise would have remained shut. You didn't like change if it meant toward a direction that repulsed you. But you did welcome new ideas when the old ones seemed outdated.

A karmic shadow was failing to change directions when it would have been wise to do so. You often defined yourself through cutting-edge professions, and as someone with a nose for future trends, though liking to keep one foot safely in the present.

Saturn in 7th house

What was your main focus? It was relationships, whether romantic or otherwise. You consistently asked at crucial points during an incarnation: how do I develop meaningful and mutually beneficial partnerships? Knowing your boundaries in relating to others gave you a sense of control. Rigidity in trying to change others sometimes produced karmic woes. The antidote was greater flexibility in this area, that is, when you were determined not to repeat the same old lessons needing to be learned.

A shadow was trying to overly please. Indecision was the result. You compromised yourself to the point of becoming confused. Clear definition in your expectations of others, and they of you, was important. Life taught you to be careful about commitments in that you needed balance. A fear of love was not the way to finding a soul mate. Though leaning too heavily on someone might get you into trouble. It was in learning how to create stable unions that you discovered fulfillment. A major redefining regularly occurred in lifetimes associated with reality testing. You needed to ascertain who were true allies. Wisdom came through being reasonable in your search for the right partnerships, and in seeing you couldn't make everyone happy all of the time.

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

Uranus in Capricorn

You had a tendency to be pragmatic concerning your future goals, indicates Uranus in the sign Capricorn. Your mind did switch to fast forward when your ambition awakened. You were an interesting sort when it came to traditions. In some lives you dared not break free from accepted thinking and refused to question societal trends. In other incarnations you found yourself fighting against the norm. You were less likely to be a disruptive force when believing you could make changes from within a system or institution.

Inventiveness was often displayed in the professions you chose. The difficulty was determining what type of work was best for you. You were not happy when stuck in any kind of role that you perceived to be limiting. Maintaining a sense of direction encouraged you to trust current commitments and enlivened your search for energizing new ones.

Uranus in 9th house

In what way were you unconventional? It was in the area of your highest beliefs. Your mind didn't care for limits, which got you into trouble now and then. You had futuristic vision when it came to sensing opportunities in greener pastures that allowed you to reinvent yourself. Restlessness needed to be channeled productively. Your goals were many and quite elaborate. The challenge was in knowing which to follow and when. A sense of direction changed as often as an unpredictable tornado, aligning itself with whatever was currently running through your mind. Your interests were numerous and eventually you tried to narrow the field. You were eclectic for the most part.

Argumentative as well. Freedom was defined by you as spontaneity. You didn't like your ideas to be questioned. You tended to rebel against limited minds and against those trying to impede your personal progress. Your ideals were sacred possessions that you didn't like infringed upon. You didn't like to look back at the past as it interfered with your momentum. You didn't find compromise something that came easily. Also, you fought the thinking of someone else if it wasn't congruent with your own. You sometimes became judgmental or preachy if you thought your own truths better than that of everyone else. You were inventive when developing an expansive plan that gave you a chance to incorporate all of your ability.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Cancer

You believed in ideals that gave you a greater sense of awareness. Your idealism was awakened through finding a family or community that supported your dreams. You were so concerned for the welfare of others that you denied yourself a few opportunities. There was divine discontent in not really knowing what location was best suited for you. It's that you were so sensitive to the energies in a region, that you needed time to digest the new one. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to have intimate connections with your closest allies. You enjoyed your privacy and expected others to respect this. You might even go off on a solo retreat. You found transcendental growth through making contact with your inner spirit and seeking outer experiences that mirrored the fulfillment you needed.

Neptune in 2nd house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to beauty and comfort. You were infatuated with each of them equally. It's not that every lifetime was filled with luxury and lavish ownership. You naturally tuned into serenity. You became mesmerized in wanting wealth or pleasure. Your idealism made you determined to find adequate outlets for cherished plans. There were times when you lost resources through unclear boundaries and in trusting the wrong people.

It was a test to feel grounded when you let go of the stabilizing things. Though you could be as solid as a rock when feeling the inspiration of your beliefs. Your spirituality brought you great abundance whether in gold or emotional fulfillment. You operated with great clarity when motivated by a drive to share your belongings with others. Love uplifted your self-esteem. It made you feel quite valuable. What was the biggest

challenge? In staying away from a poverty consciousness. You felt not deserving, or guilty, in regard to the good things life had to offer. Faith transformed your denial into a passionate search for uplifting meaning. You searched for a purpose that deepened your resolve for inner peace.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Gemini

Empowering yourself through researching growth-promoting information was a past lives tendency. You had a penetrating mind that could cut to the chase quickly in terms of ascertaining your options. Hungrily seeking learning material was a regular pattern. You sought after knowledge that might increase your earning power. You exhibited charisma through a witty intellect that knew a little about a wide range of subjects. Though there was a subject or two that found you going to the depths. A compulsively suspicious nature was sometimes a downfall. It was important that you did learn discrimination about who to trust. You only needed to be careful how far you took this trait.

There was a shadow. What was it? A constant preoccupation with criticizing what or who you couldn't control. When this tendency was modified, life was a happier possibility. You were an apt communicator. Writing and teaching were part of your past. You had a memory for facts. Self-mastery was discovered through not allowing yourself to settle for few options, while many presented themselves. You found rebirth or a sense of renewal when crossing over the boundaries of your fears into unexplored territory.

Pluto in 3rd house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? You believed that information was power. So you fed your mind as many facts as it could hold. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through overcoming negative thinking. You were a curious sort, wanting to know why people thought the way they did. You had great determination not to let anyone or anything interfere with your freedom of speech. What made you nervous were unexpected events that caught you off guard. You liked to have time to prepare for a change. A powerful self-examination manifested when you lost your mental clarity. A compulsive urge to question your own reasoning power got you to ask thought provoking questions. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations associated with becoming stuck in worn-out thought patterns, infringing upon your flexibility. Altering certain limiting perceptions freed your intellect, allowing a new revitalized you to be born.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon conjunct Mercury

Your mind had a special inner link to your feelings. This means you sometimes were quick on the draw when it came to perceiving what a situation was all about. It says that you did become fogged though if your emotions enlarged to the point that your clarity was blocked. You were an intuitive communicator. Your mind had a capacity to recall data others had long forgotten. Home was a place where you sought relief from problems. Moods and mental processes were fused together so tightly that it was necessary to take the time to objectively perceive reality. Balancing the intellect and feelings was a challenge.

Moon conjunct Venus

You had good instincts for handling your relationships. Partnerships made you feel greater security. Making sure that you got attached to the right types of individuals was the key. You didn't like prolonged stress. Family connections were strong. You felt a certain loyalty and sense of obligation in caring for those needing you. You vacillated between being a socially outgoing person to suddenly wanting privacy.

Moon oppose Pluto

You approached relationships carefully, not really opening up until long after meeting someone. Confidantes were carefully selected and tested for their trustworthiness regularly. You did form deep bonds with that special someone. However, there were always a few secrets. People found you mysterious, not easy to get to know. You liked figuring out what made others tick. You had deep inner strength, guided by a powerful intuition. An awareness of life's mysterious forces found birth, as you grew comfortable with your roles. Partnerships experienced power struggles. Relationships had a way of testing your psyche to the limits. Betrayal was the thing that hurt the most. When you did trust a lover, you were committed right to the end. Finding your own sense of power was crucial to being happy.

Moon trine Node

When you followed the instincts that guided you toward fulfilling your destiny, life was filled with abundance. There were occasions when you grew too complacent or satisfied before really getting to where you needed to be. Good fortune in the form of people or lucky happenings many times switched you onto the right track. It was your generosity and faith that attracted the best that life had to offer.

Sun conjunct Uranus

You were as free spirited as they come! Boredom was your biggest worry. Why? Because it didn't take you long to outgrow whatever you tried on for size. Inventive you were. New technologies either delighted you, or were perceived as something not to trust until they really proved their worth. Freedom was the air you breathed. You didn't feel life was worth living without it. An individualist you were, occasionally a revolutionary. Those acting out the role of dictator and authoritarian, were thorns in your side. Your unpredictability was either adored or detested. It didn't matter all that much to you. Unconventional ideas steadily streamed through your consciousness, many of them were ahead of your contemporaries. You craftily kept one foot safely out of everyday main stream thinking so your brainpower would stay alert. If you grew too unruly or sarcastic people tired of you. You had a vivid sense of direction that not everyone else understood. The future was godly in your mind.

Sun oppose Neptune

Relationships have tested you as much or more than anything. Finding a soul mate was intoxicating, making you feel on top of the world. The trick was not denying your feelings. Falling in love with what appeared to be pretty and lovely wasn't always what was being hidden deeper down in the package. You were more successful in partnerships when learning to take a second look before committing. In some lives, it was not easy to be with anyone. You were pulled away by dreams. Pursuing what you saw as magical or inspirational felt like a calling. Over-sensitivity held back your talents, fearing people could see right through you. Destiny seemed to bring you into the company of those able to help you reach the highest plateaus. Though being careful in whom you believed in proved wise.

Mercury conjunct Venus

Sharing ideas was a way to learn more about the world in which you lived. A natural curiosity about people was never far from your thoughts. You needed to watch out for growing too preoccupied with worry and becoming too critical. Getting distracted by business did dilute your remembering to have a good time. You enjoyed individuals with common sense and still knew how to celebrate. Visiting new environments was stimulating, and a way to spice up your life.

Mercury oppose Pluto

Relationships brought out your mental intensity. You sized people up as fast as a cat's eyes adjust to the dark, and that's fast! People watching was fun as you tried to figure out what motivated them. You took your time in really letting down your guard. Manipulating situations did occasionally backfire. When it came to lovers and friends it was better to talk straight. You had certain secrets never shared with anyone unless it was a close confidante. Mystery and intrigue surrounded you. Balancing a need for privacy with a fondness for stimulating exchanges with others was required. You possessed a mental toughness that helped you survive loss or a crisis. Processing your interactions with individuals took considerable time. Forgiving someone tested your courage. Letting go of hurtful past memories was freeing. Meeting thought-provoking people started you on a road to an incredible rebirth.

Venus oppose Pluto

You lived and died many times in a lifetime because of relationships. Romance made you feel alive and passionate. It had a hurtful quality as well. Betrayal was what was devastating. When you did find that magic someone, life couldn't have been better. You liked attention or feeling valuable. It was the jealousy and power struggles that were tough. The mysteries of life captured your fascination. You explored things that many just didn't notice or take the time to investigate. Your values were near and dear to you. It felt like a death when your abilities were not acknowledged. It was a type of rebirth when you found the avenues that replenished your spirit.

Venus trine Node

Your values and life aspirations were usually in sync. There was good fortune in making meaningful friendships. Lovers either shared many of your beliefs or tolerated the differences. Your professions symbolized the harmony you cherished. There was a need to reach back for courage when an obstacle stood in your way. The mysterious forces of the universe sent people and inspiration your way as needed. You only needed to maintain a creative and energetic vision to find peace and comfort.

Mars square Jupiter

Your actions tended to draw strong reactions. Waiting for just the right time wasn't your way. Too much confidence made you take chances that defied the odds. Sometimes you won anyway, and there were times you lost big. Gambling was in your blood. Playing it safe never entered your mind. Senseless arguing without any clear purpose wasted a lot of time and energy. You got your best mileage out of this one when you were moving toward a purpose. It was then that you had amazing energy to pour into your favorite interests. Exaggerating your potential was not so wise. People believed in you when living up to your promises. Restlessness was immense. You traveled and studied ferociously to stay preoccupied.

Mars conjunct Saturn

Getting along with authority figures was usually a great test. Being assertive ran in the extremes. In some lives you were geared more toward not being very direct. Yet, in others, you were quite aggressive. Somewhere in the middle was where you needed to be! Fear either pushed you to move forward or stopped you frozen in your tracks. Learning how to take that first small step toward accomplishing something was perhaps the biggest challenge. Discipline and focus came after finding those interests that you deemed worthy of your time. You weren't sure how to deal with anger. But you felt better when getting things off of your chest. Trying to control others by making them fear you never brought them closer. Though when you wanted someone to be afraid of your bark rather than your bite, you knew how to do it.

Mars oppose Node

When you incarnated, the world began to set up those experiences that were destined to test your courage. You looked for your identity in painstaking ways. It was surprising to find out that the inward struggles were the hardest. You wanted to be needed by others. It made you feel important. You had a strong desire nature. There was intense productivity when you were able to harness your energy levels. Conquering the shadows within was liberating. You liked to deal with challenges swiftly, getting them behind you just as fast as possible. Patience with yourself and others was perhaps your greatest teacher.

Mars trine Midheaven

People thought you to be easygoing, but underneath that smooth exterior, was often a fast paced strategist. As a leader you won loyalty by being a straight shooter. Those in positions of power saw you as a unifying energy. You had an impatient streak that often sparked you to be assertive and even creatively adventurous.

Jupiter square Saturn

Happy one day and sad the next. This was a pattern in some lives. You lived in extremes. Finding that place in between great joy and sober reality was the challenge. You had high expectations. Authority figures clashed with your optimism. You needed to be careful not to automatically dash someone else's hopes and dreams with negativity. The work world got you to pin many of your dreams on it. This worked fine when you were a success. It was depressing when you failed. Having beliefs that sustained you in the lean seasons was paramount in importance. You had a conflict when you dreadfully feared losing. Taking small clear steps toward a plan often delivered the best results. Not taking yourself so seriously helped. Learning to live in the moment rather than making delayed gratification your god opened the door to happiness. Becoming disciplined with an understanding that enjoying the journey was just as important as the result saved you!

Jupiter square Node

Enthusiasm was no problem, but maintaining a sense of direction was at times. You had a habit of being distracted by indulgences that took away from your concentration. There was a tendency to get so devoted to other people's causes you forgot about your own. When you were decisive and disciplined, you could run circles around others and get twice as much done. Your inspiring enthusiasm made others believe in themselves. If you had a lack of faith was when you suffered the most. You didn't care to be that disciplined. Routines made you uneasy. Painting the truth with various colors of convenience made those closest to you angry. Your willingness to make good on a promise was the best way to win back your friends. You did have an inclination to gamble.

Saturn oppose Node

Control issues followed you from one incarnation to another. This means you either became too dictatorial or didn't act responsible enough. Balancing dependency needs was the key to happiness. You were very driven to succeed. Depression snared you if you became too down over a failure. Rejection chilled you right to the bone. Love was good to you when being reasonable in what you expected. Clearly defined commitments kept you grounded and happy. Trust took time to establish. Allowing yourself to be taken advantage of didn't yield good results. Authority figures sometimes were at odds with your most serious ambitions. When you did feel understood it was very reassuring. Leadership roles exposed your vulnerability as they made you need help from others.

You were wise to cultivate solid friends that could be trusted. Learning from past experiences was one of your best teachers.

Saturn trine Midheaven

Your sense of timing was better than most. You were not in the habit of forcing the outcome of situations. Ambition was expressed with an ease that in some respects hid your real intensity.

Uranus oppose Neptune

Relationships either brought you to a greater sense of clarity or caused you confusion. You liked exchanging ideas with someone as a way of gaining objectivity. It was important that you didn't go chasing so compulsively after love that you forgot your sense of direction. When you stayed reasonable in expectations of others, life was more pleasurable. You had a powerful imagination. Staying grounded kept you focused. When you trusted your intuition, you tuned into the future. Having inspiring dreams to live for kept you thinking positive and creatively.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.

Cancer on 2nd house:

You showed an inclination to play it safe. This doesn't mean you never took a risk, only that you made sure they were well-calculated ones. There were times you missed out on a few opportunities by not moving forward fast enough. You needed warm-up time to adjust to change. You tended to be a bit clingy in relationships, but not necessarily possessive. You let go more when lovers gave you no reason to be concerned about a commitment. Your emotions intensified when your sense of security was threatened. Loyalty to friends, family and lovers is what kept them close. Family and home were highly valued.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.

Gemini on 3rd house:

A fast paced mental nature was a key feature. Ideas had a way of spinning through your brain quickly. Boredom with life when it grew too predictable occurred. Changing directions too much before finishing what you started was a challenge. Travel was a way to keep you mentally stimulated. The world of books entertained you. A curiosity about

life was a trait. Adapting to new circumstances is something you did rather successfully. You welcomed change if it promised hope or the possibility of new options. Your perceptions about people and life in general often surprised others. Being a catalyst for change gave you a feeling of self-importance.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.

Taurus on 4th house:

Developing a stable inner sense of security and relaxed home atmosphere was something you desired. Some accused you of being a bit possessive. A calm inner stability came when you felt in control of your life. It's not that you didn't like surprises, but preferred the ones that were more pleasing to the heart and mind. You found it essential not to let stress get the best of you.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.

Aries on 5th house:

A powerful creative drive colored past incarnations. Your ego was bruised when you saw your creations being ignored. An innate drive to be the center of attention was a regular pattern. You had several lives that featured a ferocious competitive spirit. An endless energy to express yourself blessed you. You were lost when living out meaningless roles. You became bored when not challenged. Love made you feel on top of the world. Entering relationships quickly was a past lives tendency. You took it personally when lovers or friends didn't openly cheer you on in life. You didn't always pace yourself. Your hunches about investments sometimes lacked reasoning. But at the same time your courage in taking risks sometimes paid off.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.

Pisces on 6th house:

You had high expectations. It doesn't mean you were always a perfectionist. But sometimes perfection haunted you. It was realizing when you had done enough on a project or task that was the key. You were very devoted to learning new skills, once you discovered the directions you needed to be pursuing. You didn't always rely on your intuition enough. It was integrating your powers of analysis with your feelings that made for a challenge. Too much dedication to causes that gave you little in return was a potential downfall. You did learn a few lessons about reality testing as life went on. You hated criticism. It stopped you from really showing your true talent. Your faith did allow you to climb over a few hurdles now and then. If you grew very disappointed in people, it did cause you to drown your sorrows in negativity. You didn't like facing reality all that much. Balancing idealism and pragmatism was a challenge.

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.

Aquarius on 7th house:

Your relationships were customarily unpredictable. You were attracted to individualists. The types of partners were as varied as possibly could be. Even peers came from a wide array of backgrounds. You liked individuals with progressive minds. People stating the obvious didn't hold your attention. An attraction to individuals fighting limiting traditions did occur. Freedom in your partnerships was a strong drive. You rebelled against those trying to limit it. Definitely you were not so comfortable being ruled by a need to act politically correct. Your usual thought pattern was that love wasn't a permanent guarantee. So it was a good idea to make the most of the moment! You were experimental in relationships. You transcended the boundaries of what a society deemed as acceptable. You didn't always fit what the rules defined as okay. Questioning authority happened regularly. Equality in partnerships was essential to your happiness.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.

Capricorn on 8th house:

You were quite cautious with your money. You liked to know where every dollar was going. This didn't always warm the heart of your romantic partners. You preferred mates that could either understand your logic, or let you control the assets. If you grew too tight with your money, lovers became angry. Wastefulness was something you didn't tolerate too well. Power struggles occurred when you refused to negotiate. You usually felt pushed toward success. Your ambition was at times intense. You attracted responsibility as much as a sweet smelling flower pulls in the bees. When you stayed clear of too much rigidity, your relationships were more flowing. Showing emotions wasn't easy. Hurt feelings tended to stay with you. You did become tough skinned so that you weren't easily talked out of your goals.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.

Sagittarius on 9th house:

You loved to travel. You didn't believe there was necessarily one absolute truth in solving life's dilemmas. Your philosophy tended to be eclectic in nature. Drawing from a wide range of knowledge was your style. People either liked your bluntness or detested it. It didn't really bother you one way or the other. You were wise when not thinking too narrowly. When you became too judgmental your vision was fogged. You were normally a restless soul. You didn't like feeling down for long. You only grew lazy if clouds of boredom settled over you. Fatigue and loss of direction were more the result of not finding any inspiration. Though you could rekindle that spark in a flash. You liked to sway the minds of others through persuasive speech.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.

Scorpio on 10th house:

You were a no nonsense type. Work was not to be taken lightly in your eyes. Life had to be on your own terms. This means you were not going to be forced without quite a fight into doing things against your will. You usually carried yourself with a powerful presence. You found your way in the world with a ferocious determination. If your ambitions met with resistance, you took this quite personally. You came back that much harder with a persistent effort to succeed. Controlling behaviors didn't make you popular, nor did the bossy ones. You enjoyed showing others that you could take care of yourself. People did sometimes envy your life. When you generously helped those in need, you were admired. When the chips were down, you grew that much stronger. Adversity brought out your strength. Power struggles occurred either due to people trying to manipulate you or because you were attempting to display your own sense of self-mastery. You needed to balance a tendency to being consumed by work. Forgiveness was the key to getting things back on track in your relationships.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.
Libra on 11th house:

You had a tendency to weigh your options carefully before moving forward. This doesn't mean you had no sense of direction! It is just describing the way you liked to mull things over before proceeding ahead to reach goals. It was frustrating if you allowed others to talk you out of things you needed for yourself. You depended heavily on the input of friends. Learning to tune into your intuition sometimes gave you clearer vision. A lover was a disruptive force occasionally, especially if you looked for too much of yourself in the relationship. Love aroused your passion to go after the future, but could be so unpredictable it caused you to lose your way. You were sensitive about getting support from those closest to you.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.
Virgo on 12th house:

You showed a realistic approach to expressing your ideals. This doesn't mean you were never intuitive or refused to act on faith. It only means your subconscious tendency was to think first, and believe later. Perfection was a nagging voice in your head. It served you well when it came to performing with excellence. However, it tormented you when you couldn't accept that your best efforts were good enough. You got too lost in following others causes. A clash between your mind and feelings did occur. You dealt with this in two ways. Either denying you had feelings or boldly letting others know just how you felt. A fear of making a mistake was frustrating. Whenever you had the faith not to let self-doubt rule you, life sent you great abundance. When you kept from surrendering too much power, you were happier.

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Mercury Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in keeping your thoughts positive. Your analytical side was well developed more often than not. A tendency to instinctively rethink your decisions was a trait. Knowing when to stop trying to perfect a task was essential to your happiness. You became nervous if rushed into decisions. Instant recall of facts happened when you least expected it. There was a need to feel like you could control the pace of your mind. You weren't bothered by information overload, as long it was facts of your choosing, or preference. The challenge was to stay clear of becoming compulsively negative in your thinking. When you felt mentally at ease and clear, life seemed good.

Jupiter retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in not foolishly believing in the wrong things or people. When you were on target and accurately assessing situations, you were a dynamo of efficiency and inspiration. Another challenge was in the area of confidence. When you lost faith it took the wind out of your sails. The search for an expansive enough vision was an innate drive. People didn't respond as well if you preached dogma or grew too judgmental. When you kept an open mind there was less friction. You had a capacity to embrace a positive outlook, that is, if self-doubt didn't seep into your thinking. Another challenge was running too fast to where the grass might be greener, running away from facing problems. The optimist in you needed to know limits. When you walked with commonsense and put your ideas into worthwhile actions, the world had no choice but to eventually give into your needs for self-discovery.

Neptune Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you needed to watch out what you asked life for. Do you know why? Because you were apt to get it! A tendency to have a strong intuitive quality was a past pattern. In some incarnations you were quite the poet, artist, entertainer or mystic. Perfection wasn't so nice to you in that divine discontent was troublesome, making it a challenge to be satisfied. When you were reasonable or grounded, life was simpler. Getting focused occurred after becoming inspired. There were times when you had premonitions of things to come. This either gave you great faith or was scary. The more you accepted your sixth sense, the easier it was to express outwardly. Another challenge was achieving discipline and utilizing reality testing. When you made a commitment not to run away from conflict, you found clarity. When letting your ideals guide you, life seemed more magical and full of inspiring symbols. Belief in a higher

power sustained you through many tough challenges. Lovers were inspirational in stimulating your creativity. You liked the idea of a special someone with whom to share your dreams. Developing a spiritual understanding and a sacred place within kept you walking on the straight and narrow with great awareness, pointing you to pleasurable escapes, and kept you guilt-free.

Pluto retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern to know your way around Intensity Street. In some lives you were overpowering. In others, you didn't usurp enough power. Having a sense of empowerment was crucial to reaching self-mastery. Survival instincts you possessed. Being emotionally intense was a past pattern. Learning to communicate your feelings made you easier to understand. Self-honesty was liberating but it was a test to admit your faults. Defensiveness had to be conquered. You didn't believe in going halfway when exploring a subject. Compulsive lusts for riches and leadership sometimes brought out your worst manipulative traits. You were happier when feeling inwardly secure and having allies that you could trust. You had to beware of an urge to win at all costs. You found rebirth through not fearing your own shadows, and being big enough not to run from those you loved. You processed experiences long after they occurred, revisiting the past often, healed when able to embrace forgiveness.
