## **Astrological Midpoints**

### **History of Midpoint Combinations**

What is a Midpoint?

The use of midpoints historically goes back to 1200 AD when Guido Bonati, a famous Italian Astrologer, used half sums, otherwise known as midpoints, in his interpretation of a chart. More recently at the turn of the century, Alan Leo, a famous American Astrologer, used midpoints along with solar arc directions. I personally have no knowledge of the use of midpoints combined with the 90-degree dial prior to its use by Reinhold Ebertin and Alfred Witte at the beginning of the Nineteen Hundreds. The history of solar arcs on the other hand, goes back to Ptolemy who used primary directions in the second century.

A midpoint is the center between any two points, which in Astrology relates to the center between two planets and/or personal points, including the Midheaven, Ascendant, and the Nodes. This center point is the meeting of planetary energies that becomes active through the process of growth, relating to the passage of time. We relate to the aspects formed by the heavenly bodies through spatial relationship. This system as I mentioned earlier goes back to Reinhold Ebertin who, near the turn of the century developed this system along with Alfred Witte by taking a 360-degree wheel and breaking it down into a 90-degree dial. Ebertin believed that hard aspects created events in one's life thus; the use of the 90-degree dial became a viable tool for forecasting future events. Ebertin started by placing the planets into three sections -- 30 degrees for Cardinal Positions which include: Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn points; 30 degrees for Fixed Positions which include: Taurus, Leo, Scorpio and Aquarius points; and 30 degrees for Mutable Positions which include: Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius and Pisces points.

This system can be seen on the 90 degree dial as 0 to 30 degrees as Cardinal, 30 to 60 degrees Fixed and 60 to 90 degrees as Mutable positions for the planetary points to be placed in accordance of their quality.

### **How to Use this System**

This system can be used to add great insight into the interpretations of the natal chart through the use of delineation of transits, progressions, solar arcs and degree arcs. In fact it can be used in almost any interpretive form of astrology where timing is added into the equation. Timing is where this type of Astrology becomes very precise and accurate. The best way to use this system is to incorporate the natal midpoint along with the time that its energy becomes activated by directing the planets into the future. This is done by

Solar Arc, which is the distance it takes for the Sun to move from one day to the next at the time of one's birth, which is approximately 59' to 1 degree 2', which is then added to the age in question. We can also use degree arcs, known as age arcs, which is equivalent to one degree equals one year, times the number of years old you are now and/or when the specific event in question occurred. It may sound difficult, but it's not once you become familiar with this system of delineation. When using this tool you will notice that I have included health interpretations along with dietary issues, which often come up when there is a lack of good nutrition or assimilation of nutrients. This can be seen easily through the activation of the natal midpoints on the 90-degree dial. Thus, I included medical interpretations in most of the midpoint structures.

Each midpoint structure has many meanings, so I have narrowed it down to the most important interpretation of each of them based upon my years of past experience. These interpretations are done in the higher and lower, or shadow manifestations. We are all on the earth plane of existence, thus no matter how enlightened we may seem, we still have to deal with our shadow. Many midpoints include births, health areas and transitions and only a part of what is said may apply to you personally. But on the other hand the whole interpretation may apply. I have included the positive and negative side of each of these midpoints so as to reach all probable outcomes.

Many times there will be others who are read through one's personal chart, since these people become the players in one's personal movie. These players include midpoints with:

Moon	=	Mother and the Feminine principal
Saturn	=	Father/Business Associates, masculine principal
Mercury/Mars	=	Brothers and Male Relatives
Mercury/Venus	=	Sisters and Female Relatives
Sun/Node	=	Children
Venus/Uranus	=	Female Friends
Mars/Uranus	=	Male Friends
Jupiter	=	Grandparents

Relationships include almost any midpoint, which involves the Sun, Moon, Venus and Mars combined with the personal points, Asc, Mc, Moon and Node and always be aware of the rulerships of these positions.

## Your Birth Chart: Midpoint Combinations

The natal midpoints represent our birth traits, our strengths, weaknesses and potential for personal growth. Each midpoint could involve others who are part of our life's path. Thus, a natal midpoint may apply to family and friends as opposed to the energy being directed to the self. Likewise, the medical influences and health issues mentioned are often manifest by others in our lives as opposed to the self. The possible medical problems, as well as the "shadow side" of a midpoint may never become an active manifestation of the midpoint's energy when addressed early. Keep an open mind when reading the interpretations of a midpoint since they are geared to both the higher and lower manifestations of the energy, and be aware that medical references should not be treated as a diagnosis. Psychological or physical symptoms or problems should be directed to the appropriate professional for diagnosis and evaluation. The timing of the events indicated by these natal midpoints are activated by progressions, directions and finally transits as the final touch off point sometime in the future.

### **Moon=Jupiter/Midheaven** Natal

The happy woman who loves her home and family is a representation of this energy. It relates to a move up in the world to a larger home and/or expansion within one's personal environment. It gives large breasts in a woman's chart, and/or it relates to breast augmentation. Either way, one has a great capacity to nurture and/or to being nurtured. This is present for people who feed many others; an example might be a family-owned restaurant or grocery business. One has the capacity to be joyous along with the ability to have a great depth of feeling for another. This also relates to traveling back to see one's homeland, and/or to organize a family reunion.

### **Sun=Moon/Pluto** Natal

Energetically this relates to emotional events and/or an intense psychological drama being played out. There can be seeing each day as new and different from all of the others. There is the capacity to love life to the utmost and be able to stay in the present moment; thus, it is a time of deep psychological awareness. This relates to a person who has a profound effect on their environment along with capabilities of being a healer and/or advisor on a psychological level. The best use of this energy is to listen and reflect on what is the higher truth being said.

### **Sun=Mars/Saturn** Natal

The person who identifies with power, restrictive power, or controlled energy -- energy that is controlled by another -- is a manifestation of this energy. There's the capacity to be the source of energy that is being used to control something and/or someone, or there may be a parent who is controlling or a boss who restricts one's personal actions or activities. Thus, there can be a snapping back and/or trying to return the negative energy back to its source. One may have physical strength due to feeling more the warrior and/or needing to take the warrior pose, thus having athletic abilities. At its strongest, a superior athlete is born. Usually one could be the center of attention and known for his or her constructive use of energy, thus being identified as a builder of many different types of structures. There can also be a parent who has circulatory issues. The most important lesson this energy has to offer is to become more responsible for one's personal actions and be able to respond on time thus tai chi would be a good form of meditation in motion to help balance out one's energy.

**Sun=Midheaven/Ascendant** Natal

One can have a strong sense of self along with personal self worth. They are dedicated to being successful in life, as this is a very successful period of opportunity. There is usually a strong physical body or there can be working on attaining the picture of health. There may be attraction to someone whom one feels will complete them, thus this relates to marriage. This also denotes healthy unions based on the merging of both identities, the physical and spiritual sides of a person.

**Mercury=Sun/Venus** Natal

There is the desire to talk about love and to make plans that would involve the relationship/partnering with another. With this, there's an ability to listen to another's point of view and/or the process of understanding what someone else has said, giving ease with communications. It represents artistic skills through the use of the hands, and brings happiness and blissful thoughts where everything seems to be looking up in the world. This is also a time where decisions can go in one's favor.

**Mercury=Sun/Uranus** Natal

A high degree of intelligence, such as being an inventor or seeking higher knowledge, is one of the manifestations of this. It represents the one who knows as well as having the capacity to study technical subjects with ease. There can be a sibling who has a high degree of intellect or is rebellious in nature. This is also known as the clairvoyant or the intuitive astrologer, and potentially the technical writer.

**Mercury=Saturn/Neptune** Natal

One can organize their thoughts in advance of acting upon them now. There may also be a depressed way of thinking, and sometimes with good reason. This can also cause substance abuse issues for a sibling and/or chronic problems that seem unending for one's self. Many times there are deep psychological issues that need to be addressed and there needs to be an extensive overhaul of one's way of

thinking. Medically, this rules weakening in the arms, hands, and/or joints, thus, this may be present with carpal tunnel syndrome. It also relates to lung disease due to heavy smoking, which went on for years.

**Venus=Moon/Midheaven** Natal

Personal advancement in one's career due to the help of others can happen. One has the ability to financially succeed in business along with sharing one's success on a professional level. There's interest in beauty as a career, possibly through apparel, cosmetics, or by becoming a hair stylist, artist, interior decorator, and/or even being a model. Many times people get married with this and work with their partners in a family business. One can meet their future mate now, thus, relating to conception of or birth of a beautiful child, usually a girl.

**Mars=Mercury/Venus** Natal

One may have success in the communications due to their ability to be aggressive and yet possess pleasant mannerisms. There can be a strong sense of diplomacy when dealing with another person's anger. There can also be conversation about sex or being jealous over another's sexual nature. Many times this manifests in the ability to be very sensuous in the way one communicates their sexuality. This relates to online dating or relationships that are phone based.

**Mars=Saturn/Node** Natal

Overcoming obstacles with created by others and feeling the one's energy is being usurped is a manifestation of this energy. There can be a forceful separation or feeling of loss and sadness with another. This relates to a group of men joined together for a common cause like builders, soldiers, or any work force where there is a lot of joint physical energy used to get the job done. Medically this rules the gall bladder which relates to the saying, "The gall of that person". It also represents sustained anger kept just beneath the surface for an extended period of time eventually causing dis-ease, so just say what you mean and mean what you say.

**Mars=Uranus/Pluto** Natal

This is a highly volatile energy wielded suddenly with intention. It relates to a sudden need for surgery, acts of violence, or extreme energy needed in competitive sports, or bodybuilding. This also relates to sudden accidents or major mistakes being made surgically. Medically this influence rules the eliminative systems in the physical body, as well as a desire to have facial plastic surgery to improve one's exterior appearance, thus relating in a rejuvenative effect.

**Jupiter=Neptune/Node** Natal

The gambler and/or being involved in a con game is a representation of this energy, thus there is a tendency to have unrealistic expectations which are hidden by one's hopes of winning big. One may be highly spiritual, linking them with others who have the same aspirations. There could also be travel with others to a foreign land, or the land of one's heritage. Medically this rules the liver as in hepatitis, caused possibly by an incorrect belief system.

**Saturn=Venus/Node** Natal

One can evaluate how well they can connect with others. But on the other side, this can become a "disconnect" period due to going in the opposite direction from those who are around and no longer have the same values. Thus, there is no longer a connection due to having dissimilar goals. This also relates to having a feeling of separation from others due to changes in the career or health challenges.

**Saturn=Uranus/Node** Natal

Career changes shared with others are one of the manifestations of this. It gives the need to change a pattern which has become boring or needs to be changed to bring in new energy. Sometimes these changes are fast and sudden, happening without warning. An example of this would be a shared layoff, or getting a new boss. This also relates to sudden earth changes which are experienced with others. The father and his health come to light with this, possibly causing problems in the heart or circulatory system. There can also be sudden changes in a man's career direction.

**Uranus=Sun/Midheaven** Natal

The career changing direction many times due to the need for more personal freedom is a reflection of this energy, and not wanting to be tied to a 9 to 5 type of job. There is usually a desire for personal individuation in the career, which gives one more of a specialty in the work environment. There can be moving from one place to another for job security, and also many unexpected life changes which affect one's long-term goals. This represents revolutionary ideas and the application of advanced state-of-the-art knowledge, which can manifest in an interest in the computer industry or anything considered high tech or advanced technologically.

**Uranus=Pluto/Midheaven** Natal

Sudden changes within one's career or long-term goals is a manifestation of this. There is a determination to change the present set of circumstances for something new, or the desire to be state-of-the-art. This is present for researchers or people who have lots of different forms of communication coming in all at once. This also relates to sudden changes within a friendship which allow one to grow and manifest easily due to the joint energy or combined resources.

**Neptune=Uranus/Midheaven** Natal

There is a need to be more on the spiritual path and to apply that knowledge in one's employment. One has a strong intuitive nature combined with artistic skills, but on the shadow side of this, there can be a lack of career direction or a weakened sense of self, resulting in no direct intentions. Medically, this relates to immune disorders as well as a weekend drive to succeed in life.

**Pluto=Moon/Mercury** Natal

There are deep connections from the past that link family members together. One has the potential for intense communications that could be transformational, as well as the capacity to love deeply. There is a feeling of being very expressive with one's emotions. Many times there can be transitions of female relatives and

this relates to the potential birth of a sibling. There may also be the capacity to make necessary dietary changes and stick with them, thus eliminating toxicity in the diet. This denotes a powerful mother and/or female in one's life who has transformational abilities, especially in the healing arts.

**Node=Mercury/Saturn** Natal

One has the desire to have better communication with relatives and to connect with others that are studying or learning a difficult subject. This relates to difficulties dealing with an uncle and/or sibling. One has the capacity to connect with a group whose goal is to promote better communications. There can be associations with people who have been depressed over habitual issues and want to make a change in their patterning. The best way to use this energy is to choose your associations wisely being careful not to be used by others.

**Node=Jupiter/Ascendant** Natal

People joining together to form a harmonious union through social activities is a representation of this energy, along with abundance shared with others. There can be a birth of a loving child who brings people together within the family. One can meet new people sharing knowledge with others who are considered influential in the community. This also relates to luck and harmony and connects one with others of equal good fortune.

**Node=Midheaven (Professional Associations)** Natal

The Node/MC joins people together on a professional level to attain mutual goals. It brings in connections that help one manifest their dreams and visions of success. There is a tendency to associate with people of similar interests. On the other side of this energy one may associate with others that prevent the attainment of personal goals. This may also bring in a relationship that could lead towards a commitment. It relates to a family member we are tied to through a soul experience.

**Midheaven=Mercury/Saturn** Natal

There can be a fixation on one's long-term goals and attaining success professionally. One may have "been there and done that" or one could act as a result of training, having wisdom gained from repetition. Thus one has the ability to be the boss or the one in control of the way other people think and act, as in being the head of a sales staff.

**Midheaven=Jupiter/Ascendant** Natal

With this one can go far since the "luck of the Irish" is with you. There can be advancement in life, but usually one is born into favorable circumstances or seeks it out. A grandparent may play a major role in one's life, even if you didn't get to know them their influence is still present. There can also be a knack for being in the right place at the right time. This may relate to a move or a move up in the world. There can also be a move from one country to another, thus indicating traveling long distances for an extended period.

**Midheaven=Node (Professional Associations)** Natal

The Node/MC joins people together on a professional level to attain mutual goals. It brings in connections that help one manifest their dreams and visions of success. There is a tendency to associate with people of similar interests. On the other side of this energy one may associate with others that prevent the attainment of personal goals. This may also bring in a relationship that could lead towards a commitment. It relates to a family member we are tied to through a soul experience.

## **Active Midpoints: Apr 01, 2005 to Apr 01, 2006**

When interpreting the active midpoints one should keep in mind that the strongest midpoint is the one that is activating a natal midpoint. Thus if your natal midpoint has been activated by transit or progression/direction, then the possibility of the events happening are much stronger. The transits to that natal midpoint seem to be the final timer on an event, which could be indicated in the birth chart. These interpretations address not only what could likely happen for the self but also for others. These midpoints also relate to medical issues, which could be for the self and or others around you. Many times these interpretations medically will have already been addressed, since one may have been working on their personal habits long before, thus arresting any ill effects from the midpoint. The activation of midpoints can happen as early as 1 degree or the equivalent of one year ahead of the exact hit, thus it's good to really look ahead at the energy being activated (by directed planets especially) during the coming year. The active midpoints look at our potential for personal growth, act as a guide for our future and can be used as an adjunct to the usual techniques of interpretive astrology.

### **Apr 01, 2005 Moon = Saturn/Pluto** Direction: Solar Arc

The matriarch who wields with an iron fist and controls the money in the family is a representation of this energy. On an emotional level, one may have maturation issues due to emotional deprivation in early childhood. Sometimes there may have been the passing of one of the parents and/or a lack of emotional support on the part of a parent, thus causing early inhibitions. On a positive level, this relates to the shaman or healer who knows how to generate energy to transform the lives of others. Medically this may create problems with the breasts, as in cysts caused by emotional hardening. Thus it's important to look at where one is vulnerable, and work through this before health issues begin to manifest.

### **Apr 04, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Pluto** Transit

There can be a lot of talk about large sums of money or talking about an estate as this relates to estates. Occult knowledge being shared with others is also a manifestation of this energy, as well as schools specializing in teaching hidden wisdom. There can be a birth of a sibling or dealing with a sibling who has transformational abilities. One has the capacity to teach others their inner philosophy and there can be great success from decisions made regarding investments. There's also the capacity to have feelings that great success is coming, and usually it does.

### **Apr 04, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Mars** Transit

One has the capacity to have success, fame, and abundance, which can come on a

monetary level, and/or through sharing one's philosophy with others. It gives the desire to travel and learn about other cultures and their belief systems. It relates to making a good decision and/or a decision going in one's favor. This has the potential to be a good time to enter into a legal contract. There can be a fortunate turn of circumstances in one's life, and it could also bring publicity and/or being in the limelight. On a physical level, this relates to being well-endowed, having a large, strong, healthy body.

**Apr 04, 2005 Sun = Node/Ascendant** Progressed

There is the capacity to bring a mate into one's life that they may want to marry in the future. It brings in many new social contacts, which could lead to lots of fun and many pleasant outings with others of like mind. This relates to procreation, and there is the potential for much happiness surrounding a child. This also attracts one to groups of people who share common interests.

**Apr 04, 2005 Sun = Node/Ascendant** Direction: Solar Arc

There is the capacity to bring a mate into one's life that they may want to marry in the future. It brings in many new social contacts, which could lead to lots of fun and many pleasant outings with others of like mind. This relates to procreation, and there is the potential for much happiness surrounding a child. This also attracts one to groups of people who share common interests.

**Apr 04, 2005 Moon = Sun/Uranus** Progressed

With this, there is a desire to make changes in a person's life, or being forced to make a change in one's residence. There can be emotional instability in the lives of women in one's surroundings. Many times there is involvement with brilliant, highly intelligent, unique females. Usually the mother is volatile and/or unstable and it can give one unusual eating patterns, which may cause stomach problems. There seems to be a lack of emotional stability due to early family conditioning which directly affects the health.

**Apr 06, 2005 Uranus = Mercury/Neptune** Direction: Solar Arc

Having higher awareness and being connected to others on a spiritual level is a manifestation of this energy. There can be bonding with friends who are on the spiritual path, thus there can be life-altering changes. On the negative side, there can be acts of terrorism which can happen without any foreknowledge. On the more positive side, it can give one psychic or clairvoyant gifts.

**Apr 07, 2005 Neptune = Sun/Jupiter** Transit

The spiritual journey or spiritual traveler is probably the main manifestation of this. It gives one the capacity to be a visionary and dreamer; but on the other side, it can cause illusions surrounding one's belief system. It gives public speaking abilities and the desire to share one's philosophy with others. On its shadow side, there can be betrayal and/or large insurance scams or neglect on the part of others. Medically, this rules the liver and hepatic system, which can be weakened due to difficulties surrounding one's belief system, and it can weaken the heart due to feelings of betrayal. There can also be confusion surrounding a correct diagnosis, since Neptune creates a fog bank.

**Apr 08, 2005 Uranus = Jupiter/Ascendant** Transit

This represents people who are very bright and seem to always have something new ready to happen just over the horizon. They are usually happy, especially in their pursuit of knowledge, which they are very highly adept at. This attracts one to the unusual, and even eccentric, side of life, but it's definitely never boring. People with this energy are trendsetters, since they are leaders, not followers. One's personal individuation is quite pronounced, especially in the way one appears. Many astrologers, inventors, and educators carry this energy.

**Apr 08, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Venus** Transit

The large beautiful home and a loving family are a manifestation of this energy. It represents the loving grandmother and/or the ancestral home. Many times people desire to buy a beautiful home that has historical value. There is also a love of travel, thus this relates to making future travel plans, possibly to the ancestral homeland. This could also be a good time to buy a Bed and Breakfast and/or go to one on a trip. One loves to cook, pleasure to others through the food they serve. On a financial level this represents success in one's ventures and opportunities to expand due to unions with others, which have the potential to become profitable.

**Apr 10, 2005 Saturn = Sun (The Disciple)** Transit

The Sun represents the self and Saturn is discipline, thus this denotes the disciplining of the self through restraint and focus. There's a sense of timing and structure, which helps one to become more stable; thus giving the capacity to develop better habits. There is also the desire to eliminate negative habits and to replace them with something that could forego the test of time. **Apr 19, 2005 Pluto = Mercury/Midheaven** Transit

One has the desire to have great success and feel that one could have influence over others through the way they process information, as in being able to sway someone to your way of thinking. There could be the birth of a sibling and/or a passing of a relative, since this denotes transitions. There can also be a major change in the way we communicate with others, this relates to the conclusion of the matter, where all communication ends. On a professional level, one has the capacity to work with large sums of money as in banking and dealing with loans.

**Apr 19, 2005 Neptune = Neptune/Pluto (Spiritual Transformation)** Transit

When Neptune combines with Pluto there is extreme energy, which takes one into a spiritual transformation. It gives a supernatural power to transmute energy and to purify one's soul experiences. This relates to visions and clairvoyance, giving

the ability to be in dreamtime, thus one seeks spiritual truth through the evolution of the soul. Most psychics and mediums have this, since they need to enter altered states of consciousness to do their work. **Apr 26, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Venus** Transit

There can be inherited wealth in the family through a grandparent where there is a strong love bond. Overall, this is one of the most successful periods to attain one's financial goals in the zodiac.

**Apr 28, 2005 Moon = Mercury (Intuitive Communication)** Progressed

When the moon combines with Mercury, there is an ability to have intuitive communication, which allows one to express their feelings easily as well as receiving non-verbal queues from others. It's where the emotional and logical mind blend to form one unit. One has the ability to be a good sales person along with very creative ideas. **May 03, 2005 Uranus = Moon (Independent Feelings) Transit**

This relates to a woman or a person who has clairvoyance and inner sight. One may make many moves from home to home, having a need to keep changing their personal environment. There can also be an unstable, eccentric mother or woman in their life. Or one may have the desire to become part of an extremist movement, thus becoming more of an independent person. On a positive level, this helps one to free their self from traditionally limiting behaviors and one may even have the desire to try out new and different foods. It's symbolized by the person/woman of knowledge or person with insight, like an astrologer. There is an intuitive intellect, and connects one with intelligent female friends. **May 14, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Uranus** Transit

**May 18, 2005 \* Node = Mercury/Saturn Transit**

This relates to difficulties dealing with an uncle and/or sibling. One has the capacity to connect with a group whose goal is to promote better communications. There can be associations with people who have been depressed over habitual issues and want to make a change in their patterning. **May 18, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Pluto Transit**

**May 26, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Ascendant** Transit

There are many ups and downs in life that seem to season one to weather almost any storm now, but for some people this is just what the doctor ordered. **May 27, 2005 Moon = Moon/Uranus (Independent Feelings)** Progressed

**May 28, 2005 \* Neptune = Uranus/Midheaven** Direction: Solar Arc

There is a need to be more on the spiritual path and to apply that knowledge in one's employment. One has a strong intuitive nature combined with artistic skills, but on the shadow side of this, there can be a lack of career direction or a weakened sense of self, resulting in no direct intentions. Medically, this relates to immune disorders as well as a weekend drive to succeed in life.

**Jun 02, 2005 \* Moon = Jupiter/Midheaven** Direction: Solar Arc

The happy woman who loves her home and family is a representation of this energy. It relates to a move up in the world to a larger home and/or expansion within one's personal environment. It gives large breasts in a woman's chart, and/or it relates to breast augmentation. Either way, one has a great capacity to nurture and/or to being nurtured. This is present for people who feed many others; an example might be a family-owned restaurant or grocery business. One has the capacity to be joyous along with the ability to have a great depth of feeling for another. This also relates to traveling back to see one's homeland, and/or to organize a family reunion.

**Jun 02, 2005 Moon = Mars/Pluto** Progressed

Dynamic women who have great power that can be wielded like a knife carry this energy. One has the capacity to overcome great odds, and yet on the negative side, it could be a person who is very controlling and wants things their way or wants their own queen-dom. This relates to the Wiccan woman and/or sorceress, the women of power. One can have surgery now on the female body, or this relates to a doctor who specializes in breast or reproductive surgery. On the positive side, there could be interest in goddess energy and healing others through transformational work.

**Jun 05, 2005 Saturn = Moon (Emotional Maturation)** Transit

Early emotional needs are seldom met; thus, one has difficulty responding in a stable way when the going gets tough. The lack of early bonding with the parents can cause one to be more self-sufficient and have control over one's feelings. There can also be a feeling of being alone in the world without someone to talk to and no one seems to understand. **Jun 06, 2005 Node = Midheaven/Ascendant** Transit

These are the contacts with other people in the environment that help to shape one's personality. There is linking of people of like minds and connections to family. This relates to sharing many happy times with others we value. One could meet someone new, partnering with them which could lead to a birth within the family.

**Jun 06, 2005 Node = Node/Ascendant (Connections in the Environment)**

Transit

When the Node and the Ascendant come together there's the potential to form bonds with people within one's environment. It relates to family members and relationships, our neighbors, or co-workers. There's sharing of interest compatibility and pleasure and enjoyment in their company. This also relates meeting and bonding with someone new who can bring new beginnings into one's life. On the other side of this, to avoid problems at a later date one should take care in forming new associations until you get to know them a little better. This also denotes potential difficulties with people you already know due to disagreements and quarrels.

**Jun 08, 2005 Node = Moon/Pluto** Transit

This also relates to some of the most important changes in one's life that create a need to start the building of a new

future through the freeing up of the old habitual patterns.

**Jun 10, 2005 Node = Sun (Karmic Connections) Transit**

The Sun/Node connects us to others energetically, connecting one with another or to a group of people that can help one to advance in the right direction. This also relates to connecting with a man or associating with others of like mind. The Nodes represent the family or people we will be associating with for a long period of time, or people who become part of our life's path. These connections may manifest on the positive or the negative, but ultimately they are our teachers and will help our spirit to advance. Thus, this relates to bonding and becoming friends with another, being in relationships with people of like interest. So, one can see how this represents joining a group and/or club. This influence ultimately relates to one's soul group, which we connect with throughout this lifetime, so one can advance through the different stages and levels of interactions. The Sun / Node has the capacity to bring in people who are of a higher quality depending on the nature of one's Sun sign in their birth chart. It allows for following one's own destiny, which links one with others.

**Jun 11, 2005 Venus = Neptune/Pluto Direction: Solar Arc**

One's romantic nature is influenced by this energy, in that it gives a highly sensual magnetism along with a heightened love nature. This relates to the mystic since there's a great love for the masses, which goes far beyond ordinary reality and is not bound by earthly rules. It also denotes a person who can create mystical art, new age art, or music, thus relating to highly gifted artists who have difficulty living in normal reality. Medically, this rules the fallopian tubes and difficulties with the menstrual cycle for a woman.

**Jun 12, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Node Transit**

Backing away from associations with others through ending, terminating, or separating is a representation of this energy. In the career area, this relates to coworkers who move on or are fired. In a marriage or union, it denotes no longer sharing the same beliefs or values with one's partner or mate. On a positive level, this relates to people in an authority position who help one to succeed, as a father does in early life.

**Jun 12, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Midheaven Transit**

This relates to visions and clairvoyance, giving the ability to be in dreamtime, thus one seeks spiritual truth through the evolution of the soul. Most psychics and mediums have this, since they need to enter altered states of consciousness to do their work. On the other side of this, there is a tendency to have a weakened will and a lack of desire to set goals in one's present reality. There can be deceptive acts and/or self-delusion manifesting as a messiah complex, or feeling that one is spiritually superior to others. On a medical level this can pull one towards alcohol and substance abuse and there can also be toxicity that forms a mass within the body, which may need to be removed surgically.

**Jun 19, 2005 Pluto = Uranus/Neptune** Transit

This is a generational energy involving the mass of humanity and was present of the use of extreme forms of energy, as in the atom bomb, hydrogen bomb and neutron bomb. So you can see that it has the potential to take on a very powerful form, and yet it gives an extreme awareness of life and the need to protect all life forms. There have been large institutions formed to serve and help society as a whole under this. An example of this is the formation of the United Nations, created when Pluto was at midpoint to Uranus/Neptune, also present during the dropping of the Atomic bomb on Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan.

**Jun 22, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Pluto** Transit

Bankers, attorneys, or people who work with large sums of other people's money, as in a stockbroker, are a representation of this energy. There can be inheritances and/or money received through the ending of a partnership, like divorce or a corporate buy-out. **Jun 25, 2005 Saturn = Sun/Saturn (The Disciple)** Transit

It gives the desire to retire or be secluded from others, since it represents inhibitions and/or habits; thus meaning habitual. Many times there is a loss of energy that can affect one's output in the work area. These are usually serious people who are very loyal and can be counted on when the going gets tough. This also relates to maturation and the aging process, which on a medical level can cause problems with brittle bones and difficulties with the knees. Medically this rules the skin, teeth, heart, and back problems due to the hardening process that takes place with age.

**Jun 26, 2005 Node = Ascendant (Connections in the Environment)** Transit

When the Node and the Ascendant come together there's the potential to form bonds with people within one's environment. It relates to family members and

relationships, our neighbors, or co-workers. There's sharing of interest compatibility and pleasure and enjoyment in their company. This also relates meeting and bonding with someone new who can bring new beginnings into one's life. On the other side of this, to avoid problems at a later date one should take care in forming new associations until you get to know them a little better. This also denotes potential difficulties with people you already know due to disagreements and quarrels.

**Jun 26, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Uranus** Transit

This is the main signature of the astrologer and/or it gives one the capacity to study difficult subjects like astrology. It rules the high tech and computer industries, thus giving one the capacity to master difficult subjects with ease. Usually people go on to college and/or seek out some form of higher education that is very enjoyable to them. There's the potential to have speculative abilities along with the gift of winning unexpectedly. There can also be advancement in life through one's attainment of knowledge and inner awareness. Many times there can be an unusual child born with a high degree of intellect.

**Jun 29, 2005 Saturn = Neptune/Node** Transit

Emotional suffering experienced with others and caused by a highly volatile situation is a manifestation of this, thus there seems to be no way out except through time. This denotes someone who has health problems or is being deceitful in a relationship where they have hidden their true nature or desires. Either way, this can leave one feeling betrayed and alone, suffering in silence. Medically, this relates to bone disease due to not feeling supported by others, or skin ailments from toxicity in the diet. There can also be substance abuse on the part of the father's lineage and/or toxic substances within the work area which affect the health.

**Jun 29, 2005 Saturn = Neptune/Midheaven** Transit

**Jul 02, 2005 Neptune = Sun/Jupiter** Transit

The spiritual journey or spiritual traveler is probably the main manifestation of

this. It gives one the capacity to be a visionary and dreamer; but on the other side, it can cause illusions surrounding one's belief system. It gives public speaking abilities and the desire to share one's philosophy with others. On its shadow side, there can be betrayal and/or large insurance scams or neglect on the part of others. Medically, this rules the liver and hepatic system, which can be weakened due to difficulties surrounding one's belief system, and it can weaken the heart due to feelings of betrayal. There can also be confusion surrounding a correct diagnosis, since Neptune creates a fog bank.

**Jul 03, 2005 Node = Sun/Pluto Transit**

These are the associations with people in power who are in a position of control over us. It is represented by the new connections we make in life that transcend us out of our old limitations. Thus, this relates to transitions and rules the process of birth and transcendence within the family. This energy gives the capacity to end old relationships and begin new ones transforming one's life for the better.

**Jul 04, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter (Expansion and Contraction) Transit**

When Jupiter and Saturn come together, one is either expanding outward and/or contracting inward. This manifests through the purchase of a larger home, which could even be the home of one's dreams. There can also be a focus on one's career -- going from one position to another, having a change in pay or a raise -- thus giving a more solid financial foundation. With regards to big business, one can have flexibility to expand and or downsize, depending upon what is needed. On the reverse side, there is a feeling of not enough or potential financial difficulties, often due to having overextended oneself. Thus the conservation of one's energy and waiting to see the outcome, knowing that one can get what they want at a later date, is important. A long hard look at what one values should be taken, along with the desire to expand one's personal awareness into other areas of life. Medically this rules the liver, the blood, as in one's blood pressure, which, on a metaphorical level, may have something to do with blockages within one's belief system.

**Jul 05, 2005 Moon = Moon/Venus (The Marriage) Progressed**

The Moon combined with Venus relates to the marriage based on the power of love and attraction. **Jul 10, 2005 Pluto = Mars/Midheaven** Transit

Professional power and the attainment of long-range goals are influenced by this energy. There is a desire to be independent from the whole, thus following one's own path. This denotes surgery, and/or the elimination of something out of one's life. There can also be violent and/or sudden reactions that have long-term ramifications now, thus this relates to transitions, losses and/or suffering at the hands of another.

**Jul 11, 2005 Jupiter = Saturn/Neptune Transit**

One has a sense of purpose when it comes to the belief system, and this relates to involvement in a religious order. Thus one may have high ideals and a sense of integrity. On the negative or misuse of this energy, there can be corruption within institutions through fraud committed by those in authority, and many religious evangelists came to their downfall under this. This also has toxic implications, as in it relates to ailments like the flu which effect large amounts of the population at once. Medically these rule pneumonia or lung diseases, so get a check up early and start doing pranayama, the yogic deep breathing technique facilitating in balanced health.

**Jul 11, 2005 Pluto = Mars/Node Transit**

This brings power and people who are magnetic and action oriented into one's life. There can be issues surrounding the life force, where life can be brought into the world and/or leaving it. Thus this relates to a powerful energy that connects one with people who are in control or are seeking self-mastery over their physical body. **Jul 12, 2005 \* Node = Venus/Saturn Transit**

**Jul 13, 2005 Node = Moon/Mercury Transit**

Females in the family are a representation of this energy. There is an ability to easily communicate the love for one another. This also relates to the associations that revolve around nurturing and healing along with the gift of being able to reflect the past. There is usually a desire to link with one's soul group, thus one has a tendency to connect with people who give them a sense of security, which helps one to grow and mature.

**Jul 14, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Venus Transit**

With this there can be a union with and/or marriage to a wealthy person who brings much happiness into life. It's one of the most successful periods of the life cycles, and there is a desire to share through one's philosophy. This also represents a successful child and/or grandchild. There can be inherited wealth in the family through a grandparent where there is a strong love bond. Overall, this is one of the most successful periods to attain one's financial goals in the zodiac.

**Jul 15, 2005 Ascendant = Mars/Saturn Direction: Solar Arc**

The physically strong person who puts their best face forward with intention and has a good sense of timing is a manifestation of this energy. They also have the ability to get the job done in a relatively short period of time. On the negative side, there can be tooth decay from too much sugar or acid in the diet. There can also be acne, thus one has difficulty facing the world, but this does develop inner strength and the ability to weather the storm.

**Jul 17, 2005 Moon = Sun/Mars Progressed**

One has the capacity to have an emotional response to a volatile situation; thus heating up the feelings as well as bringing things up quickly within the family environment and/or with others whom we consider family. Many times this is present when we purchase a new home or move to a new area, as well as when we begin a new relationship, where there is an excitement in love with a strong physical attraction. This gives the capacity to motivate others through enthusiasm along with pointing toward a strong, outgoing mother or woman, who has lots of energy, much like an Aries-type of personality.

**Jul 18, 2005 Node = Pluto (Transformational Associations) Transit**

When Pluto and the Node come together, associations can come into one's life that can transform. These connections are usually intense and have an end goal or an intention. This relates to influential people, such as a political leader or someone who has control over the masses. This also relates to large groups of people who come together for a common purpose that transforms the existing policy. This can be the beginning or ending of very important associations that could ultimately change one's life for the better. These connections are karmic in that they help us to advance quickly on a soul level. On a psychological level, this brings awareness of others and the consciousness of self and yet there's the potential to lose consciousness of others by not knowing how they really feel. This denotes transitions and births of people to whom we are very close and is rules the reproductive cycle.

**Jul 18, 2005 \* Moon = Mercury/Pluto** Progressed

**Jul 20, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Neptune** Transit

There's a feeling of wanting to help the underdog, since one may have struggled out of poverty or had a lack of security in their youth. On the reverse side, one may have a need to declare bankruptcy or feel spiritually bankrupt. Either way, there's a sense of lack with a need for more inspirational things to happen in one's life to make it worthwhile to stay around. One has a tendency to come out of an illusion or fog, stepping into the daylight and present reality. Medically, this relates to liver disorders and hepatitis.

**Jul 21, 2005 Jupiter = Mars/Pluto** Transit

The birth of a power child and/or the birth of powerful children are a manifestation of this energy. It relates to the use of energy that is wielded through philosophy and belief systems, thus transformative thought. People who can change the world through what they believe or do carry this energy. So this rules a surgeon and/or represents plastic surgery and it relates to the medical profession, or a doctor who has the capacity to deal with life and death situations. The transition of a grandparent can also come under this.

**Jul 24, 2005 Neptune = Moon/Midheaven** Transit

Spiritual awakening or the entering into dreamtime along with having artistic and musical gifts are manifestations of this. It also relates to being in altered states of consciousness, like being a psychic or a medium. This also rules the parent with substance abuse problems and/or the caring for someone who has a long-term illness. Many times one has a career surrounding the water, houseboats, etc. This energy relates to a love of being near the water or having a family home near water. Medically, this rules the breasts.

**Jul 25, 2005 Neptune = Venus (The Artist) Transit**

Venus to Neptune combines one's love of beauty along with one's creative artistic gifts, which can come in the form of dancing, painting, photography, or poetry, to name a few. There's a feeling of being inspired by something greater than oneself. There's a great imagination and capacity to create fantasy in one's life. One has a tendency to play dress up long after one's youth, creating an illusion surrounding the appearance. Thus, this energy relates to the actor or actress, and this acting ability is not limited to the movie industry or, in an ordinary person's life, as a drama queen. One could also be attracted to someone who appears to be one thing but in reality is another. So one can see how this represents plastic surgery, in that it creates an illusion that changes the way one appears to others, thus a person could appear more youthful. **Jul 25, 2005 Neptune = Moon/Node Transit**

There is basically a feeling of not living in the present reality. On a positive level, one has the capacity to share a vision with others and develop psychic intuition through a group contact. This relates to psychic women or a union with intuitive people. On a medical level, there is a love of dairy products which could cause the potential for toxicity in the body or breast cysts. This energy also relates to the sick woman and/or mother who has substance abuse issues or a chemical imbalance. To use this energy correctly, one should use their powers of intuition and enhance them through the use of yoga and meditation.

**Jul 27, 2005 \* Midheaven = Jupiter/Ascendant Direction: Solar Arc**

With this one can go far since the "luck of the Irish" is with you. There can be advancement in life, but usually one is born into favorable circumstances or seeks it out. On a daily level, this is good for making changes suddenly, as in the residence and or job structure. Medically, this relates to a break and or problems with the teeth. Staying in harmony with one's environmental circumstances is very important.

**Jul 28, 2005 Uranus = Moon (Independent Feelings)** Transit

Emotional independence and the ability to be self-willed, along with being highly, intelligent yet excitable, is a manifestation of this energy. This relates to a woman or a person who has clairvoyance and inner sight. One may make many moves from home to home, having a need to keep changing their personal environment. There can also be an unstable, eccentric mother or woman in their life. Or one may have the desire to become part of an extremist movement, thus becoming more of an independent person. On a positive level, this helps one to free their self from traditionally limiting behaviors and one may even have the desire to try out new and different foods. It's symbolized by the person/woman of knowledge or person with insight, like an astrologer. There is an intuitive intellect, and connects one with intelligent female friends. One can also have anxiety in one's everyday life due to the need for a constant change of circumstances and there's a tendency to get bored easily or have a restless mind. The Moon/Uranus represents big changes in one's life and feeling independent from others, thus pointing to a move from one home to another. The main way to work with the tension that this creates is to have more order and daily routines, since there's normally chaos when there's no rituals in one's life.

**Jul 31, 2005 \* Node = Saturn/Uranus** Transit

This connects one to people who facilitate changing long-term goals and building new structures within one's life. These are the connections that help one make changes in their path that give a sense of freedom, separating them from worn out behavioral patterns from the past.

**Jul 31, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Venus** Transit

The large beautiful home and a loving family are a manifestation of this energy. It represents the loving grandmother and/or the ancestral home. Many times people desire to buy a beautiful home that has historical value. There is also a love of

travel, thus this relates to making future travel plans, possibly to the ancestral homeland. This could also be a good time to buy a Bed and Breakfast and/or go to one on a trip. One loves to cook, pleasure to others through the food they serve. On a financial level this represents success in one's ventures and opportunities to expand due to unions with others, which have the potential to become profitable.

**Aug 02, 2005 Node = Moon/Mars Transit**

The potential for meeting a mate who has high energy and a fiery personality, much like an Aries type, is a manifestation of this. These are the ties and connections that bind us together energetically to family members. With this influence there can be a birth of a male child in the family who will possess lots of physical energy. It also represents sports or connecting with others who love sports and/or attending a sports event.

**Aug 04, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Mars Transit**

One has the capacity to have success, fame, and abundance, which can come on a monetary level, and/or through sharing one's philosophy with others. It gives the desire to travel and learn about other cultures and their belief systems. It relates to making a good decision and/or a decision going in one's favor. This has the potential to be a good time to enter into a legal contract. There can be a fortunate turn of circumstances in one's life, and it could also bring publicity and/or being in the limelight. On a physical level, this relates to being well-endowed, having a large, strong, healthy body.

**Aug 04, 2005 Node = Sun/Mercury Transit**

There can be much happiness when communicating and sharing thoughts with others with whom one shares similar interests and/or values. This relates primarily to people we consider family, relatives and/or our close associates that we can talk to easily. This represents contacts that bring in new associations, as in the birth of a sibling or relative, and it can also bring a new love interest into one's life, someone with excellent communication skills. It also denotes a good educator, teacher, presenter, and/or public speaker.

**Aug 04, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Pluto Transit**

There can be a lot of talk about large sums of money or talking about an estate as this relates to estates. Occult knowledge being shared with others is also a manifestation of this energy, as well as schools specializing in teaching hidden wisdom. There can be a birth of a sibling or dealing with a sibling who has transformational abilities. One has the capacity to teach others their inner philosophy and there can be great success from decisions made regarding investments. There's also the capacity to have feelings that great success is coming, and usually it does.

**Aug 05, 2005 Saturn = Neptune (Spiritual Teachers) Transit**

When Saturn combines with Neptune there is the decay of the old and the rebuilding of new structures, thus there is a bridging of one consciousness to another. During the last Saturn Neptune conjunction (1989), there were many bridges that collapsed and had to be rebuilt. One has the ability to go into a

dreamtime state of reality and become a channel for information on other levels of consciousness. The highest manifestation of this energy is represented by a spiritual teacher who has great wisdom, developed over a period of lifetimes, to share with humanity. On the other side, there can be problems within one's work or partnerships due to fraud or deceit. There is also a tendency to dissolve dreams, causing a feeling of great depression which could result in substance abuse or drug poisoning; this can also affect the father in all of the above issues. There can be a lack of timing and or a feeling of not being in touch with reality. Medically, this rules bone disintegration, as in tooth decay, arthritis, broken toes, and/or foot disorders, along with bone diseases and cancer, due to its wasting away effect. It's also present with alcoholism and drug abuse, which is of a habitual nature.

**Aug 09, 2005 Saturn = Venus/Ascendant** Transit

One has many sobering choices in the life which result in decisions that determine, and potentially limit, one's long-term stability. This also denotes marrying for security or partnering with an older mature person who gives one a sense of financial security. This has a tendency to separate one from their mate due to differences in values or going in opposite directions from each other. Medically, this relates to having to deal with something which has been a bother for quite a while, like the teeth.

**Aug 10, 2005 \* Saturn = Uranus/Node** Transit

Career changes shared with others are one of the manifestations of this. It gives the need to change a pattern which has become boring or needs to be changed to bring in new energy. Sometimes these changes are fast and sudden, happening without warning. An example of this would be a shared layoff, or getting a new boss. This also relates to sudden earth changes which are experienced with others. The father and his health come to light with this, possibly causing problems in the heart or circulatory system. There can also be sudden changes in a man's career direction.

**Aug 10, 2005 Uranus = Sun/Node** Direction: Solar Arc

One has the capacity to bring in unique people that help to advance one's knowledge. It could be joining a group of astrologers and linking or connecting with others on a mental level. This also manifests as the joining of a group interested in advancement through higher forms of communications. This represents the conception or birth of an unusual, unique, and often a rebellious child.

**Aug 10, 2005 Saturn = Uranus/Midheaven** Transit

A change of one's position in life, which can manifest through one's profession, is symbolic of this energy. There can be a sudden change in the overall day-to-day structure, giving the desire to leave one line of work for another. Sudden disruptive changes in one's stability can happen, resulting in one needing a better education so as to stay in their present position. This also relates to accidents or something happening out of the blue, like one's car breaking down. The father may have health issues to deal with which revolve around the heart or circulatory

system. It's also a time where there can be a change in management within one's occupation, thus offering an opportunity for advancement.

**Aug 13, 2005 \* Node = Jupiter/Ascendant** Direction: Solar Arc

People joining together to form a harmonious union through social activities is a representation of this energy, along with abundance shared with others. There can be a birth of a loving child who brings people together within the family. One can meet new people sharing knowledge with others who are considered influential in the community. This also relates to luck and harmony and connects one with others of equal good fortune.

**Aug 15, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Mercury** Transit

One has the desire to travel and to learn more about the world through different belief systems. This may come in the desire to travel to a foreign country and/or learning a second language or learning more about one's own heritage. This is usually a very optimistic person who has a desire for higher learning in the form of going on to university and continuing their education in some form or another throughout their life. One may have writing skills that could manifest in the writing of a successful book and/or novel. There is usually public appreciation and recognition, as well as being popular in the public eye.

**Aug 17, 2005 \* Mars = Uranus/Pluto** Direction: Solar Arc

This is a highly volatile energy wielded suddenly with intention. It relates to a sudden need for surgery, acts of violence, or extreme energy needed in competitive sports, or bodybuilding. This also relates to sudden accidents or major mistakes being made surgically. Medically this influence rules the eliminative systems in the physical body, as well as a desire to have facial plastic surgery to improve one's exterior appearance, thus relating in a rejuvenative effect.

**Aug 17, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Mars** Transit

There is a love of travel, especially to warm, hot places. This can cause legal problems surrounding the family and/or real estate matters and there can be heated discussions regarding the belief systems and philosophy of others. This also rules the physically large woman and/or the large breasted female. Medically, there can be weight gain due to chemical imbalance in the diet along with an over acid condition.

**Aug 19, 2005 Jupiter = Saturn/Uranus** Transit

There can be a desire to expand one's personal reality by investing in one's future potential. The way things were is too limiting, so one wants to advance and get into a more accelerated awareness. This can be done through higher studies on subjects that free one's consciousness from the limitations placed upon them by the old worn-out patterns from the past.

**Aug 19, 2005 \* Uranus = Sun/Midheaven** Direction: Solar Arc

The career changing direction many times due to the need for more personal freedom is a reflection of this energy, and not wanting to be tied to a 9 to 5 type of job. There is usually a desire for personal individuation in the career, which gives

one more of a specialty in the work environment. There can be moving from one place to another for job security, and also many unexpected life changes which affect one's long-term goals. This represents revolutionary ideas and the application of advanced state-of-the-art knowledge, which can manifest in an interest in the computer industry or anything considered high tech or advanced technologically.

**Aug 23, 2005 \* Saturn = Venus/Node** Transit

One can evaluate how well they can connect with others. But on the other side, this can become a "disconnect" period due to going in the opposite direction from those who are around and no longer have the same values. Thus, there is no longer a connection due to having dissimilar goals. This also relates to having a feeling of separation from others due to changes in the career or health challenges.

**Aug 23, 2005 Saturn = Venus/Midheaven** Transit

One may find that they are delayed in the advancement of the career, or there could be separation from those one works or partners with. This can also be a period of forced growth due to a lack of knowledge or social skills; thus, one can advance quickly once they've learned these skills and developed a better sense of timing and career management. Financially, this is usually a time when it's better to invest in one's own advancement, and it's not a time to take money out of the business.

**Aug 24, 2005 Jupiter = Pluto (The Inheritance)** Transit

When Jupiter and Pluto come together there is a focus on a deeper sense of beliefs where one seeks knowledge of the unknown. This energy relates to the priest and/or the initiation into a secret society or form of study. Good powers of judgment, especially when working with large sums of money, is another manifestation of this energy, as well as dealing with the IRS, taxes, banks, insurance companies, and estates through the death of a family member. There can be transitions for a grandparent who leaves an estate bequeathing an inheritance, thus one becomes the benefactor. There could also be a child born who may proceed the passing of a grandparent with an expanded consciousness, thus the power has been transferred to the grandchild from the grandparent. One may have great powers of judgment as this relates to major Supreme Court decisions as well as being judge and/or to be the one being judged. Many great philosophers who have the capacity to change the belief system of the masses carry this energy. Medically this rules removals through surgery which can end up favorably, along with the potential for liver problems.

**Aug 25, 2005 Uranus = Jupiter/Ascendant** Transit

This represents people who are very bright and seem to always have something new ready to happen just over the horizon. They are usually happy, especially in their pursuit of knowledge, which they are very highly adept at. This attracts one to the unusual, and even eccentric, side of life, but it's definitely never boring. People with this energy are trendsetters, since they are leaders, not followers. One's personal individuation is quite pronounced, especially in the way one

appears. Many astrologers, inventors, and educators carry this energy.

**Aug 28, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Mercury** Transit

Traveling great distances to see one's family is a manifestation of this, as it gives an interest in genealogy as well as having interest in historical information about the past. There's a tendency to focus on the belief system of the family and/or the philosophy of what one perceives to be their tribe. This also relates to the influential woman and/or an influential family in the community. There can be good news and a focus on higher education along with writing and communication skills.

**Aug 28, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Saturn** Transit

This relates to a partnership trying to move forward on a financial level but which still has to deal with periods of delay and slow progress. It can be a time to slow down and hold back economically, since it denotes overextending one's resources and finances through the "good life" and then having to pay the piper. There can also be separation in partnerships due to differences in values and/or for financial reasons. This also relates to down sizing or being conservative within a partnership.

**Aug 30, 2005 Saturn = Mars/Ascendant** Transit

One can hold themselves back from their full potential due to early inhibitions. Thus, if one works with their early environmental conditioning they could overcome some of the obstacles that seem to hold them back or keep them in the same place without advancement. People who have this seem to have physical strength and a sense of purpose. One usually has the intention to somehow get the job done no matter what the obstacles are. There can also be sadness which is shared with others due to a loss or concern for others.

**Sep 01, 2005 Moon = Sun/Mercury** Progressed

One has the ability to have clear communication, with an emotional side to it, thus relating to storytellers. Usually the family is very emotionally connected and everyone is included in what's happening as opposed to being excluded. This, on a daily level, can be a time to have a family get together and/or a reunion. It represents a good time to give a presentation where one can express themselves with feelings about the subject matter. This is also a favorable period for writing, especially about the past, since it gives good powers of recollection and the ability to reflect.

**Sep 01, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Uranus** Transit

This energy relates to a person who dedicates their life to the advancement of the social order, with lots of blocks from the establishment along the way. One has a desire for freedom from the way things are, thus people tend to quit their job or even a relationship for the quest of that newfound freedom. There can also be difficulties in life due to the lack of an education in one's specialized field, thus there are problems moving up the ladder of success. This is also a good time to seek out higher education and/or training that could give the desired skills which are necessary for personal advancement. One also has writing skills, as in writing

a long novel or documenting information for historical archives, since this relates to historians.

**Sep 03, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Pluto** Transit

These are the people who carry and form the beliefs from one generation to the next. This relates to the study of occult knowledge and an interest in secret societies. Many priests, Shamans, and people who are dedicated to a belief system have this, as well as people who incorporate sexuality with philosophy to attain their personal goals. It relates to books written which affect the consciousness of the masses. This is great for financial gain through an inheritance or an insurance claim, thus this relates to gaining through the transition of a grandparent. It represents the IRS and dealing with our taxes and/or being audited. This is the height of great personal power, creating financial success, and personal gain that results in extreme wealth. There can also be births and transitions within the family under this.

**Sep 06, 2005 Jupiter = Ascendant (Expansive Environment)** Transit

Jupiter combined with the Ascendant expands the environment and/or physical body, which could manifest in the form of excess through one's weight or height or sheer size. One could also be the lean lanky type, having a runner's body and, in fact, this energy does relate to runners and/or tennis players. There is a love of travel and/or moving from one home to another, which is usually larger. There's also the desire for a more spiritual environment where one can practice the expansion of the belief system. There can be important people who come into one's space who seem to nourish the belief in a higher order through expanded awareness. The luck of the Irish is here, giving success and/or fame. Many people experience a desire to move from one location to a larger, more spacious environment where they can share their good fortune with others. This relates to people who move early in life to a new location that is far from their birthplace where they may live out the rest of their life.

**Sep 07, 2005 Node = Mercury/Pluto** Transit

One has the power over other people's thoughts or the ability to dominate in associations due to the strengths of one's opinions. There's the capacity to be put in a position of judgment and/or decision-maker. There can be the transition of a relative or the birth of a sibling now, as well as the handling of a relative's financial problems. One also has the ability to speak for others or the community.

**Sep 08, 2005 Moon = Moon/Mars (Emotional Response)** Progressed

Emotionally charged women who are highly energetic and fast to react are examples of this energy and/or it's the emotionally young person who is very assertive to their family and friends. There are many flare-ups and heated issues that can come up while in the presence of others, and this relates to the angry woman and/or mother with deep emotional scars caused by early childhood development. This also relates to getting angry and then getting over it just as fast. On a lighter note, this represents people who work on new projects surrounding the home or family, and it relates to emotional courage. It gives the ability to

arouse the emotions of others to a new cause and it relates to many sports enthusiasts and/or women involved in sports. There can be a love of spicy foods and even the beginning of a new diet. It also relates to living in a hot climate and/or to buying a new family home. Medically this rules the sensitive stomach, resulting in an overly acidic condition or possibly an ulcer created by internalized anger. There could also be burns created while cooking for the family when one is angry.

**Sep 08, 2005 Node = Sun/Mars Transit**

The person a woman is attracted to is a manifestation of this energy, or the man in a woman's life. Thus, this relates to the time you meet someone new with the desire to form a love-bond. This is also a very procreative energy; a male child can be born or conceived now. There are also associations with healthy people with an emphasis on health clubs or clubs that relate to optimum health and wellness. This rules sexual unions, or physical unions.

**Sep 10, 2005 Jupiter = Mars/Saturn Transit**

A person wants to expand but they can't because they are limited by the reality of the situation. Thus one will try to expand their reality, but they don't have the wherewithal to make it happen, so progress becomes delayed. One may try to grow when the situation has not matured through the test of time. Most advancement starts with baby steps prior to taking the big leaps, which could change one's financial future. There's a need to deal with the limitations created by past actions before one can start to move forward on their journey of expansion. "Do not pass go, go directly to jail, and do not collect \$200.00" is an image that this energy can apply directly to the monopoly game of life.

**Sep 12, 2005 Jupiter = Sun (The Opportunity) Transit**

The Sun represents the self and Jupiter is success; thus Sun/Jupiter combinations seem to bring out success through one's philosophy on life. It attracts one to religion and/or subjects dealing with the philosophy behind worshiping something greater than the self. Each of us seeks out the purpose of life and how we fit into it. This relates to having lots of fun and expansion and it's considered one of the most advancing times of one's life. People who are born into wealth carry this energy and/or this can be a time where one could create wealth and success for themselves. This is also a time when people travel and/or have contact with foreigners. It represents being able to relate on a big level, thus expanding into many opportune areas in life. Joy for life and expansion of the self are expressions of this, as well as putting one in a high social group within the community. It relates to the seasoned traveler or author. There can be the birth of a Sagittarius or Jupiter's child who is optimistic and looks at the glass half full as opposed to half empty. This rules grand parents, especially if they leave an inheritance to their offspring. This also gives the potential for success when dealing with foreigners and/or foreign products. The medical areas are the hips, thighs, liver, blood, and hepatic system.

**Sep 12, 2005 Neptune = Jupiter/Pluto Transit**

On its highest level, one has the capacity to be a psychic healer and/or psychic surgeon with the ability to heal one's physical and spiritual woundedness. Spiritually, one has the capacity to lead the masses with one's greatness of beliefs and philosophy on life. This leading can be done through public speaking, tapes, or as a famous artisan. There's the ability to watch one's old worn-out patterns disintegrate, then witnessing the birthing of new ones. On the reverse side, there's a tendency to manipulate and try to gain something out of someone through deception or fraud; thus, this could be a very difficult time in one's life, depending on one's intent to grow or to stay where they are.

**Sep 13, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Pluto** Transit

With this energy there could be a grandparent with great wisdom and personal power. This relates to the priest and/or priestess, the one who knows or is the carrier of the ancient traditions. One has the capacity to see clearly into the beliefs of others, thus there's the ability to shape or form the mass belief system. This denotes estates, the transition of a grandparent, the IRS, insurance companies, taxes, and the family home. There's the potential to have extreme wealth and/or luck representing the big win or winning the lottery. The best use of this energy would be to share one's highest, selfless philosophies with others, possibly in a teaching position.

**Sep 15, 2005 \* Jupiter = Node/Ascendant** Transit

Many fortunate contacts and associations can come in, bringing influential people into one's life that can change it for the better. This rules traveling and/or learning with others, connecting people together to attain higher knowledge. Many people who have a fortunate turn in their life's circumstances have this, as well as people who were born into prosperity, an economically secure family, or who have the ability to manifest success through their own talents.

**Sep 15, 2005 \* Jupiter = Midheaven/Ascendant** Transit

One wants to expand their physical reality through their environment or through their physical body. This could be a good thing and/or it could lead to over expansion or weight gain. On the whole this is a popular, successful time in one's life where there is a lot of personal joy and sharing of one's prosperity with others. There's a desire to travel and enjoy the fruits of one's labor. Many people who have been born into abundance have this, as well as people who have financial success.

**Sep 15, 2005 \* Saturn = Mars/Node** Transit

There is a tendency to separate from male groups or from a man. It brings one together with men who are building a new structure, like builders on all levels of consciousness. This also relates to the father's health and/or blocks in energy when dealing with men in authority. Thus, this is a time of connecting with past karma that can be played out in the present.

**Sep 15, 2005 Moon = Neptune/Ascendant** Direction: Solar Arc

Extremely emotional women who are in the personal environment are representations of this, and/or the mother has the potential to be emotionally

unstable. Women in the surroundings have the capacity to be perceptive, with a psychic quality about them. Usually there can be water problems, either in the home and/or in the physical body; thus, do a thorough, periodic cleansing of the body with clear clean water. There can also be psychological dilemmas created in early childhood that seem to affect most of one's life, unless one begins anew and lets the past fade into the background. There can also be substance abuse in the family along with potential allergies to certain foods.

**Sep 15, 2005 Saturn = Mars/Midheaven** Transit

There can be a separation from normal routines. It is a good time to leave a job willfully, least one is asked to leave. One has a sense of purpose or intent when it comes to their goals, but it's difficult to work under the guidance of others. There can potentially be losses and suffering from others, or there could be setbacks of one's long-range goals. There can also be the transition of a loved one.

**Sep 16, 2005 Saturn = Venus/Jupiter** Transit

Relationships that have difficulties due to differences in values, which can lead to a separation and/or divorce, are influenced by this energy. There can be a feeling as though it's difficult to progress in life due to financial difficulties, or there is a tendency to overexpand in the good life and then have to pay the piper after the fact. On the positive side, one may save money for their future, especially when it comes to marriage plans or plans to expand in business. The joining of people of like interests, such as a group of friends getting together, is a manifestation of this energy. It gives happiness through higher studies and the ability to socialize with many people with varied backgrounds. There can also be a person who is happy and popular in the community or the social gathering or party of affluent people.

**Sep 16, 2005 Moon = Saturn/Uranus** Progressed

Tearing down of the old structures and the rebuilding of new emotional patterns that support one's new life style is a manifestation of this energy. Women who have a need for personal freedom through their expressions and creativity are represented by this energy, thus forming and building new bonds in the community. There is also a tendency to let go of friends who do not support one's new free way of thinking.

**Sep 16, 2005 Saturn = Mercury/Ascendant** Transit

One may have a stable way of thinking, putting the logical mind first; thus, one seems to live more in a state of reality than fantasy. There is an ability to plan the future and stick to a rigid, strict way of thinking. On the negative side, one may feel as though they are caught in a depressing situation that leaves them with no way out. Thus, there is a tendency to feel as though one can't share their thoughts with others, since one feels that others just wouldn't understand, or even worse -- they just don't want to hear it. Many times people feel limited in this place and there can be difficulties with relatives at this time which may have been created through habitual patterns.

**Sep 17, 2005 Uranus = Midheaven (Career Changes)** Transit

When Uranus combines with the MC, there can be many changes that come about

in one's career, and the doors of opportunity are open due to unexpected changes in the work environment. One can advance in the world and move from one career to another. People who have aptitude for technology, a vision, or have potential genius qualities carry this energy. Thus, they have a need for lots of change and excitement in their work life. This can come through being a racecar driver, pilot, stunt person, or any profession where a person takes chances. Thus, they have the element of excitement, doing it their own way. On the other side of this, there can be career volatility and sudden changes which are not expected, as in forceful relocation or layoffs. Take care in knowing that there is always a universal plan, and these changes are all part of that experience.

**Sep 17, 2005 Uranus = Node/Midheaven** Transit

Career changes that are shared with others are a manifestation of this. There's a desire to change one's circumstances without too much advance warning. There can be moving from one location to another, but the new location will be very different in nature. An example of this could be moving from the country to the city. One can make new connections which are unique and different in nature, having an element of excitement and unpredictability.

**Sep 18, 2005 Uranus = Node (Social Acquaintance)** Transit

Uranus to the node gives the desire to share friendships with others whom one has mutual experiences with, thus bringing more excitement into one's life. These experiences are usually of a social nature, thus advancing one's knowledge through these associations. This knowledge can come in the form of joining a study group or having a group that one likes to socialize with or network with. There is a very unusual dream life, connecting one with others through dreamtime. Professionally this connects people who are involved in making reforms or changes, and it relates to anyone involved in computer technology or the high tech industry. On the other side, there can be problems that come through one's friendships; thus, this relates to separations within those associations.

**Sep 20, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Saturn** Transit

There is a desire to expand, and yet one doesn't seem to have the funds to do it. One also has the desire to buy a new home, thus establishing mortgage payments. This relates to contraction and then expansion and/or advancement in life after a period of limitation. This represents the pessimist, the one who sees the world from tunnel vision. On the positive side, there can finally be success after a long period of hardship. There can be a raise and/or new position after waiting a long time for advancement.

**Sep 21, 2005 Saturn = Uranus/Neptune** Transit

The application of spiritual knowledge within the career area relates to this energy. It gives the capacity to understand the underdog, along with giving the desire to help others who have less than one's self. Thus, one may feel alone from those they used to feel close to. And there may be the loss of, or block in, communication with relatives. On the positive side, one may master a particular subject along with others to form a group thought or awareness.

**Jan 09, 2006 Node = Uranus/Pluto** Transit

Bringing powerful people together to form a group working together towards a common goal which seems to advance humanity is a manifestation of this energy. This is an evolutionary influence bringing together a group of souls whose nature is to transcend and change one's present reality. Medically this rules sudden surgery, and/or problems with the reproductive system.

**Jan 10, 2006 Uranus = Node (Social Acquaintance)** Transit

Uranus to the node gives the desire to share friendships with others whom one has mutual experiences with, thus bringing more excitement into one's life. These experiences are usually of a social nature, thus advancing one's knowledge through these associations. This knowledge can come in the form of joining a study group or having a group that one likes to socialize with or network with. There is a very unusual dream life, connecting one with others through dreamtime. Professionally this connects people who are involved in making reforms or changes, and it relates to anyone involved in computer technology or the high tech industry. On the other side, there can be problems that come through one's friendships; thus, this relates to separations within those associations.

**Jan 10, 2006 Uranus = Node/Midheaven** Transit

Career changes that are shared with others are a manifestation of this. There's a desire to change one's circumstances without too much advance warning. There can be moving from one location to another, but the new location will be very different in nature. An example of this could be moving from the country to the city. One can make new connections which are unique and different in nature, having an element of excitement and unpredictability.

**Jan 10, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Ascendant** Transit

The place of higher learning, college or university, is represented by this energy. There is usually happiness and the ability to expand in one's environment. One has the potential for success in life due to inheritance or the family's influence in the community. Many times one could be born into wealth and/or affluence. This denotes optimistic people who look at the glass as half full as opposed to half empty. There can be a move away from one's birth location and/or there could be moving to a foreign country. Since this is known as a time of great expansion, it's important that one is conscious of the potential weight gain that this energy can bring.

**Jan 11, 2006 Uranus = Midheaven (Career Changes)** Transit

When Uranus combines with the MC, there can be many changes that come about in one's career, and the doors of opportunity are open due to unexpected changes

in the work environment. One can advance in the world and move from one career to another. People who have aptitude for technology, a vision, or have potential genius qualities carry this energy. Thus, they have a need for lots of change and excitement in their work life. This can come through being a racecar driver, pilot, stunt person, or any profession where a person takes chances. Thus, they have the element of excitement, doing it their own way. On the other side of this, there can be career volatility and sudden changes which are not expected, as in forceful relocation or layoffs. Take care in knowing that there is always a universal plan, and these changes are all part of that experience.

**Jan 12, 2006 Jupiter = Venus/Uranus Transit**

There can be many friends of a higher mind or philosophy such as astrologers or people involved in academia. One has the capacity to be well-liked and admired for what one knows, and there can be the sudden winning of a prize or money coming to them unexpectedly. The successful artist or associating with artists and having a strong appreciation of their talents is a representation of this. One could also fall in love with a successful person, however fleeting it may be.

**Jan 14, 2006 Jupiter = Jupiter/Pluto (The Inheritance) Transit**

When Jupiter and Pluto come together there is a focus on a deeper sense of beliefs where one seeks knowledge of the unknown. This energy relates to the priest and/or the initiation into a secret society or form of study. Good powers of judgment, especially when working with large sums of money, is another manifestation of this energy, as well as dealing with the IRS, taxes, banks, insurance companies, and estates through the death of a family member. There can be transitions for a grandparent who leaves an estate bequeathing an inheritance, thus one becomes the benefactor. There could also be a child born who may proceed the passing of a grandparent with an expanded consciousness, thus the power has been transferred to the grandchild from the grandparent. One may have great powers of judgment as this relates to major Supreme Court decisions as well as being judge and/or to be the one being judged. Many great philosophers who have the capacity to change the belief system of the masses carry this energy. Medically this rules removals through surgery which can end up favorably, along with the potential for liver problems.

**Jan 14, 2006 Moon = Moon/Pluto (Powerful Feelings) Progressed**

The Moon combined with Pluto draws the feminine along with personal power; thus this represents a woman using her power. This could be the woman who uses her gifts to help others, or uses them to manifest things in her life. There's a tendency to go deep into the subconscious motivations that drive one to desire. The healer, the woman who knows, the priestess, Wiccan knowledge, the Sorceress, and/or the Shaman are representations of this energy. The deeply sensitive emotional woman and/or the people who can reflect one's past and eliminate dysfunctional behavior are also representations of this; thus, this relates to the psychologist, psychiatrist, and/or the psychic surgeon. It gives the ability to go deep into the soul patterns and reveal the wound from the past and then eliminate it; thus Evolutionary Astrology. The negative or misuse of this energy

results in trying to emotionally control others through guilt with extremes of emotion: elations then depression, many highs and lows in behavior. Medically, the reproductive system is an area where there could be difficulty when the energy gets blocked and/or misused. An example of this would be a hysterectomy or surgery on the reproductive system.

**Jan 17, 2006 Neptune = Moon/Node** Transit

The dissolving of unions with others is a manifestation of this energy. It causes one to be attracted to people with substance abuse issues or feel betrayed by others. There is basically a feeling of not living in the present reality. On a positive level, one has the capacity to share a vision with others and develop psychic intuition through a group contact. This relates to psychic women or a union with intuitive people. On a medical level, there is a love of dairy products which could cause the potential for toxicity in the body or breast cysts. This energy also relates to the sick woman and/or mother who has substance abuse issues or a chemical imbalance. To use this energy correctly, one should use their powers of intuition and enhance them through the use of yoga and meditation.

**Jan 18, 2006 Neptune = Venus (The Artist)** Transit

Venus to Neptune combines one's love of beauty along with one's creative artistic gifts, which can come in the form of dancing, painting, photography, or poetry, to name a few. There's a feeling of being inspired by something greater than oneself. There's a great imagination and capacity to create fantasy in one's life. One has a tendency to play dress up long after one's youth, creating an illusion surrounding the appearance. Thus, this energy relates to the actor or actress, and this acting ability is not limited to the movie industry or, in an ordinary person's life, as a drama queen. One could also be attracted to someone who appears to be one thing but in reality is another. So one can see how this represents plastic surgery, in that it creates an illusion that changes the way one appears to others, thus a person could appear more youthful. There can also be an enhancing quality, as in breast enlargement; either way, the perception is one of perceived beauty, which could be the real thing, only one's hairdresser knows for sure. This can also be the best time to be photographed and/or have the haircut in which one appears to be the most beautiful. Many times one may fall in love with love; romantic love, being in a fated love relationship, or finding one's long lost love (their soul mate from a past life) may be present with this energy. One could also fall in love with a musician or an artist, or there may be a great love for music, movies, dancing, and fine art. On the shadow side of this energy, there can be involvement with someone who is married, thus the mistress syndrome, secret love affairs, and relationships that are kept hidden from others, along with deception and betrayal. Medically, this represents addictions to sugars, alcoholism, and the potential for liver problems due to substance abuse.

**Jan 18, 2006 Neptune = Moon/Midheaven** Transit

Spiritual awakening or the entering into dreamtime along with having artistic and musical gifts are manifestations of this. It also relates to being in altered states of consciousness, like being a psychic or a medium. This also rules the parent with

substance abuse problems and/or the caring for someone who has a long-term illness. Many times one has a career surrounding the water, houseboats, etc. This energy relates to a love of being near the water or having a family home near water. Medically, this rules the breasts.

**Jan 19, 2006 Node = Mars Transit**

When Mars and the Node come together there are usually bonds formed with men. One has the desire to form cooperative unions to accomplish a job with others, thus having a mutual goal or purpose. There could also be joining a group together with other men, like a gun club or working out together at a gym. In a woman's chart this could be a time when she could meet a man with whom she would want to be in a relationship and there is usually a strong physical attraction to him, thus this relates to procreation. On the reverse side of this, there could be problems that occur now with co-workers and with men who want to do things their way resulting in many little disagreements and arguments within groups led by men.

**Jan 20, 2006 Moon = Node/Ascendant Progressed**

The bond that exists among family members, and/or people who feel like family, is a representation of this energy. It connects people who share mutual interests and who basically feel the same as they do. This can bring new people into one's environment, like a neighbor and/or new friends or a new social group. This also relates to bonding with women in an organization.

**Jan 21, 2006 Moon = Midheaven/Ascendant Progressed**

One can act out of instinct, as opposed to thinking it out in advance. One can bond with people who can express themselves in a balanced emotional level, and there can also be strong family connections made. This relates to the happy, well-balanced woman and/or family, who are there when one needs emotional support.

**Jan 24, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Node Transit**

A group of women discussing their beliefs and philosophy on life is represented by this energy. It's the loving and nurturing family and/or grandmother. There is an attraction to philosophical groups whom we can connect with and where one has community. One could also join a new religion or church group. There can be happiness through one's connections and enjoying prosperity with others. This also relates to travel which can take one to distant places to see one's homelands and/or to be with one's family group.

**Jan 24, 2006 Jupiter = Venus (The Contract) Transit**

Venus and Jupiter relate to what we value along with our philosophy and belief systems. There is usually abundance in one's personal life and sometimes one attracts financial gain along with the ability to attract many gifts from others. People with this have a great capacity to love others, including animals, and they have a love of religion and philosophy, thus valuing higher education. The love of foreigners, their heritage, and ethnicity are also part of this energy. There can be the ability to understand the legal system, since it relates to agreements that are based on the desire to create balance; thus, the marriage contract or legal

agreement as well as giving bliss and happiness within our life. Many times there is the capacity to be easily understood by others as well as having a sense of abundance and joy when in relationships. One may also have an excessive capacity to feel along with the potential to over extend one's self on a financial level or to become wasteful of money and/or energy. Many gamblers who have the potential to win big carry this energy. This denotes appreciation of beauty through artistic pursuits, as in being an artist, and it relates to a person who likes to throw parties and invite people from all different backgrounds. This also represents having a legal decision going in one's favor. Medically, this relates to difficulties assimilating sugar; kidney problems; problems with the liver, due to excess; and, at its worst, hepatitis.

**Jan 24, 2006 Node = Moon/Neptune** Transit

People we connect with that bring insight into our life are represented by this energy, perhaps a psychic women and/or intuitive women in the family who has the capacity to be highly intuitive to the emotional needs of others. On the other side of this, it relates to the taking care of a fragile or depressed woman and/or connecting to people with addictive behavior. Many times one is unable to see themselves clearly since their reflection is based on addictive associations. Medically there can be a lack of depth perception. To overcome the shadow sides of this energy, it's important to connect with people that build one's sense of self - not connecting with those who might destroy it.

**Jan 24, 2006 \* Jupiter = Moon/Midheaven** Transit

There can be great advancement in one's life with attainment of one's goals and being recognized for professional gifts. To have a grandparent who started a very successful business that one could benefit from and/or advancement and success financially is another manifestation of this. There can also be moving for business advancement or moving to another country and/or other locations and loving it.

**Jan 25, 2006 Saturn = Uranus/Neptune** Transit

The application of spiritual knowledge within the career area relates to this energy. It gives the capacity to understand the underdog, along with giving the desire to help others who have less than one's self. On the other side of this, there can be problems through inhibitions, feeling limited, being confined, institutionalization, and suffering from ailments that limit one's freedom of movement. Problems through partnership in the form of betrayal and extreme sadness may be present. There can also be a parent who has had deep emotional issues or substance abuse problems. This is obviously one of those karmic points that give many lessons and insights along the way to help one in their sojourn through life.

**Jan 26, 2006 Node = Saturn/Midheaven** Transit

People gathering together to work on a major project is a representation of this energy. An example would be building a home together. On the other side of this coin can be connections with others through the loss of a loved one or mutual bereavement and struggle. One has a feeling of standing alone without the support

of their loved ones now. There can also be fated unions or connections that ultimately help one to grow forcefully.

**Jan 26, 2006 Node = Saturn/Node (Stable Connections) Transit**

When Saturn and the Node combine with one another, there's a joining of people who have mutual goals in mind, connecting one with coworkers or people to build new structures. There is a feeling of maturity, or being around people who have mastered something on a professional level, thus this relates to a new boss or a change in management. On the other side, there can be separations from others due to work grievances, along with inhibitions or limitations within one's personal or professional associations. There can be a feeling of hopelessness in a situation that involves others. This also relates to the father and is present when one is separated from a family member, or a family member may have a health issue to contend with.

**Jan 26, 2006 Node = Mercury/Venus Transit**

Many connections with people who help to create beauty in one's life through communications can happen. This may be through musical groups, poetry groups, writing groups, and/or singing with others. There can also be pleasant communications with a sibling and/or the birth of a sister.

**Jan 29, 2006 Jupiter = Sun/Jupiter (The Opportunity) Transit**

The Sun represents the self and Jupiter is success; thus Sun/Jupiter combinations seem to bring out success through one's philosophy on life. It attracts one to religion and/or subjects dealing with the philosophy behind worshipping something greater than the self. Each of us seeks out the purpose of life and how we fit into it. This relates to having lots of fun and expansion and it's considered one of the most advancing times of one's life. People who are born into wealth carry this energy and/or this can be a time where one could create wealth and success for themselves. This is also a time when people travel and/or have contact with foreigners. It represents being able to relate on a big level, thus expanding into many opportune areas in life. Joy for life and expansion of the self are expressions of this, as well as putting one in a high social group within the community. It relates to the seasoned traveler or author. There can be the birth of a Sagittarius or Jupiter's child who is optimistic and looks at the glass half full as opposed to half empty. This rules grand parents, especially if they leave an inheritance to their offspring. This also gives the potential for success when dealing with foreigners and/or foreign products. The medical areas are the hips, thighs, liver, blood, and hepatic system.

**Jan 29, 2006 Mercury = Mars/Pluto Direction: Solar Arc**

There is the ability to concentrate energy on a mental level, which gives focused intent. This is present when there is a birth or transition of a relative. It denotes people who are absolute, in the way they communicate with others, thus, people who want absolute power or are forceful in the way they communicate have this. This relates to the dictator and, on the positive side, one has the ability to be a public speaker or an orator. On the negative or shadow side, there can be breaks

in communication, which symbolically denotes a cut or wound on the hands. It's important now to make long-term decisions that have a lasting effect on one's future.

**Jan 30, 2006 Uranus = Jupiter/Ascendant** Transit

This represents people who are very bright and seem to always have something new ready to happen just over the horizon. They are usually happy, especially in their pursuit of knowledge, which they are very highly adept at. This attracts one to the unusual, and even eccentric, side of life, but it's definitely never boring. People with this energy are trendsetters, since they are leaders, not followers. One's personal individuation is quite pronounced, especially in the way one appears. Many astrologers, inventors, and educators carry this energy.

**Jan 30, 2006 Saturn = Mercury/Ascendant** Transit

One may have a stable way of thinking, putting the logical mind first; thus, one seems to live more in a state of reality than fantasy. There is an ability to plan the future and stick to a rigid, strict way of thinking. On the negative side, one may feel as though they are caught in a depressing situation that leaves them with no way out. Thus, there is a tendency to feel as though one can't share their thoughts with others, since one feels that others just wouldn't understand, or even worse -- they just don't want to hear it. Many times people feel limited in this place and there can be difficulties with relatives at this time which may have been created through habitual patterns.

**Jan 30, 2006 Pluto = Pluto/Ascendant (Transformation of the Self)** Transit

The influence between Pluto and the Ascendant tends to transform the physical body along with one's personal environment. It gives self-mastery and the ability to change one's surroundings. One has a magical quality and/or unusually intense eyes which seem to mesmerize. Many hypnotherapists have this. These are people who desire success and personal power, which helps them to change their circumstances in life. This is all good as long as one doesn't try to control others in the process, thus this relates to people who have the potential to be dominant and have a controlling personality. One may use personal power to attain one's goals or one can use the energy of others to get what they want. Medically this relates to taking on a new personality through plastic surgery, eye surgery, and/or even adoption or being put in a witness protection program or getting a name change. There is the potential to heal one's self and others of almost anything due to having the sheer intent to do so. There can also be reproductive issues with this.

**Jan 31, 2006 Saturn = Venus/Jupiter** Transit

Relationships that have difficulties due to differences in values, which can lead to a separation and/or divorce, are influenced by this energy. There can be a feeling as though it's difficult to progress in life due to financial difficulties, or there is a tendency to overexpand in the good life and then have to pay the piper after the fact. On the positive side, one may save money for their future, especially when it comes to marriage plans or plans to expand in business. The joining of people of like interests, such as a group of friends getting together, is a manifestation of this

energy. It gives happiness through higher studies and the ability to socialize with many people with varied backgrounds. There can also be a person who is happy and popular in the community or the social gathering or party of affluent people.

**Feb 01, 2006 Jupiter = Neptune/Pluto** Transit

One can become highly religious under this, dedicating themselves to a belief system along with a desire to propagate the faith. There's the potential for universal love of humanity and the gift to see beyond this present reality. There could be research into the metaphysical side of things which may be very successful, especially in working with dreamtime. On the other side of the coin, this relates to gambling and/or wasting one's energy on foolish things that probably won't take form and/or manifest anyway. This also represents the spiritual traveler who can take a journey within and/or to a spiritual place on the earth. On a medical level, there could be problems with the liver and/or blood.

**Feb 01, 2006 Saturn = Mars/Midheaven** Transit

There can be a separation from normal routines. It is a good time to leave a job willfully, least one is asked to leave. One has a sense of purpose or intent when it comes to their goals, but it's difficult to work under the guidance of others. There can potentially be losses and suffering from others, or there could be setbacks of one's long-range goals. There can also be the transition of a loved one.

**Feb 01, 2006 \* Saturn = Mars/Node** Transit

There is a tendency to separate from male groups or from a man. It brings one together with men who are building a new structure, like builders on all levels of consciousness. This also relates to the father's health and/or blocks in energy when dealing with men in authority. Thus, this is a time of connecting with past karma that can be played out in the present.

**Feb 01, 2006 Neptune = Sun/Jupiter** Transit

The spiritual journey or spiritual traveler is probably the main manifestation of this. It gives one the capacity to be a visionary and dreamer; but on the other side, it can cause illusions surrounding one's belief system. It gives public speaking abilities and the desire to share one's philosophy with others. On its shadow side, there can be betrayal and/or large insurance scams or neglect on the part of others. Medically, this rules the liver and hepatic system, which can be weakened due to difficulties surrounding one's belief system, and it can weaken the heart due to feelings of betrayal. There can also be confusion surrounding a correct diagnosis, since Neptune creates a fog bank.

**Feb 04, 2006 Jupiter = Mars/Uranus** Transit

This represents the physically strong man, like a prizefighter, or the well-endowed man, or a male child being born who is more of an athletic type. It also relates to someone who is very inventive, working with electricity and/or who knows a lot about mechanical knowledge. There can be sudden wins, or getting something by chance, or suddenly advancing in life due to being in the right place at the right time.

**Feb 07, 2006 Neptune = Neptune/Pluto (Spiritual Transformation) Transit**

When Neptune combines with Pluto there is extreme energy, which takes one into a spiritual transformation. It gives a supernatural power to transmute energy and to purify one's soul experiences. This relates to visions and clairvoyance, giving the ability to be in dreamtime, thus one seeks spiritual truth through the evolution of the soul. Most psychics and mediums have this, since they need to enter altered states of consciousness to do their work. On the other side of this, there is a tendency to have a weakened will and a lack of desire to set goals in one's present reality. There can be deceptive acts and/or self-delusion manifesting as a messiah complex, or feeling that one is spiritually superior to others. On a medical level this can pull one towards alcohol and substance abuse and there can also be toxicity that forms a mass within the body, which may need to be removed surgically.

**Feb 15, 2006 Moon = Mercury/Saturn Progressed**

Thoughts of separation in relationships, and/or the awareness of problems between the parents, are a manifestation of this. One may have impression's that are received on a subtle intuitive level, which can also affect the stomach by causing difficult assimilation, relating to blocked emotions. This also denotes the moody, broody, and depressed person who feels that they are controlled by their own feelings. The best way to use this energy is to help someone who is less fortunate than oneself, thus getting a better perspective on one's own situation.

**Feb 16, 2006 Neptune = Mars/Uranus Transit**

One has the ability to perceive on an advanced level as well as being spiritually inclined yet remaining grounded in the real world. There's a lust or excitement for life with a need to become more spiritually aware, which can come through developing a practice that one sticks to, as in yoga and/or meditation. It represents boats, or water sports, thus denoting a person who likes to be active athletically around water equipment, like jet skis, etc. One of the pitfalls of this energy is its highly volatile sexual nature, without proper boundaries, thus it's important to be conscious of the fact that the rest of the world may not think the same way about sex.

**Feb 17, 2006 Uranus = Moon (Independent Feelings) Transit**

Emotional independence and the ability to be self-willed, along with being highly, intelligent yet excitable, is a manifestation of this energy. This relates to a woman or a person who has clairvoyance and inner sight. One may make many moves from home to home, having a need to keep changing their personal environment. There can also be an unstable, eccentric mother or woman in their life. Or one may have the desire to become part of an extremist movement, thus becoming more of an independent person. On a positive level, this helps one to free their self from traditionally limiting behaviors and one may even have the desire to try out new and different foods. It's symbolized by the person/woman of knowledge or person with insight, like an astrologer. There is an intuitive intellect, and connects one with intelligent female friends. One can also have anxiety in one's everyday life due to the need for a constant change of circumstances and there's a

tendency to get bored easily or have a restless mind. The Moon/Uranus represents big changes in one's life and feeling independent from others, thus pointing to a move from one home to another. The main way to work with the tension that this creates is to have more order and daily routines, since there's normally chaos when there's no rituals in one's life.

**Feb 21, 2006 Saturn = Jupiter/Uranus** Transit

This energy relates to a person who dedicates their life to the advancement of the social order, with lots of blocks from the establishment along the way. One has a desire for freedom from the way things are, thus people tend to quit their job or even a relationship for the quest of that newfound freedom. There can also be difficulties in life due to the lack of an education in one's specialized field, thus there are problems moving up the ladder of success. This is also a good time to seek out higher education and/or training that could give the desired skills which are necessary for personal advancement. One also has writing skills, as in writing a long novel or documenting information for historical archives, since this relates to historians.

**Feb 23, 2006 Mercury = Moon/Saturn** Progressed

Difficult communications with family members or making decisions that involve family matters is a manifestation of this. It relates to siblings who have problems in communication and/or are coping with a medical issue. There can be a feeling of being limited by the pressures from others and/or having an emotional block in communications. One may have the desire to study or learn difficult subjects. To resolve the pressures of this, one could use this energy to help others to learn better communication skills. Reading to the blind or helping the deaf is another way. Thus, helping those who have greater difficulty than one's self when it comes to communications.

**Feb 24, 2006 Saturn = Mars/Ascendant** Transit

One can hold themselves back from their full potential due to early inhibitions. Thus, if one works with their early environmental conditioning they could overcome some of the obstacles that seem to hold them back or keep them in the same place without advancement. People who have this seem to have physical strength and a sense of purpose. One usually has the intention to somehow get the job done no matter what the obstacles are. There can also be sadness which is shared with others due to a loss or concern for others.

**Feb 26, 2006 Ascendant = Moon/Pluto** Direction: Solar Arc

Many changes and extremes in one's environment come with this. There can be a tendency to act irrationally, or to react impulsively to an emotional issue. There can be a dominant mother or a woman who was a controlling factor in the family. On a medical level this rules female surgery or a face lift, thus presenting a new face to the world.

**Feb 27, 2006 Uranus = Saturn/Pluto** Transit

Big changes can happen in one's life due to a need for a new career or the need for a major shift of one's financial circumstances. On the negative side, there can

be sudden acts of violence that come out of the blue. This also relates to someone who has no natural fear; thus, it's present with stunt people in the movie industry, racecar drivers, and basically people who take chances with their life force.

**Feb 28, 2006 Node = Mercury/Uranus** Transit

The union of people of like minds and/or people who share a mutual desire to learn advanced subjects is a manifestation of this energy. It rules groups of people that study together, as well as the connections with people who differ from traditional thought. One has the capacity to share their ideas with friends and the ability to make new associations with people who stimulate one's mental processes. There can also be the birth of a sibling and/or a relative.

**Feb 28, 2006 Moon = Moon/Sun (The Union)** Progressed

This represents the union of yin and yang, night versus day, the masculine versus the feminine energy. These are the unions that result in marriage or the merger of two opposites. It is also a time when one experiences the uniting of the self, the right and left brain merging, and/or the coming together of two separate identities. Duality issues seem to come up with this, which signifies the union of the spirit and the soul, the active versus the passive side of oneself. It represents the bringing of the unconscious self together with conscious awareness. It gives us awareness of our position in the world so we can get in touch with what we really want out of life, thus giving the direction we want to go in next. This is a time for us to identify with our home and family, which will give us a feeling of personal satisfaction, especially in the area of developing one's capacity to love and be loved. Sharing with others the good fortune that one has gained, thus giving and receiving is another facet of this energy. One has the capacity to be the center of attention, popular, and recognized for their skills, which may give awareness of our need for inner development and personal growth. This relates to the healthy person, who has much charisma and vitality that they exert on a daily level making them well liked in their social circle. This also represents yoga, which gives the body balance on the physical, mental, and spiritual planes of consciousness.

**Mar 02, 2006 Uranus = Jupiter/Node** Transit

This connects people who are highly evolved mentally, like the MENSA group, or even an astrological group. It represents someone who is coming into one's life who has qualities which could stimulate one mentally to learn and be inspired through knowledge. This also relates to institutions of higher learning, as in going on to college and/or to university.

**Mar 02, 2006 Uranus = Jupiter/Midheaven** Transit

The gifted astrologer and/or scientist carries this energy, as well as many clairvoyants. For most people, it's a time of advancement within their careers due to getting a higher education that helps them to succeed with ease. Under this, many businesses computerize and/or update their software, and it's a great time to

seek out higher education that will fine-tune one's skills. One can start university or finish it. There is also a desire to connect one with people who aspire to advance the world through idealism and their belief system.

**Mar 05, 2006 Moon = Node (Family Associations)** Progressed

The Moon and Node has a tendency to link people together to form our soul group, the people with whom we play out our movie of life. These are the actors in our personal drama of life; they are the connections we have as we voyage along through life. Each connection advances one's soul to its full potential. Each person we connect with is a reflection of our inner reality. Since the Moon has no light of its own (it only reflects the light of the Sun), one usually has a reflective quality, as this relates to those associations from past lives or our past in this one. **Mar 06, 2006 Moon = Node/Midheaven** Progressed

Professional advancement through the help of a woman can happen now. This also links family members together in a group and is a great time for a family reunion or get together, as in a marriage celebration.

**Mar 06, 2006 Moon = Midheaven (The Matriarch)** Progressed

The Moon combined with the MC relates to the woman at the top, or the woman who is in control of a business, who is in a position of power. Sometimes people move to advance in their careers and/or run the family business. One has the ability to reach the top and have many opportunities that arise along the way; also there may be popularity. One may be very much in demand, or have lots of exposure in the public eye, since there's great advancement life. This relates to the dominant parent, the one who makes the decisions. It rules over the capacity to be the executive, the one in charge of making the main decisions for others. There can be many life changes, which lead to more personal power and/or the changing of one's life objectives. Many times people make their home into a business, thus working out of the home. One also has the ability to have great sensitivity and emotional response to the needs of others; thus, this relates to the psychologist and/or counselor. **Mar 07, 2006 Uranus = Neptune/Ascendant** Transit

One can be highly intuitive, having psychic abilities along with the capacity to have visions of the future, thus having future sight or insight. This also denotes seeing things in an enlightened way and/or having the ability to have unique and

peculiar things happen on a regular basis. On the shadow side, there can be confusion about the direction to take next and the possibility of not living in the real world, preferring one's dreams to reality.

**Mar 12, 2006 Ascendant = Mercury (Places of Communication)** Progressed  
Mercury to the Ascendant relates to the place where we like to communicate or the place where one has their home, office, study group, or anyplace in which we feel a sense of comfort. This place gives one the gift of gab so to speak, thus, we are able to express ourselves with ease and also have the capacity to study here. This can also be a time when a relative is born into the family or a time of contact with a relative. **Mar 13, 2006 \* Saturn = Venus/Node** Transit

Thus, there is no longer a connection due to having dissimilar goals. This also relates to having a feeling of separation from others due to changes in the career or health challenges.

**Mar 17, 2006 Node = Saturn/Ascendant** Transit

This can come in the form of a desire to be alone to contemplate or work on a plan that may take a long time to manifest. This relates to domination by one of the parents that in later life could come in the form of domination by a boss. Medically this tends to limit one due to psychological issues that began in early childhood, as well as having a feeling of being limited in one's body due to a lack of mobility.

**Mar 22, 2006 Uranus = Venus/Uranus (Beautiful Friends)** Direction: Solar Arc  
Venus represents our capacity to love and Uranus rules the unusual or unique; thus, this denotes attraction to people who are different and walk to the beat of a different drummer. One may have many friends, especially female friends who

have a different or unique way of expressing themselves. The person who falls in love very fast and then doesn't have staying power or longevity to commit to the relationship is a manifestation of this. **Mar 23, 2006 Neptune = Saturn (Spiritual Teachers)** Direction: Solar Arc

When Saturn combines with Neptune there is the decay of the old and the rebuilding of new structures, thus there is a bridging of one consciousness to another. During the last Saturn Neptune conjunction (1989), there were many bridges that collapsed and had to be rebuilt. One has the ability to go into a dreamtime state of reality and become a channel for information on other levels of consciousness. The highest manifestation of this energy is represented by a spiritual teacher who has great wisdom, developed over a period of lifetimes, to share with humanity. On the other side, there can be problems within one's work or partnerships due to fraud or deceit. There is also a tendency to dissolve dreams, causing a feeling of great depression which could result in substance abuse or drug poisoning; this can also affect the father in all of the above issues. There can be a lack of timing and or a feeling of not being in touch with reality. Medically, this rules bone disintegration, as in tooth decay, arthritis, broken toes, and/or foot disorders, along with bone diseases and cancer, due to its wasting away effect. **Mar 29, 2006 Moon = Jupiter/Ascendant** Progressed

The well-endowed woman and/or the expansion of the physical body are representations of this energy, as well as the expansion of one's residence. One may wish to travel abroad and/or to distant places now. This also relates to the family, thus connecting one to their family, having many happy times. So this energy denotes the happy family and/or woman.
