Introduction

This report has been written to introduce you to the concepts of astrology and how to get started in relationship astrology. Astrology is a complex and meaningful science which takes years to study and apply successfully; however, we would like to whet your appetite with this report, and encourage you to deepen your understanding through other means.

Astrology is a study of the connection between planets and life on Earth. It is based on a concept that energy patterns form between other planets and Earth and that these energies affect our lives as individuals and communities.

An astrological chart, also known as a horoscope, natal chart, or birth chart, records the relationship between the planets and the signs of the Zodiac. Charts can be calculated for the birth of a person, a community, an event or anything that seems momentous. The horoscope is as individual and unique as a fingerprint.

When using these interpretations, please bear in mind that, inevitably, every chart will contain some contradictory influences, and as a result certain interpretations of different items in the same chart may seem difficult to reconcile. However, this may still be an accurate reflection your chart, as it is likely that you do experience conflicting desires, events and circumstances in your life. Usually it is the responsibility of an astrologer to synthesize these apparent contradictions in order to present a cohesive and realistic interpretation of the dilemmas of the chart.

Please also be aware of the fact that each person has positive and negative influences in the chart, and therefore in their lives. The challenge is to accept and overcome the negative influences, so that we can successfully focus on the positive traits. This report outlines the influence of both people's charts on each other. This is called relationship synastry meaning the comparison of two horoscopes and the correlations discovered. It is likely that the report will show both the strengths and weaknesses of the relationship synastry. Any advice given is meant to be an aid to a person taking responsibility for their own lives and their own choices within a relationship. The ultimate decision rests with each individual. Individual Relating Traits

This section looks at each person's individual relationship concerns in their own personal birth chart. Every individual brings certain needs and expectations into a union, which affects his or her ability to feel loved and supported. This in turn affects the nature and course of the relationship.

Traits of Charles

Venus is in the 4th House

Venus is Conjunct Neptune

Coming to terms with the reality of your relationship simply helps you obtain a better understanding of your primary relationship, and helps prevent you becoming disillusioned. In other words taking off the rose-colored glasses means that you can make a proper assessment of your primary relationship. As a result you'll experience fewer feelings of resentment and disappointment because your partner fails to be perfect, and you won't be in danger of overlooking some major flaws such as drug addiction or deceit. Venus is Sextile Pluto

In fact you prefer change, especially if the alternative is a staid and steady relationship. Traits of Diana

Venus is in the 8th House

expectations. You could also feel angry if rejected in love. Fortunately you've an irrepressible side to your nature, on which you can rely in times of relationship trouble. You're a loyal and fun-loving partner with an ability to balance intimacy with independence.

Synastry Between Charles and Diana

Personal Issues

This section looks at the interaction between two people and their two birth charts. It notes the nature of the relationship, whether it is likely to be a successful personal relationship or whether the forces at work are suggesting a less intimate bond. In other words how do these two people come together on an intimate level?

Charles's Moon is Trine Diana's Mercury (Orb 4°46')

This is an ideal combination for a personal relationship in which two people enjoy ease of communication. Charles and Diana enjoy each other's company because they are able to communicate comfortably. They enjoy discussions and are not concerned about arguments. Many personal relationships fail simply because two people are unable to communicate both their thoughts and feelings. The synastry of these two planets means that Charles and Diana are able to tell each other not only what they are thinking, but also how they are feeling. They are able to do so in a manner that is not threatening or hurtful to each other. Therefore Charles and Diana are both safe in the knowledge that they are not going to overreact, trampling on each other's feelings. Likewise Charles and Diana are easily able to acknowledge the value of the each other's thoughts and feelings. At times Charles and Diana may even feel they are telepathic together, seemingly not needing words to communicate but understanding each other's unspoken thoughts. Together Charles and Diana are able to take a balanced approach combining passion and reason. They have an understanding and rapport that enables them to clarify their own thoughts and feelings. Charles is likely to be the more intuitive of the two, while Diana is likely to rely more on the intellect when communicating.

Diana's Moon is Opposite Charles's Sun (Orb 1°05')

'Opposites attract' could be the theme for this combination of personal planets. There is an instant spark when Diana and Charles meet, whether they choose to enjoy a friendship or a more intimate relationship. The world seems more exciting when they are together. When together Diana and Charles are able to broaden their horizons in ways they had not thought possible. Each one seems to fill a void deep inside the other. In astrology it is considered important to have a combination of personal planets in order to enjoy a deep relationship, but this can be a difficult combination once the initial excitement has worn off. Friction easily arises and what was once attractive becomes irritating. The success of this relationship largely depends on each person's ability to accept the other person's differences. Charles may eventually have difficulty understanding Diana's emotional nature. Charles may feel impatient and frustrated by the limitations placed on him by Diana. Diana may feel overwhelmed by Charles's personality. The initial excitement of the association with someone so opposing in nature may be replaced by feelings of insecurity. It's important for both Diana and Charles to continue to appreciate each other's differences at all times and to realize that this relationship is potentially very rewarding if the difficulties can be faced and resolutions found.

Charles's Sun is Sextile Diana's Sun (Orb 0°31')

When two people's Sun signs are connecting in a positive manner it augurs well for any relationship. However, it is an ideal combination for a close, personal relationship whether it is a close friendship or love relationship. There is an instant rapport and the two people seem to shine more in their own lives as a result of such a connection. Charles and Diana enjoy each other's company and feel that the other person is giving something special to the relationship, adding a little sunshine to their lives. Charles and Diana probably experienced an instant attraction when they first met, warming to each other's personalities. This is because Charles and Diana have a lot in common and tend to view the world in the same fashion. Sharing a common purpose they work and play well together. It is easy for them to co-operate, creating harmony in shared enterprises and activities. In fact Charles and Diana are likely to experience luck and good fortune in joint projects. There can be a tendency for friendly rivalry, but this usually brings out the best in both Charles and Diana. All in all it is a very successful combination of personal planets.

Diana's Sun is Square Charles's Mars (Orb 2°00')

This is a relationship that begins with a fanfare and ends with a bang. This fiery combination of the Sun and the planet Mars is a difficult one. Any relationship with this combination is likely to be difficult to maintain unless there are other more positive connections. There is much excitement when Diana and Charles first get together; an electric sexual energy pulsates between both of them. Both Diana and Charles feel a rush of energy when in each other's company. However, this quickly becomes friction because Diana and Charles are trying to head in different directions. Conflict is likely. The problem is that Diana feels overpowered by the demands of Charles, and unable to positively express herself in this union. The frustration can build to the point where Diana's attitude aggravates Charles. Diana feels that her personality is squashed by Charles. Charles is frustrated by the demands of Diana, feeling unable to pursue his goals. In the end the sexual attraction may fail to be enough to maintain a long-term intimate union. Depending on other connections in this relationship Diana and Charles may finally decide to end their association. They may need to seek counsel on how to resolve conflict, which at times could be quite fiery.

Charles's Mercury is Sextile Diana's Mercury (Orb 1°45')

Communication plays a central role in the success of any relationship whether it is a love union, friendship or work association. This combination indicates a meeting of true minds. Charles and Diana are able to converse easily with each other, sharing the stimulation of exchanging thoughts and opinions. Perhaps they also share a similar outlook on life. Charles and Diana understand each other and feel at ease together, enjoying each other's company. Lively conversations and shared pastimes feature in this relationship. They are able to appreciate each other's sense of humor and make light of any difficult arguments, often finding a creative way of approaching problematic subjects. In other words this is a harmonious combination and augurs well for the relationship. It is likely that Charles and Diana's communication takes the form of letter writing or the exchanging of notes, or perhaps even electronic mail. Whatever the form of communication it is important that both Charles and Diana keep in touch. This is an ideal

combination for a personal love relationship and friendship. It is also beneficial for a work association, which requires an intelligent and energetic approach to a joint project or task.

Charles's Venus is Conjunct Diana's Venus (Orb 1°19')

This is an ideal combination for a love relationship, providing the spark for an instant attraction. Ancient astrologers considered the planet Venus to have most beneficial effects and this could be seen clearly in relationship astrology. Both Charles and Diana are attracted to each other, seeing the very best of himself or herself reflected in the other person. They enjoy each other's company, making the most of their joint interests. Charles and Diana are likely to enjoy various pleasurable outings ranging from alfresco meals to visits to the theatre. As long as they are together they are happy. Charles and Diana are in agreement on how their relationship should be approached e.g. the blend of freedom and closeness, intellect and emotion, personal time and social activities to name a few. This combination is most ideal for a long-lasting love relationship, indicating many years of happiness. It is also beneficial for a friendship in which both people can enjoy each other's company. Even so the friends need to respect other people's rights, otherwise there is a temptation for them to act like lovers when they are not, thus alienating their partners and other friends.

Charles's Venus is Sextile Diana's Mars (Orb 0°34')

This is the ideal combination for a love union because it creates a strong sexual attraction and compatibility. Charles and Diana are likely to fall in love at first sight enjoying a passionate union, the type of love affair featured in romance novels. The durability of the relationship depends on other connections between Charles and Diana. However, if the love union is long term, both Charles and Diana can rely on the sexual attraction to help them through troubled times. Charles and Diana enjoy spending time together, in particular welcoming pleasure trips, romantic outings and artistic activities. They may also find pleasure in a joint creative project. Diana is likely to be the more assertive partner, both in bed and out of bed. Diana enjoys taking the lead and Charles is happy to acquiesce. While this combination is ideal for marriage or love affairs, it can also be a creative connection for friendships or work associations that involve working on an artistic project. However, it is important that both individuals remain focused on the creative project at hand unless a sexual flirtation is welcomed and appropriate.

Charles's Mars is Conjunct Diana's Mars (Orb 3°59')

This is a feisty relationship full of healthy competition and possibly sexual frisson. In this association both Charles and Diana are challenged to produce their best efforts. They feel the sparks fly when they are together, bringing out an ambitious side to both their natures. As friends or work colleagues they enjoy the rivalry, and it is always possible that their shared drive and energy could become sexual, tipping their relationship into a love affair. Charles and Diana enjoy energetic activities such as sports and outdoor games. Together they feel able to conquer the world and overcome all obstacles in their path. Depending on other aspects of their relationship Charles and Diana may be lovers or friends, but this strong influence of the planet Mars can also indicate a work partnership that requires plenty of drive and initiative.

Primary Forces

In addition to the intimate aspect of a relationship, there are usually a number of fundamental driving forces, which can be either major challenges or inspirations to the individuals involved. This section looks at how Charles and Diana stimulate and provoke each other.

Charles's Moon is Trine Diana's Jupiter (Orb 3°07')

This is a positive combination for any relationship enabling Charles and Diana to overcome any obstacles in life and embrace the happiness of the present moment. Charles and Diana enjoy each other's company and feel a certain zest for life when together. They share a need for fun-filled adventures and the capability of achieving their goals. Charles and Diana feel that the world is their oyster that is ready to explore together. This can include holidays in far-away places, adventure travel and also encompasses any activity that expands their minds and views of life. This is a meeting of higher-minds. Charles feels that Diana expands his horizons. Charles feels safe and appreciated in this relationship. Diana knows that Charles is a comrade in arms when it comes to fun and adventure. Diana feels that she is truly appreciated for her generosity and optimism. Together Charles and Diana can conquer the world. Nothing seems too far-fetched. This combination augurs well for a long lasting and happy relationship.

Charles's Moon is Trine Diana's Neptune (Orb 1°46')

Romance is a major theme in a union which involves the Moon and the planet Neptune. With this combination of planets Charles and Diana both feel that they are meant to be together. Perhaps they believe that it is a union of their souls. This is the height of romantic love. Charles and Diana intuitively understand each other and as a result their relationship proceeds from the start in a gentle and loving manner. They may simply enjoy relaxing in each other's company or together Charles and Diana may enjoy creative and harmonious pastimes which enhance their union bringing joy and fulfillment. They could work jointly on an artistic, musical or spiritual project, or simply share an inspirational hobby. Either way, they are drawn to each other in a way that is not logical. At times they may even feel as though they have a psychic connection. Charles feels inspired by Diana to the point of longing to be in Diana's company. Diana intuitively understands Charles's emotional needs and relates to Charles in a caring manner. This is a harmonious relationship. Problems can occur if Charles becomes overly dependent on Diana. However, on the whole it augurs well for a personal relationship which thrives on mutual love and understanding.

Charles's Moon is Opposite Diana's Pluto (Orb 0°07')

This is an intense and powerful relationship. Charles and Diana feel a strong attraction to each other, one that seems to unconsciously draw them together. Charles's and Diana's deep feelings for each other need to be nurtured in a loving manner in order for the union to be long lasting. However, this can be quite difficult for Charles and Diana to achieve. It's not that they don't love each other, because they do care very deeply. The problem is that at times their intense emotions seem to erupt from nowhere. In fact the feelings have

been simmering under the surface ready to be expressed at any moment. The pressure builds up quickly between Charles and Diana and before they know it they are embroiled in an emotional drama. Of course this can vary, depending on how Charles and Diana handle intense feelings. Some individuals thrive on intensity, while others feel threatened and powerless. Charles is likely to feel that his life has been transformed in some way by Diana. It's possible that Diana has changed the way that Charles feels about the world, making him conscious of things that have been bubbling under the surface for a long time. Life is not the same for Charles once he encounters Diana. He may feel powerless, overwhelmed by Diana's volatile nature. The key is for Charles is able to see through the explosive behaviour to the true heart of Diana and to nurture Diana's goodness. As a result Diana will deeply appreciate the emotional support offered by Charles. If this does not occur then it is likely that Diana will feel angry about the constant demands being placed on her by Charles. Diana will start to withdraw and become isolated, only initiating contact in the relationship when she feels at boiling point. The challenge for Diana is to maintain a loving attitude and to give Charles time to learn his emotional lessons. This is indeed a passionate personal union and one that needs to be loving, otherwise there is a danger of abuse. This combination can also signify a secret love affair in which intense feelings are indeed in the background. It can also depict an intense working relationship in which power struggles abound, but it is more likely to point to a personal union.

Diana's Moon is Opposite Charles's Chiron (Orb 6°52')

Compassion is needed if this union is to overcome the difficulties presented by this combination of the Moon and the asteroid Chiron. Ultimately this can be a healing relationship, one that presents both Diana and Charles with opportunities to heal past emotional wounds and head in new directions. However, initially they have to overcome old hurts that stand in the way of honest communication. Unwittingly, Charles is likely to spark Diana's painful memories. This could be by saying the wrong thing at the wrong time, or by his actions. Diana's memories may have been forgotten; only surfacing in fragments. Diana may have difficulty connecting the current day events with the past associations. Either way the force of Diana's reactions may surprise both Diana and Charles. The onus is on Diana to find a way to understand her emotional reactions, to heal the past and move on in life with renewed self-confidence and understanding. Charles also needs to become more aware of the effects of his behaviour on other people. A gentle and loving approach is often needed. Perhaps Charles is preparing to become a teacher or healer and needs these valuable lessons.

Diana's Sun is Square Charles's Jupiter (Orb 6°56')

The Sun and the favorable planet Jupiter are combining, suggesting that this relationship is blessed with good fortune and a happiness in the short term; however, a long-term relationship may be fraught with insecurities. Initially Diana and Charles feel a strong sense of togetherness, sharing many new and varied activities. Both Diana and Charles feel that the other person is contributing positively to their lives. They feel more alive within this union. Gradually the excitement wears off and they become aware that they have very different philosophies on life. Whereas once Diana felt that her life purpose was expanded by the forward moving energy of Charles, now she feels that Charles

doesn't know when to stop. She becomes aware that Charles's values are very different and that this is hindering her ability to express her full potential. Charles was once excited by the strength of Diana's purpose in life. However, now Charles feels that his path is being blocked by Diana's stubborn personality. This combination brings benefits to the couple in the first throes of the relationship, but it is going to take work to maintain the relationship. The long-term success of this association depends on other connections between Diana and Charles.

Diana's Sun is Square Charles's Uranus (Orb 6°58')

This is a relationship full of verve and romance, particularly in the first throes of love. Diana and Charles are attracted to each other from the moment that they first meet and continue to experience excitement and joy in each other's company. Despite this sense of adventure, Diana and Charles may have trouble maintaining a committed, long-term relationship unless they both enjoy plenty of freedom. This combination of the Sun and the planet Uranus suggest more an erratic and thrilling relationship, rather than a stable one. This works well if both Diana and Charles value their independence and have stimulating pursuits. However, the initial enthusiasm can fade if Diana and Charles begin to experience the need to accommodate each other's needs and desires in this union, to the detriment of their own interests. If Diana and Charles both like to maintain their individuality, the relationship works well. This is particularly true for Charles, who stresses his individuality and can be unwilling to adjust to the demands of a serious relationship unless he is given freedom to do his own thing. However, if Diana feels the need for more security and routine, then this can present problems. Charles may begin to feel overwhelmed by what he perceives as Diana's strong personality and may have problems showing a long-term commitment. Likewise Diana may believe that Charles stands in the way of her expressing her true nature. Either way this association brings something new and original into Diana and Charles's lives and they both feel enlivened as a result. The long-term success of this union may depend on other connections between Diana and Charles's astrology charts.

Charles's Sun is Opposite Diana's North Node (Orb 7°12')

Destiny plays a strong role in Charles and Diana's relationship. There is an instant attraction, a spark that ignites the feelings of both Charles and Diana. However, fate can be a cruel mistress. This relationship is fraught with problems that Charles and Diana find difficult to understand and solve. In particular Diana feels that his light is hidden under bushel. She struggles to express her true self. Perhaps Diana owes Charles a favor that seems never to be full repaid or may Diana has an inexplicable sense of responsibility for Charles. Whatever the scenario both Charles and Diana face certain challenges before reaching a full understanding of this union.

Diana's Mercury is Trine Charles's Jupiter (Orb 5°19')

This is a positive combination of the planets Mercury and Jupiter and provides inspiration in any relationship whether it is a friendship, work association or more intimate union. Both Diana and Charles discover new worlds through their association. They enjoy broadening their minds through overseas travel or by learning about different cultures in books and study courses. Philosophy, metaphysics and religion are topics of

conversation, which stimulate and expand their minds. It's also possible that Diana and Charles pursue activities connected with philanthropic or philosophical ideologies. In particular Diana's mind is extended through her relationship with Charles. Diana is willing to listen and accept the wisdom of Charles's ideas. In turn Diana is able to provide ways in which Charles can better communicate his ideas. Together they are able to grow and learn.

Charles's Mercury is Conjunct Diana's Saturn (Orb 5°53')

This is an excellent combination for an enduring relationship. Both Charles and Diana share a mutual respect for each other and are willing to work towards sound communication. They take each other seriously, and are likely to share an interest in a thought-provoking pastime or a business enterprise. Shared values also mean that this relationship has firm foundations for the long term. Charles and Diana realize early in their association that this is a lasting union. Therefore it is likely that they slowly and surely get to know each other, rather than rushing headlong into a relationship. As a result they eventually form a strong bond. Charles respects and learns from Diana's wisdom. He is better able to communicate his own thoughts and ideas thanks to Diana's well-received advice. Diana's organizational abilities shine in this relationship. She discovers different methods of approaching activities through her association with Charles.

Charles's Mercury is Conjunct Diana's Pluto (Orb 6°23')

An intense relationship is the result of this combination of the planets Mercury and Pluto, with communication playing a key role. Consequently it is vital that both Charles and Diana communicate honestly, keeping all emotions and thoughts out in the open. This helps them to keep the relationship dynamic rather than volcanic. If Charles and Diana enjoy penetrating discussions and passionate pastimes then all is well. If they don't then their union could become overwhelming, particularly for Charles. Together they experience a change of perception which is ultimately rewarding, although initially could be disruptive. Notably Diana challenges Charles's way of viewing the world. This can be an excellent combination for personal and spiritual growth. Consequently it is an ideal combination for a therapist and client relationship. It can also be beneficial for an intimate relationship or friendship, if both partners enjoy intensity, and a demanding working association.

Diana's Mercury is Trine Charles's North Node (Orb 0°14')

The North Node is a significant point in relationship astrology, indicating fate in any association. In this case Diana and Charles are destined to meet and learn from each. Perhaps they meet in a study group, as pen pals or at a college. Charles gains insight and understanding through his association with Diana. Perhaps Diana is a teacher imparting specific knowledge, or maybe Diana's presence communicates certain messages that are valuable for Charles's life lessons. Either way Diana and Charles are comfortable interacting with each other. Depending on aspects of Diana and Charles's birth charts, this association indicates an intellectual rapport rather than a passionate or emotional bond.

Diana's Venus is Conjunct Charles's Neptune (Orb 3°34')

Romance is the key theme of this combination of planets. Diana and Charles feel that they have met their one true love under the influence of the planets Venus and Neptune. They meet, fall in love and create a union brimming with romance, joy and idyllic love. Whether or not this idyll lasts depends on other aspects of the association. During the course of their union they are able to interact in a loving and creative manner. It's also possible that Diana and Charles participate in a joint creative and imaginative pursuit, inspiring each other to stretch their artistic talents. Perhaps Diana and Charles follow a spiritual path together. Diana is particularly attracted to Charles's artistic and altruistic nature. She appreciates all of the qualities that Charles brings to their relationship. In response Charles feels that Diana's support enables his talents to blossom. While this attraction is more likely to involve the love and devotion associated with a strong bond such as marriage, it can also depict a creative, artistic or spiritual working partnership.

Diana's Venus is Sextile Charles's Pluto (Orb 1°08')

Intense emotions are central to this relationship. Diana and Charles feel a passionate attraction to each other, a compelling need to be together. Sexual magnetism plays an important role in the initial stages of the union and continues, even through times of emotional difficulties. It is also possible that Diana and Charles share an artistic or creative pursuit about which they are both ardent. Whatever the outlet for the emotions, the key is intensity. On the whole this combination of the planets Venus and Pluto has a positive influence on any association, but it can be overpowering in some instances. If both Diana and Charles enjoy intensity then this relationship positively transforms both their lives. Together they embrace the changes that challenge any relationship. If one of them dislikes emotional upheaval, then there are likely to be problems. In particular Diana may feel overwhelmed at times by the force of her own emotions or the power of Charles's personality. At other times Diana enjoys learning about how to be more influential in her life. Charles feels more powerful as a result of this union with Diana, more able to achieve his ambitions.

Charles's Mars is Conjunct Diana's Neptune (Orb 7°42')

The glue that holds Charles and Diana together is a focus on a joint artistic, spiritual or philanthropic cause, and a shared idyll of how to make the world a better place. Together they share many dreams of how to improve their lives, their environment and the world at large. They are a creative duo, never short of ideas and with the ability to inspire. Depending on other aspects of their personalities they may or may not have the stability and endurance to create something concrete. Charles is likely to be the leader, the person with the drive which enables them to achieve these dreams. Diana is the creative ideas person who inspires Charles. If Charles and Diana fail to share a common dream, then this relationship is likely to lack direction and Charles and Diana slowly drift apart. They have difficulty maintaining a momentum necessary for a long-term bond. For this reason this combination of planets may indicate a relationship based on a shared project or past-time rather than an intimate lovers' bond. For instance Charles and Diana may share a friendship, enjoying martial arts as a shared activity.

Diana's Mars is Trine Charles's Pluto (Orb 0°23')

This combination of the stormy planets Mars and Pluto indicates a passionate and compelling union. The atmosphere is explosive when Diana and Charles get together. Sexual energy seems to simmer barely under control. Both Diana and Charles need to be wary of letting the force of their heated emotions build up. They need a positive outlet for all of their pent-up energy whether this is a challenging home renovation project or a regular work-out at the gym. Together Diana and Charles feel able to conquer the world and are certainly a power to be reckoned with. The initial stages of the relationship are fraught with sexual tension, but the union may not be an intimate one. Rather it may be a partnership committed to hard work and a challenging project. Either way as the relationship develops; the strong and creative force of both Diana and Charles takes over and can be directed into a mutually satisfying project. In other words Diana and Charles can be passionate about each other or they can direct their passion into an external activity. Either way this is a dynamic and explosive relationship.

Charles's Jupiter is Conjunct Diana's Jupiter (Orb 3°40')

A bountiful and loving relationship is the result of the strong influence of the planet Jupiter on this relationship. Ancient astrologers consider the planet Jupiter to be the great benefic, hence shining good fortune on this union whether it is a friendship, work association or romantic liaison. This relationship brings joy into the lives of both Charles and Diana. The attraction is strong, although not necessarily a sexual rapport. Charles and Diana share common goals and the impetus to explore these goals together. Their paths have crossed and it is more fun to continue their journey together. This can include journeys into the philosophical realms or adventures into other lands. Charles and Diana share the same beliefs, possibly even common religious beliefs. They bring out the best in each other. Together they also bring out the best in other people. As a result they attract much good fortune when they join forces. They are examples of the adage "lucky in love".

Diana's Jupiter is Trine Charles's Saturn (Orb 1°42')

A strong bond is formed as a result of this combination of the planets Jupiter and Saturn, in which both Diana and Charles learn a great deal from each other. In many ways Diana and Charles take an opposing approach to their relationship. Diana is more adventurous, keen to explore new territories. She takes a somewhat philosophical approach to this relationship. On the other hand Charles is cautious, often taking a slower and more practical outlook. Fortunately they enjoy these opposing qualities, finding equilibrium in their relationship. Charles finds his day enlivened by Diana's personality. In turn Diana enjoys having a stable and patient companion to bounce her ideas off. Charles learns much from Diana's wisdom, gaining a greater understanding of his own nature. Together Diana and Charles can achieve much success in either their personal lives or a joint project.

Charles's Jupiter is Conjunct Diana's Neptune (Orb 1°13')

This is a union of empathy and understanding, particularly in the areas of spiritual and religious beliefs. Both Charles and Diana understand and share each other's aspirations and dreams. At times their intuitive understanding of each other is so keen that they almost seem telepathically linked. It is possible that both Charles and Diana share a spiritual or religious conviction and belong to the same group or church. This may be a central force in their association. It is also possible that they take part in a philanthropic pursuit such as mission work in a foreign country or working for the same charitable organization. Whatever the outlet for their beliefs, both Charles and Diana appreciate and enjoy each other's values, thus enabling them to better pursue a more altruistic path in life. Charles and Diana brighten each other's lives through their shared beliefs.

Charles's Jupiter is Sextile Diana's Pluto (Orb 0°40')

Charles and Diana are rejuvenated through their relationship. Life takes on a new glow from their first moment of meeting. In each other Charles and Diana have found a soul-mate, someone who understands them at a very deep, metaphysical level. As the relationship develops both Charles and Diana are challenged to reach deep within themselves in order to change and grow. Depending on their individual traits they can either enjoy this process of change or they can resist. Either way they are being dared to view their lives in a different and broader manner. Charles and Diana encourage each other in this growth process through co-operation and understanding. Together they feel able to overcome all obstacles. As a result it is likely that, through this union, both Charles and Diana begin to lead more creative lives.

Diana's Jupiter is Trine Charles's North Node (Orb 1°24')

The North Node indicates a significant and ordained contact. The planet Jupiter casts a beneficial influence. Therefore this is a positive and uplifting combination for any relationship. Diana and Charles enjoy each other's company, both benefiting from the joy that is destined to enter their lives through this liaison. It is possible that Diana and Charles meet while traveling, at a place of higher learning, in a sports arena or through a philosophical or religious organization. Together they enjoy exploring any or all of these avenues of joint interests. Fate has smiled on this relationship.

Diana's Jupiter is Opposite Charles's Uranus (Orb 3°38')

This combination of the two planets Jupiter and Uranus indicates a meeting of two individual minds. In some associations it can be a case of "opposites attract". At the beginning of their relationship Diana and Charles are attracted by the novelty of each other, but this quickly wears off. However, differences between Diana and Charles are difficult to overcome. What follows is a discordant union. Their individual natures clash. What was once attractive becomes irritating and a cause of friction. Both Diana and Charles find it awkward to allow each other the independence needed to pursue their individual interests. The end result for an intimate bond depends on other aspects of the relationship. However, this combination is a formidable one and could result in a love relationship breaking down unless Diana and Charles find a way of following their independent paths within their association. A friendship or work association also needs to provide plenty of scope for individual expression.

Charles's Saturn is Trine Diana's Ascendant (Orb 6°05')

The planet Saturn is a vital ingredient in relationship astrology. It is the planet that represents stability and commitment and is seen by astrologers as the necessary glue that holds a relationship together on a long-term basis. Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. This is particularly true of connections between one person's Saturn and another person's Sun, Moon, Ascendant or Nodes. In this case Charles's Saturn is combining with Diana's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant relationship. Charles and Diana feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. This is a significant relationship.

Diana's Uranus is Trine Charles's Ascendant (Orb 4°29')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Diana's Uranus is combining with Charles's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant relationship. Diana and Charles feel strongly drawn to each other. Diana is enthusiastic about her relationship with Charles. She enjoys exploring new territories with Charles. On the whole this is a positive combination, but only if Diana and Charles allow each other a great deal of independence. In particular Diana craves the freedom to explore her own interests. While this union is a significant one, it may not be a long-term association. Both Diana and Charles may enjoy the fun and excitement of a brief encounter rather than making solid plans for a shared future. The longevity of this liaison depends on other connections between Diana and Charles's planets. This combination can denote an intimate love union, friendship, or work association.

Diana's Chiron is Sextile Charles's Ascendant (Orb 3°09')

The combination of Diana's Chiron and Charles's Ascendant is a gentle and healing one. It is possible for both Diana and Charles to be transformed in a gentle manner through this union. In particular Diana may play a healing role in Charles's life. This may through forming a loving and intimate bond or as a nurse or alternative healer. Either way Diana and Charles appreciate the contributions that each make to the other person's life. Diana shows much love and compassion towards Charles. In return Charles is an amiable and considerate friend.

Generational Values

Underpinning the success of many relationships is a sense of shared values. Often this comes from simply being born into the same generation. However, sometimes it is more complex. In this section we explore whether or not Charles and Diana share the same societal values.

Charles's Saturn is Square Diana's Uranus (Orb 4°36')

This is a difficult combination of planets in relationship astrology indicating an imbalance between commitment and freedom. On the one hand Charles and Diana feel drawn to each other, seeing qualities in each other that they feel they lack themselves. Charles and Diana believe that they will learn from being together. On the other hand; however, tension soon results as they fail to reconcile their differences. Charles is likely to take a more serious approach to this union, feeling the need for a strong bond. However, Diana is hard to pin down, preferring the freedom of non-commitment. Diana wants to initiate change and growth even though Charles is likely to resist. It is possible that Charles becomes frustrated and tries to control Diana's behaviour. Charles may even resort to criticism which ultimately only undermines Diana's creative impulses and self-confidence. If this happens Diana is likely to rebel and leave the relationship. Both Charles and Diana need to strive for a balance between commitment to each other and independence.

Diana's Saturn is Square Charles's Pluto (Orb 3°43')

The combination of the planets Saturn and Pluto indicates that this is an important and challenging relationship, although not necessarily an intimate one. Diana and Charles have difficulty relating to each other, both approaching the association from different angles. Diana tends to communicate with Charles in a serious and cautious manner, hoping to run a stable course. However, Charles feels restricted by this method of relating and wants to break out. Resentment can build up on both sides causing friction that is difficult to resolve.

Charles's Saturn is Square Diana's Chiron (Orb 3°16')

This union is fraught with difficulties, mainly because of Charles and Diana's past experiences in relationships. Hurtful experiences from previous important relationships initially have a negative impact hampering both Charles and Diana's ability to build a secure and loving relationship. However, both Charles and Diana are committed to each other, to making this relationship work. As a result past hurts are examined and healed in this union. It is possible that Charles fears emotional intimacy, at first putting up barriers that hinder the growth of this union. Perhaps he has trouble trusting the strength of the bond with Charles. Gradually Charles learns to trust the enduring nature of this relationship and both Charles and Diana learn the joys of intimacy.

Charles's Uranus is Trine Diana's Pluto (Orb 0°37')

The combination of the planets Uranus and Pluto indicates that Charles and Diana share common values. A drive for growth and change is at the basis of this relationship,

whether it be a personal or impersonal association. Charles and Diana complement each other whenever they join forces. Charles is likely to be the one who seeks answers and innovative ways of approaching tasks while Diana provides the answers after delving into her own personal resources.

Charles's Uranus is Opposite Diana's Neptune (Orb 1°15')

Although not a major contributor to this relationship, the combination of the planets Uranus and Neptune can cause conflict. The problem is that Charles is looking for intellectual stimulation in this partnership, whereas Diana is seeking romance. Charles is keen to experience a certain amount of freedom in order to explore his individual pursuits. However, Diana yearns for romance and sharing in common interests. Their values differ and it is hard to meet in the middle.

Charles's Neptune is Trine Diana's Chiron (Orb 5°34')

The healing powers of nature, music and the arts may play a significant role in this union. Charles and Diana have a romantic and empathetic relationship, in which they both place importance on gentle and loving communication. As a result they are able to forgive and forget loved ones who have hurt them in the past, and move slowly towards a better understanding of their innermost selves and each other. The artistic and spiritual side of Charles's nature proves particularly healing for Diana. Under Charles's gentle influence, Diana is able to heal past emotional wounds and better express herself. Together they may take part in a spiritual, healing or artistic project.
