Astrological Midpoints

History of Midpoint Combinations

What is a Midpoint?

The use of midpoints historically goes back to 1200 AD when Guido Bonati, a famous Italian Astrologer, used half sums, otherwise known as midpoints, in his interpretation of a chart. More recently at the turn of the century, Alan Leo, a famous American Astrologer, used midpoints along with solar arc directions. I personally have no knowledge of the use of midpoints combined with the 90-degree dial prior to its use by Reinhold Ebertin and Alfred Witte at the beginning of the Nineteen Hundreds. The history of solar arcs on the other hand, goes back to Ptolemy who used primary directions in the second century.

A midpoint is the center between any two points, which in Astrology relates to the center between two planets and/or personal points, including the Midheaven, Ascendant, and the Nodes. This center point is the meeting of planetary energies that becomes active through the process of growth, relating to the passage of time. We relate to the aspects formed by the heavenly bodies through spatial relationship. This system as I mentioned earlier goes back to Reinhold Ebertin who, near the turn of the century developed this system along with Alfred Witte by taking a 360-degree wheel and breaking it down into a 90-degree dial. Ebertin believed that hard aspects created events in one's life thus; the use of the 90-degree dial became a viable tool for forecasting future events. Ebertin started by placing the planets into three sections -- 30 degrees for Cardinal Positions which include: Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn points; 30 degrees for Fixed Positions which include: Taurus, Leo, Scorpio and Aquarius points; and 30 degrees for Mutable Positions which include: Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius and Pisces points.

This system can be seen on the 90 degree dial as 0 to 30 degrees as Cardinal, 30 to 60 degrees Fixed and 60 to 90 degrees as Mutable positions for the planetary points to be placed in accordance of their quality.

How to Use this System

This system can be used to add great insight into the interpretations of the natal chart through the use of delineation of transits, progressions, solar arcs and degree arcs. In fact it can be used in almost any interpretive form of astrology where timing is added into the equation. Timing is where this type of Astrology becomes very precise and accurate. The best way to use this system is to incorporate the natal midpoint along with the time that

its energy becomes activated by directing the planets into the future. This is done by Solar Arc, which is the distance it takes for the Sun to move from one day to the next at the time of one's birth, which is approximately 59' to 1 degree 2', which is then added to the age in question. We can also use degree arcs, known as age arcs, which is equivalent to one degree equals one year, times the number of years old you are now and/or when the specific event in question occurred. It may sound difficult, but it's not once you become familiar with this system of delineation. When using this tool you will notice that I have included health interpretations along with dietary issues, which often come up when there is a lack of good nutrition or assimilation of nutrients. This can be seen easily through the activation of the natal midpoints on the 90-degree dial. Thus, I included medical interpretations in most of the midpoint structures.

Each midpoint structure has many meanings, so I have narrowed it down to the most important interpretation of each of them based upon my years of past experience. These interpretations are done in the higher and lower, or shadow manifestations. We are all on the earth plane of existence, thus no matter how enlightened we may seem, we still have to deal with our shadow. Many midpoints include births, health areas and transitions and only a part of what is said may apply to you personally. But on the other hand the whole interpretation may apply. I have included the positive and negative side of each of these midpoints so as to reach all probable outcomes.

Many times there will be others who are read through one's personal chart, since these people become the players in one's personal movie. These players include midpoints with:

Moon	=	Mother and the Feminine principal
Saturn	=	Father/Business Associates, masculine principal
Mercury/Mars	=	Brothers and Male Relatives
Mercury/Venus	=	Sisters and Female Relatives
Sun/Node	=	Children
Venus/Uranus	=	Female Friends
Mars/Uranus	=	Male Friends
Jupiter	=	Grandparents

Relationships include almost any midpoint, which involves the Sun, Moon, Venus and Mars combined with the personal points, Asc, Mc, Moon and Node and always be aware of the rulerships of these positions.

Your Birth Chart: Midpoint Combinations

The natal midpoints represent our birth traits, our strengths, weaknesses and potential for personal growth. Each midpoint could involve others who are part of our life's path. Thus, a natal midpoint may apply to family and friends as opposed to the energy being directed to the self. Likewise, the medical influences and health issues mentioned are often manifest by others in our lives as opposed to the self. The possible medical problems, as well as the "shadow side" of a midpoint may never become an active manifestation of the midpoint's energy when addressed early. Keep an open mind when reading the interpretations of a midpoint since they are geared to both the higher and lower manifestations of the energy, and be aware that medical references should not be treated as a diagnosis. Psychological or physical symptoms or problems should be directed to the appropriate professional for diagnosis and evaluation. The timing of the events indicated by these natal midpoints are activated by progressions, directions and finally transits as the final touch off point sometime in the future.

Moon=Sun/Saturn Natal

Emotional inhibitions due to early family conditioning cause one to appear reserved; a manifestation of this is a feeling of separation from others, especially family members. This expresses itself through family responsibilities and the caring for a parent at the end of their life. Sometimes there is depression caused by psychological dilemmas, which manifest in the blocking of one's feelings, creating difficulty when in relationships with others. There could also be an early separation between the parents and/or going through problems within one's relationship that has the potential to lead to divorce if not corrected in time. Many people who have this work out of their home and have had a strong parent who struggled to make ends meet. There can also be a potential loss of one's home through mismanagement and/or separations.

Moon=Sun/Midheaven Natal

This relates to the family-run business that is successful and is passed on to the offspring. There can be fame for one of the parents due to being in the public eye as well as having the ability to work well with women in power. Many times a person can be successful in a business that revolves around food and/or real estate, and there can also be a move that is job related. Usually one is well liked and popular on the job and the work feels more like home, thus one feels most comfortable in the career area.

Sun=Moon/Node Natal

Meeting one's mate or spiritual equal is a representation of this energy, thus entering into a dynamic union. There's usually happiness when in the presence of others and there's a tendency to have good personal health and popularity. One has the potential to be in love and form a soul mate union. This can also relate to making a major connection that could change one's life and/or connect them with someone from a past life.

Sun=Mercury/Saturn Natal

The boss or the person who is in a position of authority is a reflection of this energy, as well as having the capacity to lead others professionally. On the shadow side, there can be slow growth of the bones and/or organic developmental problems along with forced growth or maturation. One has the ability to concentrate but on the other side there is difficulty when dealing with depression due to feeling that there is no way out. There can be separations from others that try to dominate and/or one is dominating over them. Always remember events in one's life are simply a reflection of their own inner reality, thus we can change the final outcome through advanced knowledge.

Sun=Mercury/Midheaven Natal

One has the ability to identify with their work as well as being recognized for their particular specialized skills. There is sales ability and one is able to relate to many people and cultures at once, along with the gift of gab or being a great storyteller. Sometimes there is the ability to speak in metaphors. There can also be meeting a romantic interest and/or developing a new relationship with a man who has strong Gemini or a mercurial personality now.

Mercury=Moon/Midheaven Natal

One has the ability to express the self in an emotional way, thus, having excellent communication skills. This relates to the writer on historical knowledge or the one who is the historian or has the memory of the past, similar to an Indian pipe carrier. Thus, these are the storytellers and the screenwriters. One has the capacity to be a good sales person and the ability to study to advance the career position. There's also success in the life of a sibling now.

Venus=Mercury/Jupiter Natal

The agreed upon contract, which turns out favorably, or the marriage agreement are manifestations of this energy. There can also be a successful female sibling who could get engaged or have an opportunity now. There can be abundance that comes into one's life through good news. This also represents the happy, well-liked person who has the ability to speak in public or to write about relationships and be very successful at it. There may be a decision going in one's favor along with an overall feeling of happiness in one's day-to-day thoughts.

Venus=Mercury/Neptune Natal

The gifted artist is a representation of this energy, denoting artistic ability, especially in professions like painters, musicians, singers, and the movie industry. Being in love with love is a symbol of this and an ethereal relationship can be

formed where love is far beyond normal reality. There's the capacity to create magic through illusion, or the movies. There can be a beautiful sister, who might have Pisces strong in their chart. On the negative side of this energy, there may be attraction to someone who isn't what they appear to be. Thus, this denotes the mate or partner who betrays, or is deceitful. The best way to use this energy is to read about spiritually enlightened people and apply that knowledge to one's personal life.

Mars=Uranus/Pluto Natal

This is a highly volatile energy wielded suddenly with intention. It relates to a sudden need for surgery, acts of violence, or extreme energy needed in competitive sports, or bodybuilding. This also relates to sudden accidents or major mistakes being made surgically. Medically this influence rules the eliminative systems in the physical body, as well as a desire to have facial plastic surgery to improve one's exterior appearance, thus relating in a rejuvenative effect.

Jupiter=Neptune (Spiritual Journey) Natal

When Jupiter and Neptune are in combination there is a tendency to create an awakening to universal oneness. It addresses our need to expand consciousness through our belief system and relates to the spiritual journey from within. It denotes the sacred sights we go to on the earth for a vision quest, or the person who seeks the application of higher knowledge which gives them more spiritual wisdom. There can be long journeys over water to distant countries, sharing beliefs and philosophies on life with others which are held in common or shared with foreigners. On the other side, there can be confusion surrounding one's belief system, thus becoming disillusioned with one's religious path. The personification of this relates to the defrocking of priests and/or ministers, along with the proverbial scandals of public officials and people who are ousted when it is discovered that they're not as spiritual as they portrayed themselves to be. This also relates to large rains and/or flooding, and people seem to take chances on speculation that end disastrously, so it's best not to get involved with the get rich quick schemes. Medically this rules toxicity in the liver and blood disorders effected by one's need to correct a belief that may be toxic, and physicians could make an incorrect diagnosis.

Saturn=Mercury/Pluto Natal

To decide to end one's career and to start another or begin a long-term work plan is a manifestation of this energy. This can also be a time of transitions for an uncle or a sibling. Many people have depressed thoughts due to working all the time, with no time to play or relax, just to work. Making long-range plans that can transform one's life, or trying to reorganize one's life, is a manifestation of this. There can also be separation from coworkers due to a lay offs or differences in opinions. Skeptics have this in their charts, due to pessimistic thoughts where they just can't see anything positive in their situation.

Saturn=Uranus/Node Natal

Career changes shared with others are one of the manifestations of this. It gives the need to change a pattern which has become boring or needs to be changed to bring in new energy. Sometimes these changes are fast and sudden, happening without warning. An example of this would be a shared layoff, or getting a new boss. This also relates to sudden earth changes which are experienced with others. The father and his health come to light with this, possibly causing problems in the heart or circulatory system. There can also be sudden changes in a man's career direction.

Saturn=Uranus/Ascendant Natal

This relates to making sudden changes surrounding one's structure. It gives the capacity to be rather unpredictable and yet, on the opposite side, very conventional. This seems to be the enigma effect in that there is a need to be in the present moment. The negative side of this energy can be where one takes chances and is always finding new ways to individuate from others. On a daily level, this is good for making changes suddenly, as in the residence and or job structure. Medically, this relates to a break and or problems with the teeth. Staying in harmony with one's environmental circumstances is very important.

Uranus=Sun/Jupiter Natal

Highly intelligent people carry this energy, and this also gives the capacity to understand more advanced subjects, like the high tech world and/or astrology. In fact, many times this represents a great astrologer. This can be a time of entering into higher education or ending one's studies, as in going on to college or finishing it. There's a love of learning and this can attract intelligent people to oneself; it also represents the big win or unexpected luck that can change the direction of one's life path.

Neptune=Mars/Jupiter Natal

One may have ease in expressing their beliefs, along with the need to share experiences with others. There can also be a feeling of being alone or by oneself, and there can be difficulty accomplishing what one sets out to do, since they tend to get involved in too many projects. On the shadow side of this energy, there can be the postulation of false beliefs, problems with unfaithfulness, and a lack of all-around good character. There can also be problems with the birth of a child due to toxicity in the system. With this, it's very important not to drink alcohol due to its addictive, toxic nature. This also rules hepatitis, in all its varied forms, thus giving one a slow weakening of the total immune system.

Neptune=Jupiter (Spiritual Journey) Natal

When Jupiter and Neptune are in combination there is a tendency to create an awakening to universal oneness. It addresses our need to expand consciousness through our belief system and relates to the spiritual journey from within. It denotes the sacred sights we go to on the earth for a vision quest, or the person who seeks the application of higher knowledge which gives them more spiritual wisdom. There can be long journeys over water to distant countries, sharing

beliefs and philosophies on life with others which are held in common or shared with foreigners. On the other side, there can be confusion surrounding one's belief system, thus becoming disillusioned with one's religious path. Node=Venus/Saturn Natal

These are associations that help us advance through forced growth. This represents difficulties arising through association with others with whom we share financial responsibility. There can be separation from others due to differences in values. One may have a tendency to connect with a mature or older person who could bring security into one's life. This may also manifest as marriage to someone that is mature and/or has already gained financial security, giving stability in one's own life.

Node=Venus/Midheaven Natal

There can be connections made that advance us in our career as well as contributing to a successful period in one's life. One can meet a person they may want to marry. This also denotes a time when one can give birth to a beautiful child and/or to a beautiful creation. It relates to the connections we have to the people we love.

Active Midpoints: Apr 01, 2005 to Mar 31, 2006

When interpreting the active midpoints one should keep in mind that the strongest midpoint is the one that is activating a natal midpoint. Thus if your natal midpoint has been activated by transit or progression/direction, then the possibility of the events happening are much stronger. The transits to that natal midpoint seem to be the final timer on an event, which could be indicated in the birth chart. These interpretations address not only what could likely happen for the self but also for others. These midpoints also relate to medical issues, which could be for the self and or others around you. Many times these interpretations medically will have already been addressed, since one may have been working on their personal habits long before, thus arresting any ill effects from the midpoint. The activation of midpoints can happen as early as 1 degree or the equivalent of one year ahead of the exact hit, thus it's good to really look ahead at the energy being activated (by directed planets especially) during the coming year. The active midpoints look at our potential for personal growth, act as a guide for our future and can be used as an adjunct to the usual techniques of interpretive astrology.

Apr 01, 2005 Mars = Neptune/Ascendant Direction: Solar Arc

One can be a very creative person who has the gift of awareness of dreamtime. There is a love of water; in fact, one needs to be near water to feel complete. On the other side of this there can be deliberate acts of deception from others or as the result of the lack of self-awareness. This is a highly sexual force which allows one to live out their fantasies on a sensual level, but on the reverse side it denotes sexual betrayal. Medically this rules a weakened immune system, burns from water, sexually transmitted diseases and potential paralysis of certain muscles.

Apr 04, 2005 Neptune = Venus/Node Transit

These are the relationships that help to advance the soul through spiritual awareness. They are the associations that add a spiritual dimension to one's life, along with a psychic connection. On the negative side, one could meet people who test their sense of reality, as well as people who have the potential to betray. It's important to know the person one connects with before one gives their most valuable asset: their love.

Apr 04, 2005 Mercury = Uranus (The Genius) Progressed

Mercury/Uranus relates to the higher and the lower mind uniting as one. One has the ability to have brilliant, unconventional, rebellious thoughts or to be a genius in a specific area. There is mental flexibility and detached, elevated thoughts, represented by the clairvoyant or having future sight. This energy relates to the

birth of an intelligent child or having a gifted sibling. It also relates to talking on a radio or telephone or studying and learning advanced technical subjects, such as astrology or even learning a new computer program. There can be talking with, associating with, or meeting new friends, as well as relating to the person who works with star knowledge, thus, having future sight. One also has an awareness of a higher order and meaning to life, and there's an ability to hear voices or to act as a receiver of knowledge. Medically, this relates to a highly sensitive nervous system, and being prone to electrical shocks from carpeting, etc. There is also the tendency to be contrary to the norm in one's thinking and one appears to be rebellious and unique.

Apr 05, 2005 * Jupiter = Sun/Uranus Transit

This is the main signature of the astrologer and/or it gives one the capacity to study difficult subjects like astrology. It rules the high tech and computer industries, thus giving one the capacity to master difficult subjects with ease. Usually people go on to college and/or seek out some form of higher education that is very enjoyable to them. There's the potential to have speculative abilities along with the gift of winning unexpectedly. There can also be advancement in life through one's attainment of knowledge and inner awareness. Many times there can be an unusual child born with a high degree of intellect.

Apr 05, 2005 Neptune = Moon/Neptune (Psychic Intuition) Transit

The Moon/Neptune contains the possibility of extreme intuitions, which may manifest through the seeing of visions or even developing one's dreamtime awareness. One has the capacity to have no time or a sense of timelessness. One seems to live in a dream world, where there are no proper boundaries and many times the mother or the grandmother could have had psychic abilities. This also relates to a person who deals with hidden guilt or shame and/or having a family secret that, if not addressed, can affect the physical health. There can be many intuitive gifts, and there is a sense of motion or waves, thus this rules the dancer. One may also have the capacity to become famous due to having intuitive or artistic skills. The medical issues usually revolve around the stomach, breasts, nutritional assimilation, and the lymph nodes. This is a powerful influence; if used correctly, there can be altered states of awareness, which can be used to guide others. On the negative or misuse of this energy, one could become deluded and confused, thus living in a self-made illusion that, eventually could affect the health. The best way to use this energy is to develop one's God-given talents, whatever they may be.

Apr 10, 2005 Uranus = Mars/Uranus (Unpredictable Energy) Transit

The energy of Mars combines with the unexpected quality of Uranus to create events that come from out of the blue or have an unpredictable nature, as in sudden electrical shocks, lightning or hearing shocking news. There's an attraction to the unusual or unique when it comes to friends, for a woman this would be interest in a rebellious type of man. One has the ability to individuate by not following the normal drumbeat and there can be association with unusual groups of people who are interested in advanced sciences or unique studies. There

can also be activities done in haste that could potentially cause accidents. There's a love of fast cars, or sports cars, or being a sports car driver since there's a need for lots of excitement and taking chances. Many stunt people have this quality. This also represents male bonding as in working out together at a health club or in any physical activity. A male child who embodies some of the qualities mentioned above can be born into a family.

Apr 10, 2005 Saturn = Node/Ascendant Transit

There is a desire to separate from others and go into seclusion. There's also a tendency to harden one's feelings, thus building walls for protection. Early life is usually difficult since one may have to be responsible for others within the environment. This is a character builder, though, giving one a sense of being able to withstand whatever life has to offer. One has a good sense of timing with this; in fact, they usually arrive early, but there's difficulty interacting with others once they're there, due to early environmental circumstances. One's early environment could make them the stand-alone type. Medically, this tends to cause ailments that limit, as in arthritis, bone problems due to lack of calcium assimilation, problems with the teeth, and difficulties with the eyes. This also manifests as the gaining of insight after a period of darkness in one's inner life.

Apr 10, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Venus Transit

The large beautiful home and a loving family are a manifestation of this energy. It represents the loving grandmother and/or the ancestral home. Many times people desire to buy a beautiful home that has historical value. There is also a love of travel, thus this relates to making future travel plans, possibly to the ancestral homeland. This could also be a good time to buy a Bed and Breakfast and/or go to one on a trip. One loves to cook, pleasure to others through the food they serve. On a financial level this represents success in one's ventures and opportunities to expand due to unions with others, which have the potential to become profitable.

Apr 11, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Ascendant Transit

These are the optimists of the zodiac, looking at most things as positive. There is a love of other cultures, thus a person usually travels a lot and wants to share their experiences with others. One also has the capacity to be a good teacher and/or present their beliefs to others or be in the ministry. There is usually a grandparent who could have influenced one's philosophy on life and possibly there is a foreign heritage. This is a good time to negotiate and sign agreements, as well as a good time to speculate. Another manifestation of this is to have a quite successful sibling.

Apr 13, 2005 Jupiter = Pluto (The Inheritance) Transit

When Jupiter and Pluto come together there is a focus on a deeper sense of beliefs where one seeks knowledge of the unknown. This energy relates to the priest and/or the initiation into a secret society or form of study. Good powers of judgment, especially when working with large sums of money, is another manifestation of this energy, as well as dealing with the IRS, taxes, banks, insurance companies, and estates through the death of a family member. There

There can be separations in the family and the sense of feeling alone in one's sufferings, or a period of depression with the need to tear down the old structures and rebuild new lasting ones. Many times one could be under the tyranny of another that was in the controlling position, like a father and/or boss. There can also be a feeling of being separated from long-term goals or a lack of clarity and direction when it comes to the career area. The highest manifestation of this energy would be to care for the needs of others by working part-time in a selfless service position as a volunteer.

Jun 26, 2005 Moon = Mars/Midheaven Progressed

Willful, independent women relate to this energy, or having to deal with an excitable woman in some area of life. One may have to deal with a strong-willed parent and/or boss with a rather dominant personality. Either way, life seems to be dominated by the emotions of another. On the positive side, one can get a lot done in a short amount of time, since there's the will to do it their own way by enhancing their personal objectives.

Jun 27, 2005 Pluto = Node/Midheaven Transit

One can be put in a position of power and prestige in one's career, due to the influence of others. One can achieve their goals through co-working with others. Large sums of money can come in now due to the help of others. On the other side of this, there can be problems created through the work environment, feeling as though one's advancement is being held back by people in authority, thus one may want to leave and start their own business. This also relates to transitions and births for those close to you.

Jun 27, 2005 Moon = Saturn/Neptune Progressed

Someone in the family may need to be taken care of now, thus there's a sense of helplessness when dealing with a family member. This is considered very karmic and so it represents paying off past karmic actions. On a medical level, this relates to chronic illnesses, like chronic fatigue or Epstein-Barr virus, where there is a lack of assimilation of the nutrition taken in. This potentially relates to breast cancer, so be sure and get a check up early, thus avoiding a major illness, although many times this is for someone close, not the self. One has a feeling that they didn't get what they needed in early life, emotionally feeling deprived and all alone. This is obviously a difficult influence, but on the positive side, it does give one a sense of personal self-reliance to weather whatever storm life has to offer.

Jun 28, 2005 Saturn = Mercury/Mars Transit

One has a good sense of timing when it comes to putting things into action, as well as a steady hand in one's business dealings. There can be the ability to be a craftsman and/or mechanic. On the reverse side of this energy, there could be problems in saying what one thinks without hesitation or thinking about how it would affect others. There could also be poor timing when it comes to doing things -- usually one is in too much of a hurry. On a medical level, this relates to stuttering, which usually one grows out of as time goes by.

Jun 30, 2005 * Node = Venus/Saturn Transit

These are associations that help us advance through forced growth. This represents difficulties arising through association with others with whom we share financial responsibility. There can be separation from others due to differences in values. One may have a tendency to connect with a mature or older person who could bring security into one's life. This may also manifest as marriage to someone that is mature and/or has already gained financial security, giving stability in one's own life.

Jul 01, 2005 Mars = Jupiter/Ascendant Direction: Solar Arc

One has a good sense of judgment along with the ability to have legal decisions go in one's favor. There's a cooperative attitude that creates teamwork with those close to you along with expansion through the environment. One could meet someone who is exactly what they've been looking for and they may help you to create a beautiful environment. Medically this corresponds to successful surgery.

Jul 02, 2005 Jupiter = Saturn/Midheaven Transit

When this comes along, one feels as though they've finally been given an opportunity that can change one's circumstances in life for the better. This can

come in the form of a rise within one's career area and/or making a big move from a smaller home to a larger one. There may be early family struggle, thus having to work hard for any advancement that is gained in life. On the negative or misuse of this energy, there could be depression and struggle which seem to create many obstacles. One may also have the belief that life is all about struggle, causing the glass to be half-empty. Medically this relates to the liver and toxicity. Be aware that the way one perceives their lot in life to be can eventually affect their health.

Jul 03, 2005 Saturn = Mercury/Neptune Transit

The process of coming out of the illusion and facing one's fear of the unknown are influenced by this energy. Professionally, there can be betrayal on the part of a partner, as well as meeting up with one's karma from past lives. There can be much depression due to years of hardship or taking care of someone who has had a long-term illness. There can also be a feeling as though one has been all alone without anyone who understands them, or the feeling of being spiritually bankrupt. On a positive level, one could have the ability to share spiritual words of enlightenment, which can help to save someone from their great sadness, such as being a substance abuse counselor. The best way to deal with this is through meditation, thus connecting to a higher source of consciousness.

Jul 04, 2005 Moon = Jupiter/Saturn Progressed

There is a desire to move forward in life by expanding in one's surroundings. Thus, there can be a purchasing of a new home and/or remodeling or doing major repairs on one's existing residence. On a psychological level, one may want to overcome early feelings of not having enough, or feeling less than enough, possibly because there just wasn't enough -- either way, it addresses our lack of emotional stability. This is present when a woman is trying to overcome difficult circumstances due to the lack of education and/or early family limitations that have held her back from her full potential.

Jul 04, 2005 Neptune = Moon/Neptune (Psychic Intuition) Transit

The Moon/Neptune contains the possibility of extreme intuitions, which may manifest through the seeing of visions or even developing one's dreamtime awareness. One has the capacity to have no time or a sense of timelessness. One seems to live in a dream world, where there are no proper boundaries and many times the mother or the grandmother could have had psychic abilities. This also relates to a person who deals with hidden guilt or shame and/or having a family secret that, if not addressed, can affect the physical health. There can be many intuitive gifts, and there is a sense of motion or waves, thus this rules the dancer. One may also have the capacity to become famous due to having intuitive or artistic skills. The medical issues usually revolve around the stomach, breasts, nutritional assimilation, and the lymph nodes. This is a powerful influence; if used correctly, there can be altered states of awareness, which can be used to guide others. On the negative or misuse of this energy, one could become deluded and confused, thus living in a self-made illusion that, eventually could affect the health. The best way to use this energy is to develop one's God-given talents, whatever they may be.

Jul 05, 2005 Saturn = Mercury/Jupiter Transit

One can have many worries about "should I expand or should I contract," or there could be financial concerns. There could be a decision to make a major purchase, like a home, along with possible changes in the stock market which could effect one's personal stocks and changes in the interest rates. Many people experience depression due to not making a decision until it's too late, or by just being complacent. This also relates to feeling like one doesn't have enough in the present moment. Thus, the "not enough" syndrome is part of one's life's journey.

Jul 06, 2005 Saturn = Sun/Mars Direction: Solar Arc

There's stability in one's direction and a determination and focus on personal goals. It gives control over one's work environment and a sense of respect for one's planning skills. On the reverse side, there can be problems in being the controller and/or being controlled by others. It can cause slow progress or delayed attainment of the goals that one sets out to accomplish. There can also be a block in the energy level and/or in one's ability to love and be loved. On a medical level, this relates to blockages in the heart or circulatory system due to closing off one's love nature.

Jul 06, 2005 Neptune = Venus/Node Transit

These are the relationships that help to advance the soul through spiritual awareness. They are the associations that add a spiritual dimension to one's life, along with a psychic connection. On the negative side, one could meet people who test their sense of reality, as well as people who have the potential to betray. It's important to know the person one connects with before one gives their most valuable asset: their love.

Jul 08, 2005 Saturn = Venus (Mature Love) Transit

Venus and Saturn combinations often relate to the desire for stability in one's life, along with the need for financial security in the relationships we attract to ourselves. Many times this results in marrying people who give us a sense of financial security, thus satisfying our need for stability. There can also be a desire for a long-term committed relationship with someone who is an equal in values. This commitment often is to someone who is older or more mature than oneself. One also has the capacity to have a great love for the father or have an attractive father whom is popular with women. On the other side of this, the father could have the potential of being a womanizer, thus affecting one's personal choices in relationship as one matures. Often times this causes one to feel alone in love within a relationship or being out of balance and feeling that one is giving more than their partner is. There is a need to address one's fears about relationships, since one could attract people who don't fulfill their needs, thus they feel unloved and hurt. This sets up a movie where fears and blocks become the major players, causing separation and divorce as the end result. There could also have been divorce between the parents, which reinforced this feeling that one can't trust relationships, thus, ending in the separation of the love bond. Medically, there can be beautiful skin or acne or many skin blemishes, as well as kidney stones due to the hardening within one's feeling of love for another. The bladder and

inflammation of the kidneys relates to a feeling of being out of balance in one's love life.

Jul 08, 2005 Jupiter = Midheaven (Successful Business) Transit

Jupiter, when in combination with the MC, gives great success within one's career along with potential opportunities to expand and move up in the world. This energy relates to heights, thus one could reach their career heights under this influence. People may move from one location to another, which denotes moving to a larger home and/or work or to another country. Usually there can be opportunities laid out by a grandparent and/or the inheriting the family business. People who do a lot of travel for business, especially to foreign lands, have this, and they seem to do well when in business with or for foreigners. On a medical level this relates to a successful outcome to the diagnosis and it denotes the prominent doctor.

Jul 10, 2005 Node = Venus/Jupiter Transit

There can be joy that comes when being in love with someone now and it brings in a connection with a mate, engagement or future marriage partner. Connections that are made now bring happiness for years into the future. Happiness is derived from creating beauty in the lives of others through associations with happy abundant people.

Jul 10, 2005 Moon = Mercury/Pluto Progressed

There is a capacity to benefit through the buying and selling of homes or dealing with mortgages. This also gives deep penetrating abilities to reach large groups of people and sway them to one's way of thinking. There's the possibility of having a controlling or willful mother, and there could also be news of the loss of a family member, which has been expected. If this energy is used positively, it can give one the capacity to understand how to transmute negative energy, somewhat like a psychic surgeon.

Jul 11, 2005 Node = Venus/Neptune Transit

These are the connections we make that advance our soul towards more spiritual fulfillment. It relates to the marriage, or partnering with someone who can enhance our spiritual path or the journey to awareness of a greater whole. On the negative side, there can be attraction to people who usurp one's energy. It is important to be discriminating with whom you spend your time.

Jul 12, 2005 Moon = Uranus/Node Progressed

This usually represents one's family of friends or our personal family, which by astrological terms may be considered quite eccentric. On the other hand, this usually represents a change in one's home environment along with new neighbors and/or circumstances. This is a highly emotional influence, which may cause many changes within the family as in a birth, and/or a new family member coming in. The mother is considered highly volatile with this and it also represents a group of female astrologers and/or a group of women who are highly educated or have a specialized interest.

Jul 13, 2005 Saturn = Mercury/Saturn (Concentrated Thought) Transit

Mercury and Saturn relate to introspection and concentration of thought since one has the potential to become deeply fixed into a mental pattern that is either favorable or not. Thus, depression comes easily and one tends to only see the glass as half empty. There can also be mental blocks along with difficult communications with the father and/or boss. One may have problems feeling as though they can't share their thoughts with a sibling, which could lead to a separation from the sibling for an extended period of time. There can be difficulty due to the inability of others to understand what is trying to be communicated and/or they just don't feel the same way, thus, direct and effective communication is most important, especially in the work environment. One usually has a tendency to be able to teach others what they've already mastered. Thus, there can be leadership ability due to having learned how to communicate in an authoritative manner as well as having constructive thoughts or organized thoughts. One can clear away a mess of papers by itemizing, collating, organizing, and simplifying one's self. On a professional level, one has the potential to put in a new system and perfecting it, thus, this relates to accountants and teachers. It also represents the working relationships with others and studying for a period of time, or even focusing on writing a long-term novel. Though, there's a tendency to be self-absorbed in one's own thoughts and to not hear what others are trying to communicate. Medically, this relates to breaks in the fingers, arms, hands, and collarbone due to potential blocks in communication over a period of time. Heavy smokers also have this, causing lung problems along with blocks in the nerves of the hands and/or problems with the disks in the low back; there may also be a lack of assimilation of one's nutrition.

Jul 13, 2005 Moon = Neptune/Midheaven Progressed

One has a heightened sense of awareness along with perceptual abilities. Thus this relates to psychics and mediums who use this energy professionally. One has the capacity to go beyond appearances, being able to feel what others are saying as opposed to the words one speaks, thus this makes for a good intuitive consultant. On the other side of this, one can be emotionally confused, especially if the early environment was not stable. There can also be addictions and/or allergies to certain foods. The mother could possibly have psychological disorders and/or have problems with the breasts, which could be passed on to the next generation.

Jul 16, 2005 Node = Sun/Mercury Transit

There can be much happiness when communicating and sharing thoughts with others with whom one shares similar interests and/or values. This relates primarily to people we consider family, relatives and/or our close associates that we can talk to easily. This represents contacts that bring in new associations, as in the birth of a sibling or relative, and it can also bring a new love interest into one's life, someone with excellent communication skills. It also denotes a good educator, teacher, presenter, and/or public speaker.

Jul 16, 2005 Node = Venus/Mars Transit

One may have a strong attraction to their mate or future marriage partner.

Children born under this are born of love. This also addresses the sexual unions and associations we have that focus on one's sensuality. One can also be attracted to someone who has a sense of passion for life and draws upon that in their day-to-day life.

Jul 17, 2005 Saturn = Mercury/Midheaven Transit

There can be a career that requires good managerial skills, or a career in accounting or keeping of books or records. One has skills with running a system or becoming a systems manager as well as having the capacity to be in charge of the communications within a company. Many times one goes through a lot of depression due to feeling that they have to be perfect all of the time, which leaves them thinking, "Is that all there is, only work and toil in this life?" There can also be separations from a brother or relative due to a difference of belief system.

Jul 18, 2005 Saturn = Sun (The Disciple) Transit

The Sun represents the self and Saturn is discipline, thus this denotes the disciplining of the self through restraint and focus. There's a sense of timing and structure, which helps one to become more stable; thus giving the capacity to develop better habits. There is also the desire to eliminate negative habits and to replace them with something that could forego the test of time. Saturn, who is known as father time, represents the need to get a better sense of timing along with the need to set long-range goals and plans for the future. Thus preparing one for that potential rainy day. This may also represent having to care for the needs of a child, or children, who needs help in their early development. This is a time of little pleasure, just learning how to discipline the self, thus attaining future security in life. Many times the father can have potential health problems now, and people with this may have a tendency to harden their hearts due to long periods of no love and/or not giving love out of fear of rejection. Thus this can lead to hardening of the arteries. Usually one puts their attention on work instead of love, or they do not love the self, and/or they give selfless love. It also can be the block in love or a delay in getting the love one needs. This represents being separated from others and/or from one's sense of self. It gives the desire to retire or be secluded from others, since it represents inhibitions and/or habits; thus meaning habitual. Many times there is a loss of energy that can affect one's output in the work area. These are usually serious people who are very loyal and can be counted on when the going gets tough. This also relates to maturation and the aging process, which on a medical level can cause problems with brittle bones and difficulties with the knees. Medically this rules the skin, teeth, heart, and back problems due to the hardening process that takes place with age.

Jul 20, 2005 Node = Pluto/Ascendant Transit

Bringing people together to share an unusual destiny is a manifestation of this energy. These relationships can transform and empower one's life contributing knowledge about the manipulation and use of power. This also represents conception and transitions from one state of consciousness to another.

Jul 20, 2005 Moon = Jupiter/Midheaven Progressed

The happy woman who loves her home and family is a representation of this energy. It relates to a move up in the world to a larger home and/or expansion within one's personal environment. It gives large breasts in a woman's chart, and/or it relates to breast augmentation. Either way, one has a great capacity to nurture and/or to being nurtured. This is present for people who feed many others; an example might be a family-owned restaurant or grocery business. One has the capacity to be joyous along with the ability to have a great depth of feeling for another. This also relates to traveling back to see one's homeland, and/or to organize a family reunion.

Jul 21, 2005 Pluto = Saturn/Node Transit

Beginnings and endings can happen in the career area which can be shared with others. This energy relates to a parent's health and/or to someone in the position of authority. There can also be a desire to break with others due to a tyrannical situation which has limited or kept one in bondage. Thank the good Lord, when this energy is done it's done, thus you no longer need to learn that lesson of limitation again. There can also be limitations surrounding resources, like oil, gas, petroleum, coal, or any energy-giving commodity that is shared with others. Medically this rules eliminating that which has held you back or limited you, thus it denotes a mass forming within the physical body that needs to be eliminated. This mass symbolizes a pattern in our life which needs to be eliminated on a metaphorical level.

Jul 21, 2005 Ascendant = Jupiter (Expansive Environment) Direction: Solar Arc

Jupiter combined with the Ascendant expands the environment and/or physical body, which could manifest in the form of excess through one's weight or height or sheer size. One could also be the lean lanky type, having a runner's body and, in fact, this energy does relate to runners and/or tennis players. There is a love of travel and/or moving from one home to another, which is usually larger. There's also the desire for a more spiritual environment where one can practice the expansion of the belief system. There can be important people who come into one's space who seem to nourish the belief in a higher order through expanded awareness. The luck of the Irish is here, giving success and/or fame. Many people experience a desire to move from one location to a larger, more spacious environment where they can share their good fortune with others. This relates to people who move early in life to a new location that is far from their birthplace where they may live out the rest of their life.

Jul 24, 2005 Uranus = Sun/Node Transit

One has the capacity to bring in unique people that help to advance one's knowledge. It could be joining a group of astrologers and linking or connecting with others on a mental level. This also manifests as the joining of a group interested in advancement through higher forms of communications. This represents the conception or birth of an unusual, unique, and often a rebellious child.

Jul 25, 2005 Saturn = Moon/Node Transit

Problems associated with coworkers or working relationships are a manifestation of this. It can cause separations in the family and/or in work associations. Many times it manifests as the loss or separation from the father, or a person who is in the authority position in one's life. There's an ability to act as a spokesperson for others, to be more in a position of control over the family circumstances, or to act as the boss in the work environment. There can also be mourning our past and/or mourning over the loss of a family member with others.

Jul 25, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Node Transit

This relates to people who share the desire to teach higher subjects that advance one's knowledge of self and others, as this denotes educators and public speakers. There can be many happy days in communication with a grandparent. And this also denotes happiness when connected with a travel group or people who travel for a living.

Jul 27, 2005 Jupiter = Pluto (The Inheritance) Transit

When Jupiter and Pluto come together there is a focus on a deeper sense of beliefs where one seeks knowledge of the unknown. This energy relates to the priest and/or the initiation into a secret society or form of study. Good powers of judgment, especially when working with large sums of money, is another manifestation of this energy, as well as dealing with the IRS, taxes, banks, insurance companies, and estates through the death of a family member. There can be transitions for a grandparent who leaves an estate bequeathing an inheritance, thus one becomes the benefactor. There could also be a child born who may proceed the passing of a grandparent with an expanded consciousness, thus the power has been transferred to the grandchild from the grandparent. One may have great powers of judgment as this relates to major Supreme Court decisions as well as being judge and/or to be the one being judged. Many great philosophers who have the capacity to change the belief system of the masses carry this energy. Medically this rules removals through surgery which can end up favorably, along with the potential for liver problems.

Jul 28, 2005 Neptune = Moon/Mars Transit

The intuitive woman who takes initiative and can react quickly when needed is influenced by this energy. It relates to emotional sensitivity and/or an emotionally sensitive situation. It also denotes family secrets or the hiding of one's nature from others, or being deceived, deceptive, or confused. There can also be the influence of women who are substance abusers or have psychological disorders. On a positive level, this relates to the athlete who loves to swim or do water sports, and or there is a potential for water problems in the home or the need for a new water heater.

Jul 29, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Ascendant Transit

These are the optimists of the zodiac, looking at most things as positive. There is a love of other cultures, thus a person usually travels a lot and wants to share their experiences with others. One also has the capacity to be a good teacher and/or present their beliefs to others or be in the ministry. There is usually a grandparent

who could have influenced one's philosophy on life and possibly there is a foreign heritage. This is a good time to negotiate and sign agreements, as well as a good time to speculate. Another manifestation of this is to have a quite successful sibling.

Jul 30, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Venus Transit

The large beautiful home and a loving family are a manifestation of this energy. It represents the loving grandmother and/or the ancestral home. Many times people desire to buy a beautiful home that has historical value. There is also a love of travel, thus this relates to making future travel plans, possibly to the ancestral homeland. This could also be a good time to buy a Bed and Breakfast and/or go to one on a trip. One loves to cook, pleasure to others through the food they serve. On a financial level this represents success in one's ventures and opportunities to expand due to unions with others, which have the potential to become profitable.

Jul 30, 2005 Saturn = Moon/Ascendant Transit

Separation from others in the family or from the business family is a manifestation of this. It can cause one to feel depressed or confined when in this place. There could be slow maturation of the physical body and/or smaller features. One can either have beautiful skin or acne on the face, since this rules our face to the world. There is also a feeling of being limited by others or of facing the world alone. Usually there are unions formed now which have karmic repercussions or there may even be a marriage for security reasons. On the positive side, this represents a time of weight loss due to the lack of appetite or not being able to stomach the situation.

Jul 30, 2005 Saturn = Mars/Pluto Transit

The powerful builder of institutions or the person who institutes the laws of the land is a manifestation of this. It denotes the person who bridges the consciousness of one reality to the next. On the negative side, there can be the disintegration of the bridges that kept people apart or linked them together. This is usually a person who has power which they can use either for good or for evil, depending on their intention. This relates to the breaking down of the old structures and the building up of new ones.

Jul 30, 2005 Moon = Uranus/Ascendant Progressed

Sudden changes surrounding the environment are expressed by this energy, which can come in the form of a quick move and/or a volatile early home life. There are many early changes that give the person an ability to make sudden changes easily and without too much attachment in the present. The mother may also have many mood swings and the possibility of being out of balance chemically. Many times our friends feel more like family than our real family does; thus we seem to prefer friends to family. On the shadow side, this relates to the dysfunctional family, whose history has it's own lurid tale.

Jul 30, 2005 Node = Pluto/Node (Transformational Associations) Transit

When Pluto and the Node come together, associations can come into one's life that can transform. These connections are usually intense and have an end goal or

an intention. This relates to influential people, such as a political leader or someone who has control over the masses. This also relates to large groups of people who come together for a common purpose that transforms the existing policy. This can be the beginning or ending of very important associations that could ultimately change one's life for the better. These connections are karmic in that they help us to advance quickly on a soul level. On a psychological level, this brings awareness of others and the consciousness of self and yet there's the potential to lose consciousness of others by not knowing how they really feel. This denotes transitions and births of people to whom we are very close and it rules the reproductive cycle.

Aug 01, 2005 Uranus = Jupiter/Uranus (Higher Intellect) Transit

When Jupiter combines with Uranus there's a desire to study and learn about knowledge on advanced subjects. Many times, one desires to go on to college or university and study advanced technical subjects like astrology and/or being inspired by the quest for knowledge. There can be many opportunities surrounding higher education, as in a scholarship being given and/or the beginning and/or ending of higher education. Seminars and all sorts of classes and/or any form of continuing education falls under this. People who believe in higher consciousness carry this energy, having good fortune and advancement in life. There is also the desire to explore foreign lands, having a strong sense of adventure and excitement. One has a desire to take chances through speculation, thus one can win in a big way. Religion also plays a role, since one likes to make changes in what they perceive as a sedentary system which may lack the freedom of belief that one's looking for. Medically this rules the hepatic system: hips, thighs, calves, blood pressure, and blood disorders.

Aug 02, 2005 Moon = Saturn (Emotional Maturation) Progressed

Early emotional needs are seldom met; thus, one has difficulty responding in a stable way when the going gets tough. The lack of early bonding with the parents can cause one to be more self-sufficient and have control over one's feelings. There can also be a feeling of being alone in the world without someone to talk to and no one seems to understand. There's the potential to feel isolated, depressed along with a tendency to focus on one's self too much, thus this relates to self-indulgence through dwelling on one's personal problems. One should try to overcome their negative patterning and focus more on seeking emotional stability. This also relates to separations, even of the parents, and/or there could be family problems where the responsibility of one of the parents lies on one's shoulders. One may bond with one of the parents and/or it denotes separation from a parent. A visual of this might be a solitary older or mature woman of wisdom with many responsibilities on her shoulders. There's the capacity to work out of the home and/or making one's workplace more like a home. Many building contractors and/or homebuilders relate to this energy. It also relates to one's work family and/or responsibilities in the work place. Medically, this rules digestion due to feelings of oppression triggered by emotional problems in childhood.

Aug 03, 2005 Saturn = Neptune/Pluto Transit

The dark night of the soul is a representation of this energy, which seems to torture one's spirit, but thank the Lord it moves on. It can cause betrayal on a work level and/or the gradual waning of one's career potential. There's a pattern of loss and deception on the part of big business or the government. There's a lot of emotional suffering, causing one to wonder if that's all there is. On a medical level, this denotes the feeling of being limited, as in bone disease and/or through arthritis. There is also the potential for confinement, either by the authorities or within one's personal life. On the positive side, this could denote building a spiritual sanctuary where one can find solitude to rebuild their faith.

Aug 04, 2005 * Jupiter = Sun/Uranus Transit

This is the main signature of the astrologer and/or it gives one the capacity to study difficult subjects like astrology. It rules the high tech and computer industries, thus giving one the capacity to master difficult subjects with ease. Usually people go on to college and/or seek out some form of higher education that is very enjoyable to them. There's the potential to have speculative abilities along with the gift of winning unexpectedly. There can also be advancement in life through one's attainment of knowledge and inner awareness. Many times there can be an unusual child born with a high degree of intellect.

Aug 05, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Pluto Transit

Separation from others due to fixed beliefs and/or the feeling of being indoctrinated by others is a representation of this energy. Once one learns the lesson of separation due to one's philosophy, then one understands how to use their personal will power. In the career area, one has the capacity to run the company, since this energy relates to big business and the power of control, which only someone at the top has. This can also be ending a career due to no possibility of expansion, thus one moves on to greener fields. On the shadow side, there may have been obstacles that have prevented one from advancing in life, due to inhibitions created within the early environment.

Aug 08, 2005 Uranus = Uranus/Neptune (Visions & Dreams) Transit

Uranus combined with Neptune relates to the collective associations one has with people who are spiritual in nature. These friendships help one to become inspired to heal wounds from past incarnations and evolve the soul; thus, this is the "evolution of the soul." This denotes a collective group of souls who have come into this world to bring new light of spiritual awareness and consciousness. On the shadow side, this relates to people who have addictive behaviors or are perhaps misguided by their associations with others; thus, the negative forces in a culture are using them. On the positive side, this is a period to enhance one's dreams, visions, and insights and put them into a daily practice. This practice can be done through meditation, yoga, and any form of ritual that brings balance and insight into the daily routine.

Aug 11, 2005 Pluto = Jupiter/Ascendant Transit

One can come into their own now by having a sense of personal power. Thus one can transmute and change one's personal environment and/or one's personal

appearance for the better. This also relates to plastic surgery. Many healers or people who know how to transmute energy have this. It relates to making use of transformational energy in one's own personal life. This also represents transitions and births, due to the sheer amount of energy generated.

Aug 13, 2005 Saturn = Saturn/Pluto (Focused Intent) Transit

Saturn, when combined with Pluto, has the effect of transformation within the structure, which can manifest in one's career through the ending of one job and beginning of a new one. Thus, there is a death of the old structure along with a birth of the new. A new home or business structure, new management, or even a new work direction are other ways this energy can take form. On the reverse side, there can be dealing with someone's personal power who uses it through ruthless means, or the elimination of one's position. Aug 15, 2005 Neptune = Mercury/Uranus Transit

Aug 20, 2005 Jupiter = Pluto/Node Transit

This also relates to people who try to control through economic power, as in the IRS, or a banker, or a life insurance company. There can also be the birth of a power child who has the capacity to become famous in some way.

Aug 20, 2005 Sun = Pluto/Node Progressed

People of power and/or people in the position of power are a representation of this energy. There's a power to be born and to transcend present consciousness along with others. One has the capacity to bring in associations with people who control things, like money, energy, and sex, all second chakra issues. There could also be a person who enters one's life now who may encompass some of the previous stated qualities. Aug 20, 2005 Sun = Pluto/Node Direction: Solar Arc

There's a love of fast cars, or sports cars, or being a sports car driver since there's a need for lots of excitement and taking chances. Many stunt people have this quality. This also represents male bonding as in working out together at a health club or in any physical activity. A male child who embodies some of the qualities mentioned above can be born into a family.

Aug 24, 2005 Jupiter = Pluto/Ascendant Transit

Success in life, gained through the generosity of others, is one of the manifestations of this. It gives the ability to move beyond the present circumstances and enjoy more of the good life. This could come through an inheritance and/or just being in the right place at the right time. Many people who are born into wealth have this, and it relates to expansion into a better lifestyle. This expansion can also come through the physical body as in weight gain due to

living high on the hog, so to speak.

Aug 26, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Mars Transit

People with this can have a strong sensual philosophy or belief system about relationships, as well as a happy sexual relationship. There can be many fun times with people from other cultures or nationalities. Lots of sexual activity is one of the manifestations of this, as well being a person who is lucky in love. There is an ease in getting what one wants, especially when it comes to love and money.

Aug 26, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Mercury Transit

One has the desire to travel and to learn more about the world through different belief systems. This may come in the desire to travel to a foreign country and/or learning a second language or learning more about one's own heritage. This is usually a very optimistic person who has a desire for higher learning in the form of going on to university and continuing their education in some form or another throughout their life. One may have writing skills that could manifest in the writing of a successful book and/or novel. There is usually public appreciation and recognition, as well as being popular in the public eye.

Aug 26, 2005 Moon = Mercury/Neptune Direction: Solar Arc

Being a psychic who can connect with the world of spirits easily is a manifestation of this energy. Women with this energy seem to be in another space and time but lack grounding; one could even have a psychic mother or grandmother. One may have peculiarities about them, thus being totally out of touch with reality. Medically this can cause food allergies, and dairy products potentially can become toxic to the body. Breast problems and cysts are prone with this combination. There is a desire to live near water and/or one feels at home when near a body of water.

Aug 28, 2005 Uranus = Mercury/Jupiter Direction: Solar Arc

This is the epitome of the astrologer, the computer wizard, or the high tech engineer. The person who has the capacity to apply many variables into one package is represented by this, thus it relates to advanced thoughts which can be applied to high technology. This also relates to the genius that receives their information from a higher source, or the one who knows. A sibling born with this is highly intelligent or is considered to have insight. There may be sudden luck or hearing about another person's good fortune, thus this relates to one who tends to take chances in life and is very lucky.

Aug 29, 2005 Saturn = Mars/Node Transit

There is a tendency to separate from male groups or from a man. It brings one together with men who are building a new structure, like builders on all levels of consciousness. This also relates to the father's health and/or blocks in energy when dealing with men in authority. Thus, this is a time of connecting with past karma that can be played out in the present.

Aug 29, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Neptune Transit

The long lost love who lives a great distance away and/or who is unavailable at

the present time is a manifestation of this energy. It gives a strong sense of fantasy along with writing abilities that could be used in a romance novel. There's a love of living near the water or traveling with a loved one to water, as in living near a lake, river, or ocean. One may also have an abundance of feelings or the love of art and an admiration of artistic pursuits. It represents love of nightlife and movies, plays, and the glamorous life.

Aug 30, 2005 Saturn = Venus/Uranus Transit

Separations from friends or difficulty in relationships -- either due to going in different directions or not spending enough time with each other to truly develop and nurture the relationship -- is a manifestation of this energy. There can also be controlled response in a relationship in one's love life or a feeling of a change in one's capacity to love. Thus, this denotes the sobering up process within a relationship. On the positive side, one may have new friends come in through a job change or a change of personnel within the present job.

Aug 30, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Jupiter (The Contract) Transit

Venus and Jupiter relate to what we value along with our philosophy and belief systems. There is usually abundance in one's personal life and sometimes one attracts financial gain along with the ability to attract many gifts from others. People with this have a great capacity to love others, including animals, and they have a love of religion and philosophy, thus valuing higher education. The love of foreigners, their heritage, and ethnicity are also part of this energy. There can be the ability to understand the legal system, since it relates to agreements that are based on the desire to create balance; thus, the marriage contract or legal agreement as well as giving bliss and happiness within our life. Many times there is the capacity to be easily understood by others as well as having a sense of abundance and joy when in relationships. One may also have an excessive capacity to feel along with the potential to over extend one's self on a financial level or to become wasteful of money and/or energy. Many gamblers who have the potential to win big carry this energy. This also represents having a legal decision going in one's favor. Medically, this relates to difficulties assimilating sugar; kidney problems; problems with the liver, due to excess; and, at its worst, hepatitis.

Sep 03, 2005 Saturn = Neptune/Node Transit

Emotional suffering experienced with others and caused by a highly volatile situation is a manifestation of this, thus there seems to be no way out except through time. This denotes someone who has health problems or is being deceitful in a relationship where they have hidden their true nature or desires. Either way, this can leave one feeling betrayed and alone, suffering in silence. Medically, this relates to bone disease due to not feeling supported by others, or skin ailments from toxicity in the diet. There can also be substance abuse on the part of the father's lineage and/or toxic substances within the work area which affect the health.

Sep 03, 2005 Saturn = Mars/Ascendant Transit

One can hold themselves back from their full potential due to early inhibitions. Thus, if one works with their early environmental conditioning they could overcome some of the obstacles that seem to hold them back or keep them in the same place without advancement. People who have this seem to have physical strength and a sense of purpose. One usually has the intention to somehow get the job done no matter what the obstacles are. There can also be sadness which is shared with others due to a loss or concern for others.

Sep 03, 2005 Moon = Midheaven (The Matriarch) Progressed

The Moon combined with the MC relates to the woman at the top, or the woman who is in control of a business, who is in a position of power. Sometimes people move to advance in their careers and/or run the family business. One has the ability to reach the top and have many opportunities that arise along the way; also there may be popularity. One may be very much in demand, or have lots of exposure in the public eye, since there's great advancement life. This relates to the dominant parent, the one who makes the decisions. It rules over the capacity to be the executive, the one in charge of making the main decisions for others. There can be many life changes, which lead to more personal power and/or the changing of one's life objectives. Many times people make their home into a business, thus working out of the home. One also has the ability to have great sensitivity and emotional response to the needs of others; thus, this relates to the psychologist and/or counselor. Many homebuilders and/or people working in the food industry have this.

Sep 03, 2005 * Saturn = Moon/Sun Transit

Separation in a relationship is a reflection of this, since one feels that their needs aren't being met. It can also mean a mature person or the maturing of a relationship that has staying power, since there seems to be a stabilizing force that is present in the partnership. On the negative or misuse of this energy, there is a tendency to have blocked maturation, or slow growth, forcing one to mature later in life and be unable to accept emotional responsibilities for anyone other than the self. This can cause deep psychological issues leading to depression. Family patterns in early life may have created a sense of emotional deprivation, thus later in life this patterning could cause difficulty through expressing one's self and/or feeling inhibited, restricting one's behavior when in the company of others.

Sep 04, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Saturn Transit

This relates to a partnership trying to move forward on a financial level but which still has to deal with periods of delay and slow progress. It can be a time to slow down and hold back economically, since it denotes overextending one's resources and finances through the "good life" and then having to pay the piper. There can also be separation in partnerships due to differences in values and/or for financial reasons. This also relates to down sizing or being conservative within a partnership.

Sep 05, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Node Transit

Backing away from associations with others through ending, terminating, or separating is a representation of this energy. In the career area, this relates to coworkers who move on or are fired. In a marriage or union, it denotes no longer sharing the same beliefs or values with one's partner or mate. On a positive level, this relates to people in an authority position who help one to succeed, as a father does in early life.

Sep 07, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Uranus Transit

This is the strongest energy pointing to the astrologer in the zodiac. It represents sudden success in life and a person who speculates and wins, thus one may play the lottery and/or take chances which they normally wouldn't take otherwise. There could be positive recognition for the application of one's intellectual abilities and the desire to study advanced subjects, such as computer technology and/or astrology. This also manifests by going on to college or university; either way it's a period of enlightenment gained through advancing one's desire to learn. There is also a desire to share the knowledge learned with others through writing a book, which could be published.

Sep 07, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Midheaven Transit

There is the ability to have career success and advancement in life, giving the potential for higher pay and/or a better position within one's work. One has the ability to have a new status in life. Many times one may want to partner with someone who has a more solid social position with financial security; in other words, this could mean marrying well. This is also the influence which attracts us to other cultures, philosophies, and religious beliefs.

Sep 07, 2005 Venus = Moon/Pluto Progressed

One has the capacity to have a great love for another and/or to gain financially through marriage, thus, this rules the power of seduction and/or flirtatious activities. There is a deep sexual nature, a visual of this might be the sexual enchantress and/or the act of being seduced. There can also be financial gain through the transition of someone close or through insurance policies. On a medical level, this rules the hormones, the fallopian tubes, and surgery on the reproductive system. A good image of this might be, "It takes two to tango."

Sep 08, 2005 Saturn = Neptune/Ascendant Transit

Setting personal boundaries is a function of this, due to the limitations created in early life through one's personal environment. There may have been alcoholism or some form of substance abuse which causes one to feel emotionally deprived. This also relates to past life karma which may need to be played out and eliminated in the present. Either way, there is a feeling that one can't get ahead in life; thus, medically, this rules diseases which limit, as in arthritis, bone disease, tooth decay, and sleep disorders. There's also a tendency to define one's spiritual reality, helping one to work within a constructive framework.

Sep 09, 2005 Node = Sun/Uranus Transit

One can associate with rebellious groups now. This can be a time of meeting and forming new friendships. It denotes happy associations of an intellectual nature

that one can draw into their life. This also has a lot to do with the joining of groups, like a New Age group, with the main purpose of personal transformation.

Sep 09, 2005 Jupiter = Node (Successful Associations) Transit

Jupiter/Node brings successful and pleasant associations into our life, as it relates to abundant people who are influential in the community, having knowledge or financial success. These are the connections one makes which help them to change their future direction. One can meet someone now with whom they would like to marry and share their future. There can also be the birth of a child who brings much pleasure into one's life. Connections can be made now with foreigners who share their beliefs and philosophy on life. On a professional level, this relates to connecting with people who are in key positions to help advance one's career; thus this is an important time for business success created through bonding with others.

Sep 11, 2005 Saturn = Jupiter/Ascendant Transit

There's a tendency to create separation and estrangements to those close associations within the environment. One may want to be alone or spend many lonely days by one's self; either way, the energy is still the same in that aloneness is the end result. There are many ups and downs in life that seem to season one to weather almost any storm now, but for some people this is just what the doctor ordered. Medically, this rules the breathing process and potential blood disorders.

Sep 11, 2005 Uranus = Moon/Mercury Transit

One has a high degree of aptitude for many different subjects. There can be attraction to unusual or different types of friends where the common denominator is the ability to communicate in an avant-garde manner. Many times one's friends become family; in fact, they're usually closer than one's own family members are. There can also be connections with people who have a high degree of integrity or position in the community who can help one to advance quickly on a professional level. Thus, one has the capacity to make decisions fast, along with having a peculiar insight into the motivations of others.

Sep 12, 2005 Jupiter = Node/Ascendant Transit

Many fortunate contacts and associations can come in, bringing influential people into one's life that can change it for the better. This rules traveling and/or learning with others, connecting people together to attain higher knowledge. Many people who have a fortunate turn in their life's circumstances have this, as well as people who were born into prosperity, an economically secure family, or who have the ability to manifest success through their own talents.

Sep 14, 2005 Saturn = Saturn/Node (Stable Connections) Transit

When Saturn and the Node combine with one another, there's a joining of people who have mutual goals in mind, connecting one with coworkers or people to build new structures. There is a feeling of maturity, or being around people who have mastered something on a professional level, thus this relates to a new boss or a change in management. On the other side, there can be separations from others due to work grievances, along with inhibitions or limitations within one's

personal or professional associations. There can be a feeling of hopelessness in a situation that involves others. This also relates to the father and is present when one is separated from a family member, or a family member may have a health issue to contend with.

Sep 15, 2005 Ascendant = Mars/Saturn Direction: Solar Arc

The physically strong person who puts their best face forward with intention and has a good sense of timing is a manifestation of this energy. They also have the ability to get the job done in a relatively short period of time. On the negative side, there can be tooth decay from too much sugar or acid in the diet. There can also be acne, thus one has difficulty facing the world, but this does develop inner strength and the ability to weather the storm.

Sep 15, 2005 Jupiter = Ascendant (Expansive Environment) Transit

Jupiter combined with the Ascendant expands the environment and/or physical body, which could manifest in the form of excess through one's weight or height or sheer size. One could also be the lean lanky type, having a runner's body and, in fact, this energy does relate to runners and/or tennis players. There is a love of travel and/or moving from one home to another, which is usually larger. There's also the desire for a more spiritual environment where one can practice the expansion of the belief system. There can be important people who come into one's space who seem to nourish the belief in a higher order through expanded awareness. The luck of the Irish is here, giving success and/or fame. Many people experience a desire to move from one location to a larger, more spacious environment where they can share their good fortune with others. This relates to people who move early in life to a new location that is far from their birthplace where they may live out the rest of their life.

Sep 16, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Pluto Transit

These are the people who carry and form the beliefs from one generation to the next. This relates to the study of occult knowledge and an interest in secret societies. Many priests, Shamans, and people who are dedicated to a belief system have this, as well as people who incorporate sexuality with philosophy to attain their personal goals. It relates to books written which affect the consciousness of the masses. This is great for financial gain through an inheritance or an insurance claim, thus this relates to gaining through the transition of a grandparent. It represents the IRS and dealing with our taxes and/or being audited. This is the height of great personal power, creating financial success, and personal gain that results in extreme wealth. There can also be births and transitions within the family under this.

Sep 16, 2005 Ascendant = Neptune/Pluto Progressed

One may have a highly developed dream life combined with the ability to disappear into the woodwork. It's as if others are not seeing one as they really are. Perhaps there is the ability to take on many different identities, much as an actor does. There is a surrealistic quality to this energy; thus these are people one would call an enigma. On a medical level this can cause problems through wasting away

or feeling as though you're not in your body.

Sep 19, 2005 Saturn = Node/Midheaven Transit

There's a feeling of wanting to climb to the top of the career ladder with this, and it represents training with others and sharing work duties. This has a tendency to connect one with people in authority or with the father. This also relates to a change in people within the career environment or, medically, health issues for the father. One can have a feeling of being obligated to give time and energy to others.

Sep 20, 2005 Saturn = Saturn/Ascendant (Restricted Environment) Transit

With Saturn in combination with the Ascendant there is a feeling that our environment is limiting us and/or that we have restricted one's self due to one's personal patterns. One can have a strong sense of timing along with the desire to succeed in whatever one does, due to feeling that one's life should have purpose. This relates to maturing and/or being aged by the world around us. Thus, one begins to look within the self for a sense of balance, which can be done through meditation. There can be an attraction to a relationship that could test one's values, especially if one decides to partner with them. Old souls come to the earth plane to teach others the lessons they have learned in previous lifetimes. Medically, there can be either beautiful skin or acne created by too much acid in the system. There can also be breaks in the skeletal system along with tooth decay.

Sep 23, 2005 Pluto = Jupiter/Ascendant Transit

One can come into their own now by having a sense of personal power. Thus one can transmute and change one's personal environment and/or one's personal appearance for the better. This also relates to plastic surgery. Many healers or people who know how to transmute energy have this. It relates to making use of transformational energy in one's own personal life. This also represents transitions and births, due to the sheer amount of energy generated.

Sep 25, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Mercury Transit

Traveling great distances to see one's family is a manifestation of this, as it gives an interest in genealogy as well as having interest in historical information about the past. There's a tendency to focus on the belief system of the family and/or the philosophy of what one perceives to be their tribe. This also relates to the influential woman and/or an influential family in the community. There can be good news and a focus on higher education along with writing and communication skills.

Sep 26, 2005 Saturn = Midheaven/Ascendant Transit

This has a sobering effect in that there may be periods of isolation from others, or a feeling that one needs to be alone. This builds personal character and stability due to relying on the self versus others. There can also be a period where one is limited by a situation, or one may have to take care of the needs of another. On a medical level, this tends to cause ailments that limit, like arthritis, as well as having problems with the teeth and/or bone structure, denoting chronic ailments.

Sep 28, 2005 Jupiter = Mars/Uranus Transit

This represents the physically strong man, like a prizefighter, or the well-endowed man, or a male child being born who is more of an athletic type. It also relates to someone who is very inventive, working with electricity and/or who knows a lot about mechanical knowledge. There can be sudden wins, or getting something by chance, or suddenly advancing in life due to being in the right place at the right time.

Oct 01, 2005 Jupiter = Uranus/Neptune Transit

The spiritual journey is a manifestation of this energy, thus one has a love of travel and/or the desire to be near a large body of water. It relates to insight gained through other cultures or from one's personal heritage. This is a very speculative influence with the potential for sudden unexpected wins, thus fulfilling one's dreams. There's a great capacity to dream, thus one can apply the information received through dreamtime awareness to everyday life. On the reverse side, this can represent the gambler and/or person who does things fraudulently. Medically this can cause blood disorders, difficulties with the immune system, and liver dysfunction, as in hepatitis.

Oct 02, 2005 Jupiter = Jupiter/Uranus (Higher Intellect) Transit

When Jupiter combines with Uranus there's a desire to study and learn about knowledge on advanced subjects. Many times, one desires to go on to college or university and study advanced technical subjects like astrology and/or being inspired by the quest for knowledge. There can be many opportunities surrounding higher education, as in a scholarship being given and/or the beginning and/or ending of higher education. Seminars and all sorts of classes and/or any form of continuing education falls under this. People who believe in higher consciousness carry this energy, having good fortune and advancement in life. There is also the desire to explore foreign lands, having a strong sense of adventure and excitement. One has a desire to take chances through speculation, thus one can win in a big way. Religion also plays a role, since one likes to make changes in what they perceive as a sedentary system which may lack the freedom of belief that one's looking for. Medically this rules the hepatic system: hips, thighs, calves, blood pressure, and blood disorders.

Oct 03, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Node Transit

There can be the birth of a happy Sagittarius child, or connections with a relative, like a grandparent. This is a time to connect with people who have personal power and sound judgment. There is also the capacity to expand one's connections and people can come into one's life who enhance their belief system.

Oct 04, 2005 Node = Mars/Neptune Direction: Solar Arc

There can be attractions to people who create fantasy and/or illusion in our life. On a career level this denotes the swimmer, or athlete-surrounding water sports, perhaps even a dancer or musician. This relates to people that come back into one's life from a previous lifetime allowing you to complete and make right some unfinished business. Thus, this denotes the completion of the illusion created in a

previous lifetime or owing someone energy from your past life.

Oct 05, 2005 Saturn = Mercury/Venus Transit

There can be blocks in communication, especially where love and/or money play a role or if one is doing business with relatives. This energy means to be judged negatively by others, or there can be talk about separation when a relationship becomes too out of balance. There can also be sadness surrounding a separation due to work and involving a loved one. On a career level, this energy relates to financial planners or people who are experiencing career delays or are holding back on a raise, a bonus, or just hearing about financial delays.

Oct 06, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Ascendant Transit

There can be the expansion of the self and the awareness of how the environment affects one's health. People who have this desire to travel great distances and seldom live in the place in which they were born. It gives a happy personality along with a strong philosophy on life, which gives the capacity to be the eternal student. A grandparent usually plays a strong role in early life due to their philosophical influence, thus one's personal heritage becomes a vital factor in early development. This also has a tendency to put on weight and girth due to the need to expand on all levels of consciousness, including the physical. Great wealth and abundance are the outcome of this, since one has the ability to connect with others who are in a position of influence and power. Each person's sense of wealth is relative to his or her own personal situation, though.

Oct 07, 2005 Jupiter = Saturn/Uranus Transit

There can be a desire to expand one's personal reality by investing in one's future potential. The way things were is too limiting, so one wants to advance and get into a more accelerated awareness. This can be done through higher studies on subjects that free one's consciousness from the limitations placed upon them by the old worn-out patterns from the past.

Oct 07, 2005 * Mercury = Sun/Midheaven Progressed

This relates to the writer who gains fame and notoriety, or a person who becomes successful due to their excellent sales skills and ability to communicate effectively. There could be effective negotiating skills and it gives the capacity to express one's self easily through public speaking gifts, and often one can speak more than one language. There can also be a sibling or relative who takes precedence under this and become successful in his or her own right. On the whole, this is the bearer of good news coming, thus advancing one on a professional level through agreements or contracts.

Oct 09, 2005 Jupiter = Uranus/Midheaven Transit

There can be sudden fame and good fortune. One can also speculate and win, as well as connect on a social level to others who are successful. This relates to the successful astrologer or anyone who is successful on the Internet, with computers, or anything considered high tech or state of the art. This is present when one enters or leaves college, as well as when one computerizes or upgrades software or information.

Oct 14, 2005 Pluto = Saturn/Node Transit

Beginnings and endings can happen in the career area which can be shared with others. This energy relates to a parent's health and/or to someone in the position of authority. There can also be a desire to break with others due to a tyrannical situation which has limited or kept one in bondage. Thank the good Lord, when this energy is done it's done, thus you no longer need to learn that lesson of limitation again. There can also be limitations surrounding resources, like oil, gas, petroleum, coal, or any energy-giving commodity that is shared with others. Medically this rules eliminating that which has held you back or limited you, thus it denotes a mass forming within the physical body that needs to be eliminated. This mass symbolizes a pattern in our life which needs to be eliminated on a metaphorical level.

Oct 14, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Pluto Transit

With this energy there could be a grandparent with great wisdom and personal power. This relates to the priest and/or priestess, the one who knows or is the carrier of the ancient traditions. One has the capacity to see clearly into the beliefs of others, thus there's the ability to shape or form the mass belief system. This denotes estates, the transition of a grandparent, the IRS, insurance companies, taxes, and the family home. There's the potential to have extreme wealth and/or luck representing the big win or winning the lottery. The best use of this energy would be to share one's highest, selfless philosophies with others, possibly in a teaching position.

Oct 15, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Mars Transit

This relates to people who usually have a good sense of judgment and/or are involved in the decision making process, such as judges who have a sense of justice and balance when it comes to making decisions for others. This is basically a happy energy that makes one feel that they're in the right and have a good, sound belief system. This also relates to coming into a large sum of money due to sales agreements as well as judgments that go in one's favor.

Oct 18, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Neptune Transit

The fictional writer, spiritual teachers, preachers, priests, shamans, and healers who share their beliefs with others to help them to heal themselves are influenced by this energy. It also relates to people who tap into a higher state of consciousness and have the capacity to relate that information to the masses. This is considered an inspirational influence where there's a state of blissful awareness. On the negative side of this energy there is a tendency to con or be conned through belief. Medically this relates to the lungs, with mucus or water build up and/or asthma.

Oct 19, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Jupiter (The Philosopher) Transit

With this, there's an ability to think with greatness and have ease with communicating belief systems and philosophy to others. There is the desire to seek out or to see other cultures so as to learn more about them, along with a love of travel to foreign lands. Good news comes easily as one has an eternally

optimistic disposition. There can also be pleasant communication with others on a regular basis, as well as having a sibling who has the potential to become very successful. One has the capacity to discuss religion and philosophical issues along with the desire to pursue higher education, thus, becoming a philosopher in addition to being a perpetual student. There is also a love for the grandparents and having a similar philosophy on life as they do. One's ideas and concepts are usually received easily by others and can even become a point of reference or quoted by others in the future. There is also the ability to be a novelist and/or it's a time to have a book published, thus, this relates to publishers. People who are successful in sales carry this energy and are usually at the top of their group in output. Medically, this rules asthma or difficulty in the breathing processes, and it also gives large hands, fingers, or limbs.

Oct 21, 2005 Jupiter = Venus (The Contract) Transit

Venus and Jupiter relate to what we value along with our philosophy and belief systems. There is usually abundance in one's personal life and sometimes one attracts financial gain along with the ability to attract many gifts from others. People with this have a great capacity to love others, including animals, and they have a love of religion and philosophy, thus valuing higher education. The love of foreigners, their heritage, and ethnicity are also part of this energy. There can be the ability to understand the legal system, since it relates to agreements that are based on the desire to create balance; thus, the marriage contract or legal agreement as well as giving bliss and happiness within our life. Many times there is the capacity to be easily understood by others as well as having a sense of abundance and joy when in relationships. One may also have an excessive capacity to feel along with the potential to over extend one's self on a financial level or to become wasteful of money and/or energy. Many gamblers who have the potential to win big carry this energy. This denotes appreciation of beauty through artistic pursuits, as in being an artist, and it relates to a person who likes to throw parties and invite people from all different backgrounds. This also represents having a legal decision going in one's favor. Medically, this relates to difficulties assimilating sugar; kidney problems; problems with the liver, due to excess; and, at its worst, hepatitis.

Oct 24, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Saturn Transit

There is a desire to expand, and yet one doesn't seem to have the funds to do it. One also has the desire to buy a new home, thus establishing mortgage payments. This relates to contraction and then expansion and/or advancement in life after a period of limitation. This represents the pessimist, the one who sees the world from tunnel vision. On the positive side, there can finally be success after a long period of hardship. There can be a raise and/or new position after waiting a long time for advancement.

Oct 24, 2005 Saturn = Sun/Mars Transit

There's stability in one's direction and a determination and focus on personal goals. It gives control over one's work environment and a sense of respect for one's planning skills. On the reverse side, there can be problems in being the

controller and/or being controlled by others. It can cause slow progress or delayed attainment of the goals that one sets out to accomplish. There can also be a block in the energy level and/or in one's ability to love and be loved. On a medical level, this relates to blockages in the heart or circulatory system due to closing off one's love nature.

Oct 26, 2005 Jupiter = Mercury/Midheaven Transit

One has a fresh optimistic outlook towards life, along with the capacity to have good fortune in the career due to making the right decisions at the right time. There can be potential success as a writer and/or publicist as well as having skills in public relations. There can also be excellent communication with a grandparent and an ability to express one's self in a manner which brings advancement in one's career and/or receiving a raise or hearing good news surrounding the career.

Oct 27, 2005 Jupiter = Sun (The Opportunity) Transit

The Sun represents the self and Jupiter is success; thus Sun/Jupiter combinations seem to bring out success through one's philosophy on life. It attracts one to religion and/or subjects dealing with the philosophy behind worshiping something greater than the self. Each of us seeks out the purpose of life and how we fit into it. This relates to having lots of fun and expansion and it's considered one of the most advancing times of one's life. People who are born into wealth carry this energy and/or this can be a time where one could create wealth and success for themselves. This is also a time when people travel and/or have contact with foreigners. It represents being able to relate on a big level, thus expanding into many opportune areas in life. Joy for life and expansion of the self are expressions of this, as well as putting one in a high social group within the community. It relates to the seasoned traveler or author. There can be the birth of a Sagittarius or Jupiter's child who is optimistic and looks at the glass half full as opposed to half empty. This rules grand parents, especially if they leave an inheritance to their offspring. This also gives the potential for success when dealing with foreigners and/or foreign products. The medical areas are the hips, thighs, liver, blood, and hepatic system.

Oct 28, 2005 Moon = Mercury/Node Progressed

This relates to the connections made within one's personal family, especially siblings or other relatives. This also denotes communicating easily with someone whom one has a history. Many times a sibling is born into the family under this, or there can be bonding with others of like mind to form a type of family, represented by a group consciousness. Thus, this relates to people who have a similar mental interest gathering together to discuss a particular subject where feelings and emotions are involved.

Oct 31, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Node Transit

A group of women discussing their beliefs and philosophy on life is represented by this energy. It's the loving and nurturing family and/or grandmother. There is an attraction to philosophical groups whom we can connect with and where one has community. One could also join a new religion or church group. There can be

happiness through one's connections and enjoying prosperity with others. This also relates to travel which can take one to distant places to see one's homelands and/or to be with one's family group.

Nov 03, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Ascendant Transit

The place of higher learning, college or university, is represented by this energy. There is usually happiness and the ability to expand in one's environment. One has the potential for success in life due to inheritance or the family's influence in the community. Many times one could be born into wealth and/or affluence. This denotes optimistic people who look at the glass as half full as opposed to half empty. There can be a move away from one's birth location and/or there could be moving to a foreign country. Since this is known as a time of great expansion, it's important that one is conscious of the potential weight gain that this energy can bring.

Nov 03, 2005 Jupiter = Mars/Pluto Transit

The birth of a powerful child and/or the birth of powerful children are a manifestation of this energy. It relates to the use of energy that is wielded through philosophy and belief systems, thus transformative thought. People who can change the world through what they believe or do carry this energy. So this rules a surgeon and/or represents plastic surgery and it relates to the medical profession, or a doctor who has the capacity to deal with life and death situations. The transition of a grandparent can also come under this.

Nov 04, 2005 Pluto = Node/Midheaven Transit

One can be put in a position of power and prestige in one's career, due to the influence of others. One can achieve their goals through co-working with others. Large sums of money can come in now due to the help of others. On the other side of this, there can be problems created through the work environment, feeling as though one's advancement is being held back by people in authority, thus one may want to leave and start their own business. This also relates to transitions and births for those close to you.

Nov 06, 2005 Jupiter = Neptune/Pluto Transit

One can become highly religious under this, dedicating themselves to a belief system along with a desire to propagate the faith. There's the potential for universal love of humanity and the gift to see beyond this present reality. There could be research into the metaphysical side of things which may be very successful, especially in working with dreamtime. On the other side of the coin, this relates to gambling and/or wasting one's energy on foolish things that probably won't take form and/or manifest anyway. This also represents the spiritual traveler who can take a journey within and/or to a spiritual place on the earth. On a medical level, there could be problems with the liver and/or blood.

Nov 06, 2005 Moon = Pluto (Powerful Feelings) Progressed

The Moon combined with Pluto draws the feminine along with personal power; thus this represents a woman using her power. This could be the woman who uses her gifts to help others, or uses them to manifest things in her life. There's a

tendency to go deep into the subconscious motivations that drive one to desire. The healer, the woman who knows, the priestess, Wiccan knowledge, the Sorceress, and/or the Shaman are representations of this energy. The deeply sensitive emotional woman and/or the people who can reflect one's past and eliminate dysfunctional behavior are also representations of this; thus, this relates to the psychologist, psychiatrist, and/or the psychic surgeon. Nov 06, 2005 Pluto = Saturn/Ascendant Transit

On the negative and/or the misuse of the energy, this relates to violence, brutality, abuse and disputes with others. Medically this relates to having surgery. The best way to deal with this energy is to be aware and have faith that there is a universal plan.

Nov 07, 2005 Jupiter = Jupiter/Pluto (The Inheritance) Transit

When Jupiter and Pluto come together there is a focus on a deeper sense of beliefs where one seeks knowledge of the unknown. This energy relates to the priest and/or the initiation into a secret society or form of study. Good powers of judgment, especially when working with large sums of money, is another manifestation of this energy, as well as dealing with the IRS, taxes, banks, insurance companies, and estates through the death of a family member. There can be transitions for a grandparent who leaves an estate bequeathing an inheritance, thus one becomes the benefactor. There could also be a child born who may proceed the passing of a grandparent with an expanded consciousness, thus the power has been transferred to the grandchild from the grandparent. One may have great powers of judgment as this relates to major Supreme Court decisions as well as being judge and/or to be the one being judged. Many great philosophers who have the capacity to change the belief system of the masses carry this energy. Medically this rules removals through surgery which can end up favorably, along with the potential for liver problems.

Nov 08, 2005 Saturn = Sun/Neptune Transit

One can dissolve old structures by the rebuilding of new ones. This represents the bridge of consciousness created when we follow our spiritual path. It can also represent a physical bridge over a body of water; thus, on a psychological level, this relates to a bridge over troubled waters. On the negative side, there can be issues surrounding desertion and/or substance abuse on the part of the father. On a professional level, there can be betrayal within the work environment or a slow disintegration of the business. Medically this weakens the immune system, thus causing a wasting-away effect. This rules the potential cancer of one's philosophy,

thus manifesting as liver disease caused by the lack of good judgment. There can also be tooth decay, osteoporosis, and weakened bones due to poor assimilation of calcium. It's important to have clear intent along with sound values as one's guide through life.

Nov 08, 2005 Mercury = Neptune/Node Direction: Solar Arc

There's a tendency toward flights of fantasy in the way one thinks, thus, this could manifest through the writing of fictional stories or being an intuitive speaker. Many times there is a relative or sibling who has an illogical way of looking at life, and/or they may have substance abuse problems. There can also be contact with spirits, giving mediumistic abilities. But on the negative side of this energy, there can be talking to one's self and whomever else is out there in the spirit realm. Thus, this gives one an appearance of being out of touch with reality. This also relates to connecting with spiritual groups of people who have similar interests on a mental plain of consciousness.

Nov 08, 2005 Mars = Saturn/Node Direction: Solar Arc

Overcoming obstacles with created by others and feeling the one's energy is being usurped is a manifestation of this energy. There can be a forceful separation or feeling of loss and sadness with another. This relates to a group of men joined together for a common cause like builders, soldiers, or any work force where there is a lot of joint physical energy used to get the job done. Medically this rules the gall bladder which relates to the saying, "The gall of that person". It also represents sustained anger kept just beneath the surface for an extended period of time eventually causing dis-ease, so just say what you mean and mean what you say.

Nov 11, 2005 Jupiter = Saturn/Pluto Transit

Government, big business, and/or the IRS, CIA, FBI, or any powerful organization that investigates and researches is a manifestation of this energy. This relates to large sums of money, where one's activities are kept secret. Sounds like a major deal and that it is, so be sure to pay taxes and have nothing to hide from these institutions, lest one be caught in their web. On a more positive side, this denotes estates, estate planning, gaining financially, and/or stock market trading where there are many ups and downs. On a medical level, this relates to elimination, either elective or otherwise.

Nov 12, 2005 Neptune = Midheaven/Ascendant Direction: Solar Arc

One can change their personal appearance now or there can be a fading into the crowd effect. People, who have this are healthy and don't want to waste their energy. There may be a desire to help people less fortunate than one's self, but this could be a drain on one's energy over an extended period of time. Be sure and stay away from addictive behavior like drugs, caffeine, nicotine, and alcohol. There could also be sleep disorders. Medically, this tends to drain one's energy and gives problems with the musculature. The best thing one could do is to work out or do yoga. Remember no matter how difficult the strain may be at first, you will feel 100 percent better in a short time.

Nov 13, 2005 Node = Moon/Venus Transit

A new love relationship can come into one's life now, someone whom they would want to marry in the future. There can be many happy associations with a love of life expressed through the connections one makes now. One also has the potential for future success due to the help of others. There is the ability to make others feel emotionally secure and comfortable in your presence, thus this relates to the connections that bring success in life.

Nov 13, 2005 Node = Mercury/Ascendant Transit

This is the place where we connect in a good communicative way with others, especially our relatives or with our soul group. This also denotes the possible birth of a sibling who is very mercurial in nature or a Gemini. There's a strong need to be able to express one's self to others, as well as having skills as a presenter. This energy relates to a group with whom one may want to study or a group of people that share similar interests.

Nov 14, 2005 Jupiter = Pluto/Midheaven Transit

Financial power and professional success is a manifestation of this. This brings one together with people who are influential and have abundance in their own life. There can be inheritances along with the potential transition of a grandparent. This relates to having to deal with the IRS and/or large banking institutions.

Nov 15, 2005 Moon = Mercury/Ascendant Progressed

The home in which the family gathers, or where the relatives come to join together, is a manifestation of this; as well as relating to female relatives who may have an emotional way of expressing themselves. This also relates to the history or genealogy of the family. There can be a family-run business, which may lean toward the food and/or real estate industry. And one can have the ability to create crafts or make little things that take intricacy.

Nov 16, 2005 Moon = Moon/Venus (The Marriage) Progressed

The Moon combined with Venus relates to the marriage based on the power of love and attraction. It denotes beautiful women, who have sensitivity to the needs of others or the beautiful environment and the happy family, thus creating beauty in one's life. One has the capacity to emotionally respond to the desires of others, as well as feel happiness while in the presence of family members. Having a beautiful face and hair and the overall liking of what is seen in the mirror is represented by this energy. There is usually a capacity to do interior decorating along with a love of colors and textures. This also denotes the ability to be very socially oriented with the love of a good party. One usually has a very fertile imagination and loves to make food in a way that gives pleasure to others. Great cooks who express their love for others through their food have this, which provides for one's emotional needs. There's also a love of planting flowers and watching them grow. Nov 20, 2005 Node = Pluto (Transformational Associations) Transit

This also relates to large groups of people who come together for a common purpose that transforms the existing policy. On a psychological level, this brings awareness of others and the consciousness of self and yet there's the potential to lose consciousness of others by not knowing how they really feel. Nov 20, 2005 Jupiter = Mars/Node Transit

Successful men and/or connecting with men who have abundance created through their career, much like a philanthropist or world traveler, is a manifestation of this. There can be happiness that can come to one through the connections made with males. This represents contractual agreements, which can connect one with the legal profession or with people who make decisions for others. This also represents conception and/or birth of a male child.

Nov 21, 2005 Jupiter = Venus/Uranus Transit

There can be many friends of a higher mind or philosophy such as astrologers or people involved in academia. One has the capacity to be well-liked and admired for what one knows, and there can be the sudden winning of a prize or money coming to them unexpectedly. The successful artist or associating with artists and having a strong appreciation of their talents is a representation of this. One could also fall in love with a successful person, however fleeting it may be.

Nov 23, 2005 Pluto = Midheaven/Ascendant Transit

One has the power of self-mastery over the physical and emotional body. It tends to give the ability to control the circumstances in one's life and to advance one quickly due to personal attention to details. This relates to transitions and births as well as adoptions and/or a total change in one's life due to outside forces. There can also be powerful changes due to something outside of the self, as in earth changes or weathering the storm with others.

Nov 23, 2005 Jupiter = Neptune/Node Transit

The gambler and/or being involved in a con game is a representation of this energy, thus there is a tendency to have unrealistic expectations which are hidden by one's hopes of winning big. One may be highly spiritual, linking them with others who have the same aspirations. There could also be travel with others to a foreign land, or the land of one's heritage. Medically this rules the liver as in hepatitis, caused possibly by an incorrect belief system.

Nov 23, 2005 Jupiter = Mars/Ascendant Transit

Popular people or a time of popularity in one's life is an expression of this energy,

and it can bring a man into a woman's life. With this, we can commit to something greater than ourselves by working with others who have similar beliefs to our own. Many times people get married and/or become engaged now. This also can put one in the center of attention due to their activities, which could be either legal or illegal. Nov 23, 2005 Jupiter = Moon/Sun Transit

There can be abundance in one's personal life, and or a child could be born into a wealthy family. It gives the desire to travel and see the world and experience different belief systems and philosophies of other cultures. There is normally a need to move up in the world with this. Thus this is a time of moving and/or expanding in one's personal home. Nov 24, 2005 Jupiter = Jupiter/Node (Successful Associations) Transit

Jupiter/Node brings successful and pleasant associations into our life, as it relates to abundant people who are influential in the community, having knowledge or financial success. These are the connections one makes which help them to change their future direction. One can meet someone now with whom they would like to marry and share their future. There can also be the birth of a child who brings much pleasure into one's life. Connections can be made now with foreigners who share their beliefs and philosophy on life. On a professional level, this relates to connecting with people who are in key positions to help advance one's career; thus this is an important time for business success created through bonding with others.

Nov 24, 2005 Mercury = Mars/Ascendant Direction: Solar Arc

These are the people who can express themselves forcefully, saying exactly what they are thinking, in fact, they may be known for that aggressive quality. Many writers, critics, and comedians carry this energy. This denotes a relative or someone close, with no problem expressing their thoughts and what they feel about almost anything. Thus, this represents fast communication with others of like mind.

Nov 25, 2005 Moon = Mercury/Jupiter Direction: Solar Arc

One has the capacity to feel things with great compassion and sensitivity, thus there is usually good communications with women and any dealings with them. There's writing ability about matters pertaining to the past and/or history, along with the capacity to speak in public about matters relating to family and/or one's personal philosophy. Many time's people make decisions to move and/or to travel great distances now.

Nov 26, 2005 Jupiter = Neptune/Ascendant Transit

The beautiful happy person who has the capacity to influence the beliefs of others is a manifestation of this energy. One has a love of water and traveling great distances to experience other cultures, and/or one could take an internal journey to discover inner awareness of the self and one's own dream life. This also relates to deception on a grander scale, as in a big con game and/or a person who is a sociopath. Medically this rules the immune system, the blood, and the liver, as in hepatitis.

Nov 27, 2005 Node = Mercury/Node (The Communication Connection) Transit

Communication with those one feels very connected to as well as relating to a study group that one meets up with once a week are manifestations of this energy. It links one to relatives and siblings in the family or it connects one with people who we consider family. There may be unique connections that bring new interests and knowledge into one's life as well as people with whom one thinks in the same way and shares mutual interests.

Nov 27, 2005 Jupiter = Jupiter/Ascendant (Expansive Environment) Transit

Jupiter combined with the Ascendant expands the environment and/or physical body, which could manifest in the form of excess through one's weight or height or sheer size. One could also be the lean lanky type, having a runner's body and, in fact, this energy does relate to runners and/or tennis players. There is a love of travel and/or moving from one home to another, which is usually larger. There's also the desire for a more spiritual environment where one can practice the expansion of the belief system. Nov 29, 2005 Jupiter = Saturn/Node Transit

This energy takes one from one set of circumstances into another and it relates to experiencing a financial struggle with others. This struggle can finally manifest in the attainment of a goal, thus recreating economic security. There can be the desire to do something for one's future security with others, like building a home or building a career. This also relates to the father or grandfather on the paternal side who may have left an inheritance and or started a family-run business. There seems to be happiness in seclusion, or through being separated from the masses. There can also be family separations, created through a difference in philosophy and beliefs. Medically this relates to the liver, thus metaphorically it represents a hardened belief system that no longer is flexible and receiving of new ideas.

Dec 02, 2005 Jupiter = Node/Midheaven Transit

One can make social connections now which are influential in society and in one's personal social group. These connections can advance one's career and social

position in life. There can be many outings and favorable networking get-togethers where the purpose is sharing of philosophy and beliefs. This also denotes fame and success due to the attention of others, and there's usually a very successful grandparent who had influence in the community. People can move up in the world easily with this, and they usually have the desire to take a long trip to another country to see their homeland.

Dec 02, 2005 Jupiter = Saturn/Ascendant Transit

Moving up in the world due to opportunities that take one out of their former limitations is a manifestation of this energy. There's a desire to move from a smaller home to a larger one. This relates to people who have come from a limited, confined position early in life, with little joy or happiness. Thus this gives one the capacity to value hard work and saving for that potential rainy day. Medically this relates to the liver, so be sure to drink lots of water.

Dec 05, 2005 Jupiter = Midheaven/Ascendant Transit

One wants to expand their physical reality though their environment or through their physical body. This could be a good thing and/or it could lead to over expansion or weight gain. On the whole this is a popular, successful time in one's life where there is a lot of personal joy and sharing of one's prosperity with others. There's a desire to travel and enjoy the fruits of one's labor. Many people who have been born into abundance have this, as well as people who have financial success.

Dec 06, 2005 Saturn = Sun/Neptune Transit

One can dissolve old structures by the rebuilding of new ones. This represents the bridge of consciousness created when we follow our spiritual path. It can also represent a physical bridge over a body of water; thus, on a psychological level, this relates to a bridge over troubled waters. On the negative side, there can be issues surrounding desertion and/or substance abuse on the part of the father. On a professional level, there can be betrayal within the work environment or a slow disintegration of the business. Medically this weakens the immune system, thus causing a wasting-away effect. This rules the potential cancer of one's philosophy, thus manifesting as liver disease caused by the lack of good judgment. There can also be tooth decay, osteoporosis, and weakened bones due to poor assimilation of calcium. It's important to have clear intent along with sound values as one's guide through life.

Dec 08, 2005 Moon = Sun/Uranus Progressed

With this, there is a desire to make changes in a person's life, or being forced to make a change in one's residence. There can be emotional instability in the lives of women in one's surroundings. Many times there is involvement with brilliant, highly intelligent, unique females. Usually the mother is volatile and/or unstable and it can give one unusual eating patterns, which may cause stomach problems. There seems to be a lack of emotional stability due to early family conditioning which directly affects the health.

Dec 08, 2005 Ascendant = Jupiter/Pluto Progressed

This energy relates to a person who could be born into wealth or who manifests it in this lifetime. One has a transformative nature, pursuing financial security and in later life becoming a philanthropists, thus helping many charities with the money one has accumulated. This also relates to one with personal power that could be used to heal and transform the lives of others. This denotes the surgeon, priest, shaman, Wiccan priestess or sorcerer; all having powers which heal and transform. On a mundane level, this relates to having cosmetic surgery to improve one's appearance, thus becoming more youthful looking.

Dec 09, 2005 * Jupiter = Mercury/Venus Transit

Legal contracts and/or agreements that could have a favorable outcome are a manifestation of this energy. There may be a sibling and/or relative who is involved in the legal profession. And this relates to the marriage contract, the legal judgment, and/or when someone has the potential to become the judge. Thus one has a good sense of judgment. One also has the ability to have great love for another and the capacity to express that through one's feelings. Usually people who like to write, but in a big way, have this, thus they could either write many short stories and/or write a novel about their love for another or about one's personal philosophy or belief system.

Dec 10, 2005 Mercury = Moon/Sun Direction: Solar Arc

It has to do with being in balance with one's ability to communicate effectively with others and to do it with awareness of the feeling each person has invested in the outcome. It also gives one the ability to apply knowledge and understanding with sensitivity in their everyday communications. There can be love and enjoyment in the process of learning, and it could give teaching and lecturing abilities, since there's the capacity to hear what someone is saying combined with the skill to be a good listener.

Dec 13, 2005 Mars = Pluto/Node Progressed

These are powerful, energetic people who know how to get what they want out of life. This power has the potential to be manipulative along with a sexual vent; thus relating to assault or brute force at the hands of others. This also denotes a group of soldiers, surgeons, or body builders, all having the same effect, the ability to transmute energy. One has to be careful with this type of energy, so be aware of who you meet when this is activated so you can understand their motives. In a man's chart this can deal with hernias and prostate problems on a medical level.

Dec 16, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Mars Transit

One has the capacity to have success, fame, and abundance, which can come on a monetary level, and/or through sharing one's philosophy with others. It gives the desire to travel and learn about other cultures and their belief systems. It relates to making a good decision and/or a decision going in one's favor. This has the potential to be a good time to enter into a legal contract. There can be a fortunate turn of circumstances in one's life, and it could also bring publicity and/or being

in the limelight. On a physical level, this relates to being well-endowed, having a large, strong, healthy body.

Dec 16, 2005 Pluto = Mercury/Venus Transit

Dec 16, 2005 Node = Midheaven (Professional Associations) Transit

Dec 19, 2005 * Jupiter = Sun/Neptune Transit

This is the spiritual journey which either comes from within and/or manifests as a vision quest. Dec 19, 2005 Node = Saturn/Midheaven Transit

One has a feeling of standing alone without the support of their loved ones now. There can also be fated unions or connections that ultimately help one to grow forcefully.

Dec 20, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Jupiter (The Opportunity) Transit

The Sun represents the self and Jupiter is success; thus Sun/Jupiter combinations seem to bring out success through one's philosophy on life. It attracts one to religion and/or subjects dealing with the philosophy behind worshiping something greater than the self. Each of us seeks out the purpose of life and how we fit into it. This relates to having lots of fun and expansion and it's considered one of the

most advancing times of one's life. People who are born into wealth carry this energy and/or this can be a time where one could create wealth and success for themselves. This is also a time when people travel and/or have contact with foreigners. It represents being able to relate on a big level, thus expanding into many opportune areas in life. Joy for life and expansion of the self are expressions of this, as well as putting one in a high social group within the community. It relates to the seasoned traveler or author. There can be the birth of a Sagittarius or Jupiter's child who is optimistic and looks at the glass half full as opposed to half empty. This rules grand parents, especially if they leave an inheritance to their offspring. This also gives the potential for success when dealing with foreigners and/or foreign products. The medical areas are the hips, thighs, liver, blood, and hepatic system.

Dec 21, 2005 Saturn = Sun/Mars Transit

There's stability in one's direction and a determination and focus on personal goals. It gives control over one's work environment and a sense of respect for one's planning skills. On the reverse side, there can be problems in being the controller and/or being controlled by others. It can cause slow progress or delayed attainment of the goals that one sets out to accomplish. There can also be a block in the energy level and/or in one's ability to love and be loved. On a medical level, this relates to blockages in the heart or circulatory system due to closing off one's love nature.

Dec 24, 2005 Venus = Mercury/Mars Progressed

With this, one tends to fall madly in love with someone quickly and they can do no wrong. There can also be excellent communications between the sexes. There's an alluring quality to the beholder and, shall we say, a way with words, which could be shown through fits of jealousy. But on a more positive level, there can be benefit through sales and presentations since they can get people inspired to their way of thinking. This also relates to the marriage of a sibling.

Dec 24, 2005 Jupiter = Moon (Great Feelings) Transit

The Moon/Jupiter gives expansion of the environment, a large family and/or the woman with a great philosophy on life or the family's belief system. It represents one's physical presence or moving to a larger home and/or to the love of family and home life. It's when one moves up in the world and finds happiness and abundance in one's life's path; thus it's the good life. There's the capacity to be emotionally receptive to the needs of others. It relates to having a highly religious and/or philosophical nature. There can also be a grandmother with a strong heritage and belief system who's at the head of the family. Usually there's a happy family and success and opportunities with real estate. An image of this could be the happy woman who loves to travel, especially to see the family ancestral home, since this represents the history or heritage of the family, thus genealogy. Many times it gives the desire to become a priest and/or a nun or becoming involved with someone of a religious nature. The luck of the Irish is with this energy and there is also the love of sports that the whole family becomes involved in. On a medical level, this tends to increase one's weight due to the love of food, which

also relates to the large-breasted woman. On the shadow side, this relates to inherited diseases.

Dec 26, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Saturn Transit

Expansion from smaller to bigger, or getting larger, is a manifestation of this, and many times there is a feeling of not enough, causing one to feel that the glass is half empty. People stay in one place for years with this and aren't able to travel much except for business. There can also be saving for a time in the future when one can expand, thus attaining their goals after being limited by time and circumstance. On a medical level, this rules potential heart problems due to holding back the love and not giving to others and/or not receiving the love from others.

Dec 26, 2005 Jupiter = Uranus (Higher Intellect) Transit

When Jupiter combines with Uranus there's a desire to study and learn about knowledge on advanced subjects. Many times, one desires to go on to college or university and study advanced technical subjects like astrology and/or being inspired by the quest for knowledge. There can be many opportunities surrounding higher education, as in a scholarship being given and/or the beginning and/or ending of higher education. Seminars and all sorts of classes and/or any form of continuing education falls under this. People who believe in higher consciousness carry this energy, having good fortune and advancement in life. There is also the desire to explore foreign lands, having a strong sense of adventure and excitement. One has a desire to take chances through speculation, thus one can win in a big way. Religion also plays a role, since one likes to make changes in what they perceive as a sedentary system which may lack the freedom of belief that one's looking for. Medically this rules the hepatic system: hips, thighs, calves, blood pressure, and blood disorders.

Dec 27, 2005 Node = Saturn (Stable Connections) Transit

When Saturn and the Node combine with one another, there's a joining of people who have mutual goals in mind, connecting one with coworkers or people to build new structures. There is a feeling of maturity, or being around people who have mastered something on a professional level, thus this relates to a new boss or a change in management. On the other side, there can be separations from others due to work grievances, along with inhibitions or limitations within one's personal or professional associations. There can be a feeling of hopelessness in a situation that involves others. This also relates to the father and is present when one is separated from a family member, or a family member may have a health issue to contend with.

Dec 28, 2005 Node = Uranus/Ascendant Transit

Dec 29, 2005 Jupiter = Sun/Midheaven Transit

Jan 01, 2006 Jupiter = Venus/Pluto Transit

Jan 02, 2006 Neptune = Mercury/Uranus Transit

Jan 02, 2006 Node = Neptune/Midheaven Transit

This also relates to the uniting of creative artists to form a common bond. There can be a linking of people who are deceptive or addictive in nature or both; be careful who you call your flock. Jan 02, 2006 Node = Uranus/Node (Social Acquaintance) Transit

Jan 03, 2006 Node = Mercury/Pluto Transit

There's the capacity to be put in a position of judgment and/or decision-maker. There can be the transition of a relative or the birth of a sibling now, as well as the handling of a relative's financial problems. One also has the ability to speak for others or the community.

Jan 03, 2006 Node = Mars/Jupiter Direction: Solar Arc

One has the capacity to co-operate, work well with and get along with others. There's an ability to experience free enterprise at its best through buying and selling or merchandising. This relates to meeting someone with whom we feel a soul bond, that could lead to a future merging of energies.

Jan 04, 2006 Node = Jupiter/Saturn Transit

One wants to change their core associations due to differences in philosophy, thus creating separating from others. One sees how they have limited themselves through their beliefs; and there is a desire to want more out of life. There is also a desire to associate with people who can help one to attain their goals. There can be professional connections to other with whom one will work on long-term projects, expansion and advancement being the ultimate goals.

Jan 06, 2006 Node = Saturn/Neptune Transit

There's may be a feeling of discomfort or depression when in the presence of others, or there can be a connection with people who have been suffering over a long period of time. This suffering may have been from health problems, or a basic feeling of inferiority due to early childhood neglect when one may have been deserted by parents.. Either way this is difficult karmic energy denoting a time of immobility. This also connects one with people who have addictions. Jan 06, 2006 Node = Mars/Midheaven Transit

Jan 08, 2006 Midheaven = Moon (The Matriarch) Direction: Solar Arc

Jan 13, 2006 Node = Jupiter (Successful Associations) Transit

Jupiter/Node brings successful and pleasant associations into our life, as it relates to abundant people who are influential in the community, having knowledge or financial success. These are the connections one makes which help them to change their future direction. One can meet someone now with whom they would like to marry and share their future. There can also be the birth of a child who brings much pleasure into one's life. Connections can be made now with foreigners who share their beliefs and philosophy on life. On a professional level, this relates to connecting with people who are in key positions to help advance one's career; thus this is an important time for business success created through bonding with others.

Jan 15, 2006 Node = Jupiter/Neptune Transit

Connecting one with people who wish to lead or show the way through personal guidance on a spiritual level is a manifestation of this energy. One may try to help someone who is an alcoholic or drug addict, but it's best to let the professionals familiar with the games addicted people play deal with this. Jan 17, 2006 Uranus = Venus (Beautiful Friends) Direction: Solar Arc

Jan 17, 2006 Node = Neptune (Spiritual Connection) Transit

On the reverse side of this there can be abdication of responsibility within the community that can cause anti social behavior. Usually there is a feeling of being separate from others and alone. Jan 19, 2006 Pluto = Sun/Mars Transit

This relates to self-mastery and control of the physical body. It is usually present in the charts of athletes and/or people interested in bodybuilding, it gives great strength and creates a healthy body. This relates to elimination and/or cutting something out of the life, which can sometimes be through drastic means or brute force. On the reverse side it rules vengeful acts, rape in all of its different facets, births and deaths. It's also present in the charts of healers who have the power to recreate a healthy mind/body relationship.

Jan 19, 2006 Jupiter = Mercury/Uranus Transit

This relates to optimistic people who are fortunate in life as well as having a sibling with the capacity to have a high IQ and excel in academia. One could become a great astrologer, due to the ability to comprehend and synthesize many variables at once. This relates to higher education, university, and specialized schools, thus one has the capacity to be a philosopher and/or teacher of technical

subjects. There can also be hearing good news or hearing of good fortune for another. This is also a great time to speculate and win.

Jan 20, 2006 Saturn = Midheaven/Ascendant Transit

This has a sobering effect in that there may be periods of isolation from others, or a feeling that one needs to be alone. This builds personal character and stability due to relying on the self versus others. There can also be a period where one is limited by a situation, or one may have to take care of the needs of another. On a medical level, this tends to cause ailments that limit, like arthritis, as well as having problems with the teeth and/or bone structure, denoting chronic ailments.

Jan 21, 2006 Node = Mars/Jupiter Transit

One has the capacity to co-operate, work well with and get along with others. There's an ability to experience free enterprise at its best through buying and selling or merchandising. This relates to meeting someone with whom we feel a soul bond, that could lead to a future merging of energies.

Jan 23, 2006 Node = Mars/Neptune Transit

There can be attractions to people who create fantasy and/or illusion in our life. On a career level this denotes the swimmer, or athlete-surrounding water sports, perhaps even a dancer or musician. This relates to people that come back into one's life from a previous lifetime allowing you to complete and make right some unfinished business. Thus, this denotes the completion of the illusion created in a previous lifetime or owing someone energy from your past life.

Jan 24, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Mars Transit

There is a love of travel, especially to warm, hot places. This can cause legal problems surrounding the family and/or real estate matters and there can be heated discussions regarding the belief systems and philosophy of others. This also rules the physically large woman and/or the large breasted female. Medically, there can be weight gain due to chemical imbalance in the diet along with an over acid condition.

Jan 27, 2006 Saturn = Saturn/Ascendant (Restricted Environment) Transit

With Saturn in combination with the Ascendant there is a feeling that our environment is limiting us and/or that we have restricted one's self due to one's personal patterns. One can have a strong sense of timing along with the desire to succeed in whatever one does, due to feeling that one's life should have purpose. This relates to maturing and/or being aged by the world around us. Thus, one begins to look within the self for a sense of balance, which can be done through meditation. There can be an attraction to a relationship that could test one's values, especially if one decides to partner with them. Jan 29, 2006 Jupiter = Venus/Node Transit

This relates to great success, since it creates connections that help one to advance and expand in their life's path. Many times one meets the person they want to marry and are happy for many years to come.

Jan 29, 2006 Node = Mars Transit

When Mars and the Node come together there are usually bonds formed with men. One has the desire to form cooperative unions to accomplish a job with others, thus having a mutual goal or purpose. There could also be joining a group together with other men, like a gun club or working out together at a gym. In a woman's chart this could be a time when she could meet a man with whom she would want to be in a relationship and there is usually a strong physical attraction to him, thus this relates to procreation. On the reverse side of this, there could be problems that occur now with co-workers and with men who want to do things their way resulting in many little disagreements and arguments within groups led by men.

Jan 29, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Neptune Transit

There can be a psychic grandmother and/or a large woman who has great abundance in one's life, as well as having a strong religious belief with a powerful heritage. There's a desire to feed the masses and/or to give freely the gifts that one has received from others. Many times there is a journey of awareness: the spiritual journey or traveling great distances over water to see family. This relates to the process of entering into dreamtime. Jan 30, 2006 Neptune = Venus/Node Transit

It's important to know the person one connects with before one gives their most

valuable asset: their love.

Jan 31, 2006 Uranus = Mars/Uranus (Unpredictable Energy) Transit

The energy of Mars combines with the unexpected quality of Uranus to create events that come from out of the blue or have an unpredictable nature, as in sudden electrical shocks, lightning or hearing shocking news. There's an attraction to the unusual or unique when it comes to friends, for a woman this would be interest in a rebellious type of man. One has the ability to individuate by not following the normal drumbeat and there can be association with unusual groups of people who are interested in advanced sciences or unique studies. There can also be activities done in haste that could potentially cause accidents. Jan 31, 2006 Neptune = Moon/Neptune (Psychic Intuition) Transit

The Moon/Neptune contains the possibility of extreme intuitions, which may manifest through the seeing of visions or even developing one's dreamtime awareness. One has the capacity to have no time or a sense of timelessness. One seems to live in a dream world, where there are no proper boundaries and many times the mother or the grandmother could have had psychic abilities. This also relates to a person who deals with hidden guilt or shame and/or having a family secret that, if not addressed, can affect the physical health. There can be many intuitive gifts, and there is a sense of motion or waves, thus this rules the dancer. One may also have the capacity to become famous due to having intuitive or artistic skills. Jan 31, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Jupiter (Great Feelings) Transit

The Moon/Jupiter gives expansion of the environment, a large family and/or the woman with a great philosophy on life or the family's belief system. It represents one's physical presence or moving to a larger home and/or to the love of family and home life. It's when one moves up in the world and finds happiness and abundance in one's life's path; thus it's the good life. There's the capacity to be emotionally receptive to the needs of others. It relates to having a highly religious and/or philosophical nature. There can also be a grandmother with a strong heritage and belief system who's at the head of the family. Usually there's a happy family and success and opportunities with real estate. An image of this could be the happy woman who loves to travel, especially to see the family ancestral home, since this represents the history or heritage of the family, thus genealogy. Many

times it gives the desire to become a priest and/or a nun or becoming involved with someone of a religious nature. The luck of the Irish is with this energy and there is also the love of sports that the whole family becomes involved in. On a medical level, this tends to increase one's weight due to the love of food, which also relates to the large-breasted woman. On the shadow side, this relates to inherited diseases.

Feb 04, 2006 Saturn = Saturn/Node (Stable Connections) Transit

When Saturn and the Node combine with one another, there's a joining of people who have mutual goals in mind, connecting one with coworkers or people to build new structures. There is a feeling of maturity, or being around people who have mastered something on a professional level, thus this relates to a new boss or a change in management. On the other side, there can be separations from others due to work grievances, along with inhibitions or limitations within one's personal or professional associations. There can be a feeling of hopelessness in a situation that involves others. This also relates to the father and is present when one is separated from a family member, or a family member may have a health issue to contend with.

Feb 04, 2006 Jupiter = Venus/Ascendant Transit

Expansion of the environment with the influence of other cultures and/or through one's heritage is a manifestation of this energy. This is also the beautiful person who brings happiness into the lives of others because of their expanded love awareness and internalized beauty. One has a great capacity to give and receive love from others.

Feb 07, 2006 Neptune = Moon/Jupiter Transit

One can enrich the lives of others through their belief system. It's a time when one may desire to travel to distant lands over a large body of water, and one may also have creative and artistic abilities that could manifest as a great musician, dancer, and/or poet. A picture of this might be an emotionally abundant woman who is very intuitive in nature. On the other side of this, there may be a tendency to con others or to be conned. It could cause religious or philosophical deception from, or to, others. It can create lots of rain and a time of flooding, indicating the rising river or tide. On a medical level, it rules prescribed medications, the unknown medical problem, and/or a misdiagnosis. This also can affect the liver as in hepatitis or jaundice.

Feb 07, 2006 Mercury = Jupiter/Node Direction: Solar Arc

Communication within the group, which specializes in the effective use of words as their allies is a representation of this energy. This may manifest as a writer's guild, book guild, or any group using communication as their connection. This also relates to contact with a sibling or relative who is very self-expressive. This energy also relates to having shared success with others on a cooperative project.

Feb 08, 2006 Saturn = Jupiter/Ascendant Transit

There's a tendency to create separation and estrangements to those close associations within the environment. One may want to be alone or spend many

lonely days by one's self; either way, the energy is still the same in that aloneness is the end result. There are many ups and downs in life that seem to season one to weather almost any storm now, but for some people this is just what the doctor ordered. Medically, this rules the breathing process and potential blood disorders.

Feb 08, 2006 Pluto = Sun/Neptune Transit

The spiritual belief of the masses along with the ability to transform our spiritual path is a reflection of this. It rules psychic surgery and the ability to reach great heights of awareness, which could enlighten the masses, thus relating to being transformed through spirit. One is able to reach altered states of consciousness through deep meditation or being guided by a Realized Being, teacher or Guru. On the other side, one could be undermined through deception from another, and there may be an ending, which is related to substance abuse. This also rules surgery on the feet and losses, which are caused by addictive behavior.

Feb 11, 2006 Saturn = Neptune/Ascendant Transit

Setting personal boundaries is a function of this, due to the limitations created in early life through one's personal environment. There may have been alcoholism or some form of substance abuse which causes one to feel emotionally deprived. This also relates to past life karma which may need to be played out and eliminated in the present. Either way, there is a feeling that one can't get ahead in life; thus, medically, this rules diseases which limit, as in arthritis, bone disease, tooth decay, and sleep disorders. There's also a tendency to define one's spiritual reality, helping one to work within a constructive framework.

Feb 11, 2006 Uranus = Uranus/Neptune (Visions & Dreams) Transit

Uranus combined with Neptune relates to the collective associations one has with people who are spiritual in nature. These friendships help one to become inspired to heal wounds from past incarnations and evolve the soul; thus, this is the "evolution of the soul." This denotes a collective group of souls who have come into this world to bring new light of spiritual awareness and consciousness. On the shadow side, this relates to people who have addictive behaviors or are perhaps misguided by their associations with others; thus, the negative forces in a culture are using them. On the positive side, this is a period to enhance one's dreams, visions, and insights and put them into a daily practice. This practice can be done through meditation, yoga, and any form of ritual that brings balance and insight into the daily routine.

Feb 12, 2006 Node = Uranus/Pluto Transit

Bringing powerful people together to form a group working together towards a common goal which seems to advance humanity is a manifestation of this energy. This is an evolutionary influence bringing together a group of souls whose nature is to transcend and change one's present reality. Medically this rules sudden surgery, and/or problems with the reproductive system.

Feb 13, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Saturn Transit

There's a desire to expand in one's life after a period of being limited, especially in one's belief system. There can be a need to study higher knowledge, becoming

aware of the inward journey to self-awareness. One has a sense of concentration that can be applied to long-term projects and there is usually a duty and/or task which needs to be performed when it comes to the family or the family home. On a philosophical level, one has the desire to teach others what they have learned, thus eliminating a lot of the inner tension this created during early childhood development.

Feb 15, 2006 Saturn = Sun/Neptune Direction: Solar Arc

One can dissolve old structures by the rebuilding of new ones. This represents the bridge of consciousness created when we follow our spiritual path. It can also represent a physical bridge over a body of water; thus, on a psychological level, this relates to a bridge over troubled waters. Feb 15, 2006 Uranus = Jupiter/Uranus (Higher Intellect) Transit

Many times, one desires to go on to college or university and study advance technical subjects like astrology and/or being inspired by the quest for knowledge. There can be many opportunities surrounding higher education, as in a scholarship being given and/or the beginning and/or ending of higher education. Medically this rules the hepatic system: hips, thighs, calves, blood pressure, and blood disorders.

Feb 16, 2006 Neptune = Venus/Ascendant Transit

People who can create fantasy in their appearance or have a gift for acting carry this energy. One appears to be what people want them to be since they are chameleons. Thus, one seems to know exactly what one wants and how to respond; they are masters of illusion. Many actors or impressionists have this, since they have many different appearances. This is one of the best times to have a photo shoot, or to get a new hairstyle. Many stylists carry this energy, since they have the capacity to be able to bring out and compliment an individual's external beauty.

Feb 16, 2006 Saturn = Jupiter/Node Transit

Backing away from associations with others through ending, terminating, or separating is a representation of this energy. In the career area, this relates to coworkers who move on or are fired. In a marriage or union, it denotes no longer sharing the same beliefs or values with one's partner or mate. On a positive level, this relates to people in an authority position who help one to succeed, as a father does in early life.

Feb 18, 2006 * Saturn = Moon/Sun Transit

Separation in a relationship is a reflection of this, since one feels that their needs aren't being met. It can also mean a mature person or the maturing of a relationship that has staying power, since there seems to be a stabilizing force that is present in the partnership. On the negative or misuse of this energy, there is a tendency to have blocked maturation, or slow growth, forcing one to mature later in life and be unable to accept emotional responsibilities for anyone other than the self. This can cause deep psychological issues leading to depression. Family patterns in early life may have created a sense of emotional deprivation, thus later in life this patterning could cause difficulty through expressing one's self and/or feeling inhibited, restricting one's behavior when in the company of others.

Feb 19, 2006 Saturn = Mars/Ascendant Transit

One can hold themselves back from their full potential due to early inhibitions. Thus, if one works with their early environmental conditioning they could overcome some of the obstacles that seem to hold them back or keep them in the same place without advancement. People who have this seem to have physical strength and a sense of purpose. One usually has the intention to somehow get the job done no matter what the obstacles are. There can also be sadness which is shared with others due to a loss or concern for others.

Feb 19, 2006 Pluto = Sun/Jupiter Transit

This can be great wealth, success and personal power or a powerful person coming into one's life. One has the capacity to be a healer and/or psychic surgeon. Many priests and leaders in their faith or people who work with magic, and/or have the capacity to do energy work have this. These are highly influential people who seem to affect the community around them, thus this relates to the philanthropist. It can bring in financial abundance for oneself and others. Many transformations can come to one as well as a gift of faith or fate that can change one's life.

Feb 19, 2006 Uranus = Sun/Node Transit

One has the capacity to bring in unique people that help to advance one's knowledge. It could be joining a group of astrologers and linking or connecting with others on a mental level. This also manifests as the joining of a group interested in advancement through higher forms of communications. This represents the conception or birth of an unusual, unique, and often a rebellious child.

Feb 19, 2006 Saturn = Neptune/Node Transit

Emotional suffering experienced with others and caused by a highly volatile situation is a manifestation of this, thus there seems to be no way out except through time. This denotes someone who has health problems or is being deceitful in a relationship where they have hidden their true nature or desires. Either way, this can leave one feeling betrayed and alone, suffering in silence. Medically, this relates to bone disease due to not feeling supported by others, or skin ailments from toxicity in the diet. There can also be substance abuse on the part of the father's lineage and/or toxic substances within the work area which affect the health.

Feb 24, 2006 Moon = Pluto/Node Progressed

These are usually women who are in power, who have control of the family and/or the family money or both. This relates to women who have personal power; which, on the highest level, could take the form of a healer, shaman, or priestess. There can also be the passing of a matriarch and/or the birth of a power child, usually Scorpio's child. Medically, this rules problems with the reproductive system, especially, if there are control issues within the family.

Feb 25, 2006 Node = Mercury (The Communication Connection) Transit

Communication with those one feels very connected to as well as relating to a study group that one meets up with once a week are manifestations of this energy. It links one to relatives and siblings in the family or it connects one with people who we consider family. There may be unique connections that bring new interests and knowledge into one's life as well as people with whom one thinks in the same way and shares mutual interests.

Feb 26, 2006 Saturn = Venus/Uranus Transit

Separations from friends or difficulty in relationships -- either due to going in different directions or not spending enough time with each other to truly develop and nurture the relationship -- is a manifestation of this energy. There can also be controlled response in a relationship in one's love life or a feeling of a change in one's capacity to love. Thus, this denotes the sobering up process within a relationship. On the positive side, one may have new friends come in through a job change or a change of personnel within the present job.

Feb 28, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Midheaven Transit

There can be great advancement in one's life with attainment of one's goals and being recognized for professional gifts. To have a grandparent who started a very successful business that one could benefit from and/or advancement and success financially is another manifestation of this. There can also be moving for business advancement or moving to another country and/or other locations and loving it.

Feb 28, 2006 Saturn = Mars/Node Transit

There is a tendency to separate from male groups or from a man. It brings one together with men who are building a new structure, like builders on all levels of consciousness. This also relates to the father's health and/or blocks in energy when dealing with men in authority. Thus, this is a time of connecting with past karma that can be played out in the present.

Mar 02, 2006 Uranus = Sun/Ascendant Transit

Sudden changes surrounding one's physical environment, and unexpected rises and falls in one's life path come with this. In other words, it relates to the big changes that come about in one's life on an environmental level. It usually gives a unique and/or bizarre appearance, manifesting in an avant-garde or even progressive way of dressing. This also relates to electrical shocks to the body or nervous system, and it rules the place where lightening strikes. Medically, this rules spasms and contractions, thus it can cause aneurisms, strokes, and heart ailments.

Mar 04, 2006 Uranus = Saturn/Uranus (Changing Structures) Transit

When Saturn combines with Uranus, there seems to be the need to change the old structures to new ones, thus taking a different direction in life. Rebellion or rebellious acts relate to this energy, denoting a sense of being limited too long with the same old patterns. One has a tendency to be dominated by people who are in the position of authority. For the most part, this makes one feel as though they're on the ocean without a keel, without any direction. Medically, this rules diseases that limit, especially on an emotional and psychological level; thus, this denotes breast disease. The best way to deal with the tension that this brings is to meditate and do yoga or energy balancing, thus creating inner balance and peace.

Mar 08, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Midheaven Transit

There can be great advancement in one's life with attainment of one's goals and being recognized for professional gifts. To have a grandparent who started a very successful business that one could benefit from and/or advancement and success financially is another manifestation of this. There can also be moving for business

advancement or moving to another country and/or other locations and loving it.

Mar 14, 2006 Uranus = Uranus/Midheaven (Career Changes) Transit

When Uranus combines with the MC, there can be many changes that come about in one's career, and the doors of opportunity are open due to unexpected changes in the work environment. One can advance in the world and move from one career to another. People who have aptitude for technology, a vision, or have potential genius qualities carry this energy. Thus, they have a need for lots of change and excitement in their work life. This can come through being a racecar driver, pilot, stunt person, or any profession where a person takes chances. Thus, they have the element of excitement, doing it their own way. On the other side of this, there can be career volatility and sudden changes which are not expected, as in forceful relocation or layoffs. Take care in knowing that there is always a universal plan, and these changes are all part of that experience.

Mar 15, 2006 Moon = Pluto/Ascendant Progressed

There is the potential to bring up powerful emotional issues surrounding one's environment, which is experienced with others in the family. This relates to a woman who is a healer, who has the capability to use emotional power to transform others. Medically this rules surgery on the breasts and/or it could also represent emotionally removing a psychological pattern from one's subconscious through the help of a trained consultant.

Mar 22, 2006 Neptune = Moon/Midheaven Transit

Spiritual awakening or the entering into dreamtime along with having artistic and musical gifts are manifestations of this. It also relates to being in altered states of consciousness, like being a psychic or a medium. This also rules the parent with substance abuse problems and/or the caring for someone who has a long-term illness. Mar 22, 2006 Mercury = Venus/Pluto Progressed

There can also be the birth of a sibling or a sibling having a child now, depending on one's age group. Mar 24, 2006 Jupiter = Moon/Saturn Transit
